The happy lad in the above photo is the operator of the wireless pump, Horace Greer, known the world over as W6TI.

Horace was first licensed in 1920, at the tender age of 14. The rig then, consisted of a half KW rotary spark and receiving was done with a coherer detector. He graduated to a pair of five watters (205's), then to a pair of UV-211's and a detector and one step home-brew receiver. A receiver made by the wireless shop in San Jose, California was the next gem, followed by a Grebe CR-10, National SW-3, National FB-7, Hammarlund-Pro, and a Hammarlund Super-Pro. After World War II, a BC-610 and a Meissner Signal Shifter as a VFO were installed. The receiver was a Hallicrafter SX-28, later replaced with a National NC-183 with a preselector, all working into an 80 meter dipole which accounted for Post War WAZ certificate #14 (the first Post War WAZ in Northern California) and DXCC #77, both obtained in 1947.

He is a confirmed CW Man and his favorite band is 20 meters. In April 1949 a 20 meter beam was erected which gave W6TI quite a boost. A few years ago a 40 meter groundplane was installed with the help of W6PYH. This addition enabled Horace to work 40 meters when the 20 meter band condx were poor.

"The present transmitter incorporates everything known to modern science", according to Horace, excluding key clicks!

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The final amplifier is a pi-network all band affair with a pair of 4/250 A's built by W6KEV. The amplifier is driven by a TVI proof Collins 310B1 exciter and the receiver is a Collins 75A4 with an 800 cycle mechanical filter which he says is out of this world. His present score is 255 countries worked and 246 confirmed.

Horace is one of the most active members in the NCDXC and is a past president of the club.

Since W2SN has retired, Horace now has the distinction of being the oldest ARRL QSL Manager in terms of service. He has handled the W6-Bureau for over 20 years.
