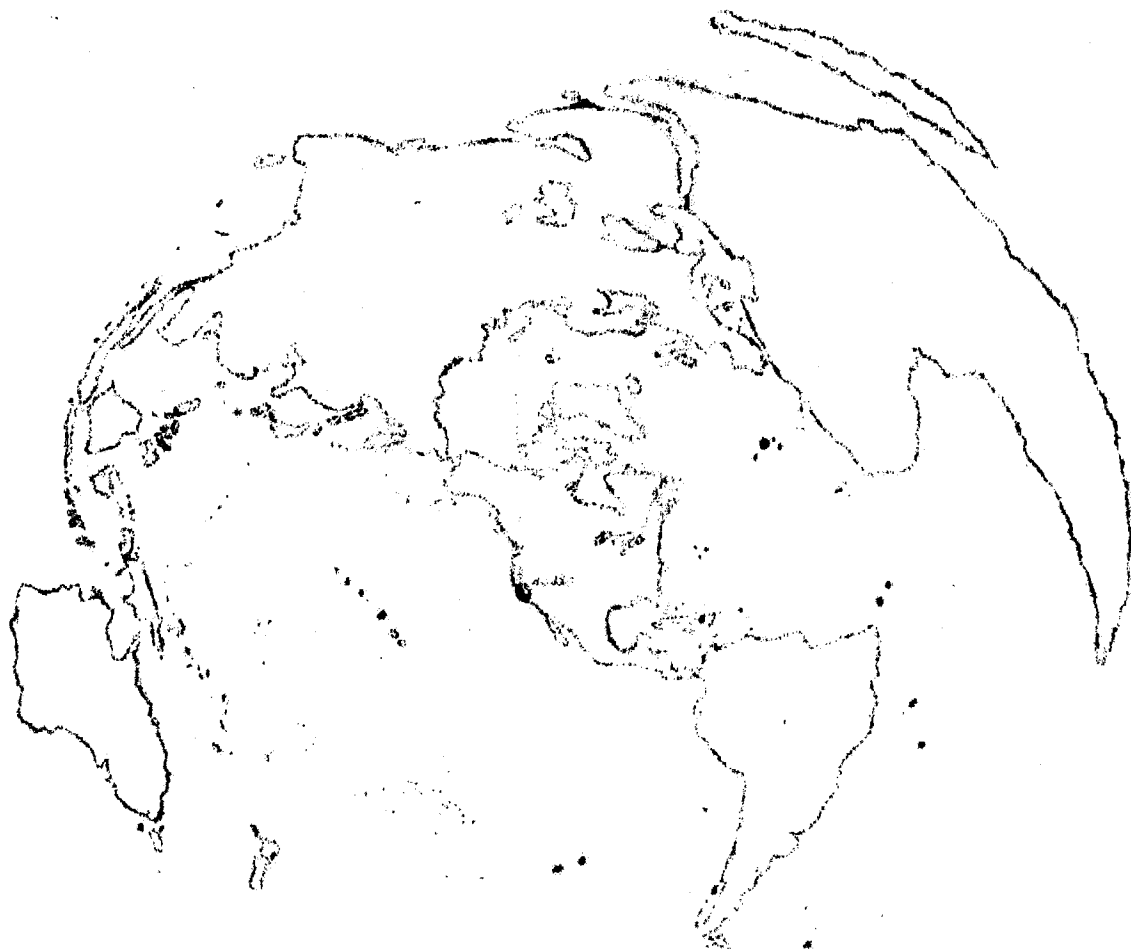

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AFTER COCKTAILS AND AN EXCELLENT TURKEY DINNER THE PRESIDENT CALLED THE CLUB TO ORDER AND FOUR VISITORS WERE INTRODUCED; W6ONZ, W6NRZ, W6IPH & T12TG.

1954 A.R.R.L. DX CONTEST AWARDS WERE PRESENTED BY THE AWARDS CHAIRMAN W6TI TO THE FOLLOWING: PHONE W6PWR, CW W6DZZ, MULTIPLE W6TT (WITH W6PYH AND W6TT) AND WITH APPROPRIATE BOWING OF THE HEADS THE INTER CLUB TROPHY WON BY THE SCDXC FOR THE THIRD TIME WAS VIEWED BY THE GALLANT LOSERS.

THE PRESIDENT REPORTED THAT W6KEK HAD TWENTY STRIPS WIRED FOR THE TWO METER TRANSMITTERS, AND ONE WIRED STRIP WAS PASSED AROUND FOR ALL TO SEE, IT CERTAINLY IS A NEAT LOOKING JOB. VOLUNTEERS WERE SOUGHT FOR THE WINDING OF THE 160 COILS FOR THE TRANSMITTER AND ALSO A GRID DIP METER. W6LDD OFFERED HIS GRID DIPPER AND WOULD HELP WHENEVER POSSIBLE.

W6PYH GAVE A REPORT FOR THE DX COMMITTEE AND AFTER MUCH PRO AND CON IT WAS VOTED THAT THE COMMITTEE WRITE A LETTER TO THE A.R.R.L. AND RECOMMEND THAT THE LEAGUE HIRE A FULL TIME DX MAN TO HANDLE ALL DX MATTERS COMING BEFORE THE LEAGUE, ALSO THAT COPIES OF THE LETTER BE SENT TO ALL THE DX CLUBS IN THE COUNTRY AND ASK THEIR HELP IN GETTING THIS ACROSS WITH THE LEAGUE. IT WAS FURTHER RECOMMENDED THAT THE LEAGUE APPOINT A TEN MAN DX COMMITTEE, ONE FROM EACH OF THE TOP TEN DX CLUBS.

IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE EAST BAY SCM OF THE A.R.R.L. INVITED THE NCDXC TO JOIN THE "FEDERATION OF RADIO CLUBS" THE ADVANTAGES OF BELONGING TO SUCH A FEDERATION WERE POINTED OUT. HOWEVER, AFTER CAREFUL CONSIDERATION IT WAS DECIDED NOT TO JOIN, AS WE (AS A DX CLUB) HAD VERY LITTLE TO GAIN BY SUCH A MOVE.

OUR NEXT MEETING ON DEC. 9TH WILL BE A CLOSED MEETING FOR MEMBERS ONLY. THERE WILL BE AN ELECTION OF THE OFFICERS FOR THE ENSUEING TERM. SO COME AND HELP ELECT YOUR FAVORITE CANDIDATE TO OFFICE.

AND HERE IS SOMETHING SPECIAL, WE HAVE IT FROM VERY GOOD AUTHORITY THAT HORACE WILL HAVE ABOUT 200 QSL CARDS FROM THE RECENT G2RO DX-PEDITION INTO ASIA, SUCH AS VS4RO & VS5RO, NUFF SAID?

THERE WILL BE A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CLUB CALLED AT THE FRESNO CONVENTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISPOSING OF THE MATTER TO AMEND OUR CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS AS PUBLICIZED IN THIS PAPER RECENTLY. 73 & DX, GPB

JOHN S. MAYES, 2960 BODEGA ROAD, SEBASTOPOL, CALIF.

W6BYB FIRST STARTED DRAWING THE ATTENTION OF THE BCL'S ON JUNE 1st. 1928 WHEN HE TURNED LOOSE A SIG ON THE 40 METER BAND WHICH CAME OUT OF A HARTLEY OSC. USING A 6EX TUNGSTEN FIL. "50 WATTER" AND 1000 V. RAC ON THE PLATE. THE ANTENNA WAS THE GOOD OLD HALF WAVE ZEPP. SIX DAYS LATER OZ2GO (NOW ZL2GO) WAS WORKED AFTER CALLING HIM FROM IIPM UNTIL 6AM. THAT WAS THE START OF THE DX BUG WHICH HAS CONTINUED TO THIS DAY. JOHN HAD A RADIO AND HOME APPLIANCE BUSINESS IN SACRAMENTO FROM 1932 TO 1942 AND THEN SIX MONTHS AFTER PEARL HARBOR CLOSED THE BUSINESS AND RADIO OPERATED IN THE MERCHANT MARINE.

AFTER THE WAR HE WORKED FOR PHILCO IN DL LAND AS A TECH-REP. AND HAD A BC-610 ON THE AIR OVER THERE WITH THE CALL D4AVW. DURING THAT TIME HE WORKED OVER 150 COUNTRIES AND 39 ZONES, OVER 350 DIFFERENT W6-W7 STN. WERE WORKED.

AFTER THE CONTRACT WITH PHILCO WAS UP HE RETURNED HOME AND PACKED FOR A TRIP THRU ALL THE CENTRAL AMERICAN COUNTRIES, AND ALSO COLOMBIA S.A., AND HIT JAMAICA AND THE GRAND CAYMEN ISLANDS ON THE RETURN TRIP HOME. HE VISITED AND POUNDED BRASS AT SUCH FAMOUS STATIONS AS XEIPO, HRIBG, HRIGM, KZ5CG, HKIDZ, VPSAO (KINGSTON) VP5BE (CAYMANS) AND VP1AA IN BRITISH HONDURAS. TRAVELING IS HIS 2ND LOVE AND SO FAR THE SCORE IS 39C IN 5 CONTINENTS, AFRICA BEING THE MISSING ONE.

AT PRESENT, THE RIG SHOWN IS ONLY TEMPORARY (THE p\* 75th's at 900w open mounted on the table) AS A NEW DEN IS BEING COMPLETED WHICH WILL HOUSE SEPARATE KW FINALS FOR ALL BANDS FROM 10 THRU 160. THE NEW B&W 5100 WILL BE USED AS THE EXCITER, EXCEPT FOR 160 METERS. VEE BEAMS WILL BE USED ON ALL BANDS EXCEPT 160, WHICH WILL BE A FULL WAVE LONG WIRE OVER 100 FT. HIGH.

DX CONTESTS ARE REALLY ENJOYED, AND IN 1952 AND 1953 HE WON THE CQ CONTEST FOR W6 ON 21mc. ALSO IN 1953 HE HAD HIGH U.S. SCORE FOR THE VK-ZL CONTEST. IN THE A.R.R.L. CONTEST IN 1948 HE WON FOR GERMANY AS D4AVW.

THE COUNTRIES LIST STANDS AT PRESENT AT 170 W & 144 C, AND 39Z.

CONDITIONS HAVE BEEN RATHER GOOD AT TIMES AT THIS QTH. A FEW EXCEPTIONS ARE NEW BCI COMPLAINTS AND TELEPHONE LINE PICK UP. THE P.T.&T. TRUCKS HAVE BEEN OUT HERE IN DROVES. AH.. FOR THE LIFE OF A PHONE MAN! I THINK THE MAIN REASON FOR MY NEW DIFFICULTIES IS THE FACT THAT I CAN NOW MODULATE THE RIG ONE HUNDRED PERCENT. HELLO ROY:

NOV. 5th. 1954.

I WAS VERY HAPPY TO HOOK UP WITH YOU AGAIN ON 7mc. TODAY, CONDITIONS HAVE BEEN COMPARATIVELY POOR THE LAST TWO WEEKS, BUT 40 SEEMS TO BE OPEN TO CALIFORNIA HOW BAD THE BANDS YET MAY BE-HI. I ALSO WORKED W6DFY TODAY, I GOT THE SAME REPORT AS AKE, SM5AOW, WHICH PLEASED ME VERY MUCH AS I HAVE ALWAYS THOUGHT THAT MY 7mc. ANTENNA WAS MUCH POORER THAN HIS. DURING THE LAST FOUR WEEKS I HAVE BEEN ON 7mc. ABOUT THREE DAYS EVERY WEEK AND HAVE MANAGED TO WORK W7SFA, W6LW, W6SN, W6AM, W6EEK, W6DFY, K8CIT.....ALL QSOs HAVE BEEN BETWEEN 1400-1530 GMT. I AM VERY MUCH INTRIGUED WITH THESE PECULIAR PROPAGATION CONDITIONS, AND THAT IS WHY I AM WRITING TO YOU. I BELIEVE THAT QUITE A FEW OF YOU ARE USING BEAMS OF SOME KIND ON 7mc., STUFF LIKE RHOMBICS, VERTICAL BEAMS etc., AND I WOULD BE VERY GLAD TO KNOW FROM WHICH DIRECTION YOU ARE RECEIVING THE EUROPEAN SIGNALS AROUND 1400 - 1500 GMT. ON 7mc. I AM WORKING AT IONOSPHERIC RESEARCH AND SOME GOOD INFO ON THIS WOULD BE VERY VALUABLE TO ME. MY PRIVATE OPINION IS THAT MY SIGNALS GO VIA THE SHORT CIRCUIT OVER THE POLE AND SNEAK DOWN ALONG THE ALASKA COAST TO W6, THAT IS BECAUSE I WORKED AND HEARD A LOT OF JA STATIONS SIMULTANEOUSLY WITH THE W STATIONS. ON THE OTHER HAND SEEMS THE BAND TO BE OPEN TO VK, AP etc. AT THE SAME TIME, BECAUSE IF I SUCCEEDED TO HEAR A VK IN THE TERRIFIC QRM FROM EUROPEANS I GENERALLY HOOK HIM AND GET SOME REPORT LIKE 579 OR 689. THE SIGNALS MIGHT GO VIA THE LONG PATH SOME DAYS, AND I WOULD BE HAPPY TO GET SOME DOPE ON SUCH HAPPENINGS. WHEN I WORKED YOU TODAY YOUR SIGNALS HAD A TERRIFIC ECHO, ALTHOUGH YOU WERE SENDING QUITE QRS AND NO QRM WAS PRESENT YOU WERE VERY HARD TO READ. AT THE SAME TIME VU2AL WAS HEARD WORKING AP2K, BOTH 579, AND A VK WAS A FAINT 349. ON OCT. 18th. HOWEVER, YOUR SIGNALS WERE MUCH MORE STABLE AND YOUR BUG WAS CLEARLY READABLE. THAT DAY SOME JAs CAME THROUGH, BUT NO FAR EAST OR VK SIGNALS.

WELL OM ROY, WOULD APPRECIATE SOME COMMENTS ON THIS, I WILL SEND MY QSL SEPARATELY TO YOU, AND WILL BE VERY HAPPY TO RECEIVE YOURS, THE ONLY W6 CARD I HAVE FOR 40 IS W6MHB AND I WORKED AT LEAST A DOZEN OF YOU IN MY TIME-hi!
