MINUTES OF NCDXC MEETING OF OCTOBER 8, 1964

THE OCTOBER MEETING OF THE NCDXC WAS HELD 8 OCT. 1964 AT TADDY'S STEAK HOUSE SAN MATEO. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER BY THE PRESIDENT, W6CBE. GUEST PRESENT WERE: HB9VP, DICK SCHWEIZER, W6EGB, GENE ROYER AND XYL, AND G6QB, "TOMMY" THOMAS, AND WASHAE. BILL EITEL, WSUF, TOLD OF HIS PLANNED EXPEDITION TO EASTER ISLAND ON 26 NOVEMBER. BOB THOMPSON, K6SSJ, REPORTED ON PROGRESS IN PLANS FOR THE JOINT MEETING. STUART MEYER, PRESIDENT OF HAMMARLUND MFG. CO., IS EXPECTED TO BE GUEST SPEAKER. THE PRESIDENT WAS REQUESTED TO APPOINT A COMMITTEE TO CONTACT MEMBERS IN REFERENCE TO THE PROPOSED CHANGE OF MEETING NIGHTS TO FRIDAYS INSTEAD OF THURSDAYS. THE FOLLOWING COMMITTEE WAS APPOINTED: W6WX, DAVE BAKER (CHAIRMAN), K6 OHJ, RICH WILDE, W6ZMW, CURT ROCHE W6CBE, RON PANTON. W6KG SUGGESTED THAT A CHANGE IN THE BY-LAWS BE MADE TO A SIMPLE MAJORITY OF MEMBERSHIP INSTEAD OF THE PRESENT 2/3 VOTE OF MEMBERSHIP FOR ACCEPTANCE OF AN AMENDMENT. THE SUGGESTION WAS NOT ACTED UPON. JOE HORVATH, W6GPB, MADE A PERSONAL PRESENTATION OF CALIFORNIA AWARD #70 TO TOMMY THOMAS, G6QB. AFTER THE GENERAL DX DISCUSSION, THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED.

EXCEPT ON THE FRIDAY MORNING AFTER A NCDXC THURSDAY NIGHT MEETING. THEN, I DRAG MYSELF TO WORK ON FRIDAY MORNING WITH THE FEELING THAT OLD AGE IS HERE. AT THIS MOMENT I MENTALLY FIGURE JUST HOW LONG IT WILL BE TILL THE NEXT FRIDAY NIGHT MEETING. WE HAVE FOUR FRIDAY MEETINGS YEARLY. THEN THE OUT OF TOWN MEMBERS SHOW UP, AND WE OLD GUYS STAY OUT LATE CHEWING THE FAT FOR A CHANGE.

WHEN THE CLUB WAS FORMED, (SO I AM TOLD) THE MEETINGS WERE HELD ON THURSDAYS IN DEFERENCE TO W6TI PROBLEM ABOUT MAKING FRIDAY MEETINGS. I AM SORRY THAT HORACE IS NO LONGER HERE TO ARGUE THE SUBJECT, BUT I HAVE YET TO MEET THE MEMBER THAT PREFERS THURSDAY MEETINGS. IN OUR LAST ATTEMPT TO CHANGE THE MEETING NIGHT TO FRIDAY, SOME MEMBERS DID VOTE FOR THURSDAY, BUT THE ABSTAINING VOTES SHOT US DOWN, AS THEY COUNTED AS NAY VOTES. WE WOULD LIKE TO TRY AGAIN, BUT BEFORE WE GO TO THE CLUB EXPENSE IN SUCH AN ATTEMPT, WE WOULD LIKE SOME INDICATION AS TO MEMBERS PREFERENCES. IF WE DO AGAIN SEND OUT BALLOTS, WE WILL FOLLOW THEM UP WITH A PHONE CALL TO ASCERTAIN IF THE CARD HAS BEEN RETURNED. PLEASE SAVE US MONEY AND IF YOU ARE AGAINST FRIDAY MEETINGS, DROP US A CARD NOW.

IN CASE SOME OF YOU HAVE FORGOTTEN, TO CHANGE THE MEETING NIGHTS, REQUIRES A 2/3 MAJORITY OF THE ENTIRE MEMBERSHIP. THIS, AT THE PRESENT TIME REQUIRES AT LEAST 57 MEMBERS VOTING IN FAVOR. WE NOW HAVE 85 FULL MEMBERS. I FEEL THAT THE OUT OF TOWN MEMBERS DON'T BOTHER TO VOTE. IN LOOKING OVER THE MEMBERSHIP ROSTER, I SEE 19 CALLS THAT I HAVE NEVER SEEN AT A MEETING. SOME OF THESE FELLOWS LIVE IN SPOTS LIKE RED BLUFF, BAKERSFIELD, WASCO, CARMICHAEL, DELANO, AND SUSANVILLE. I HOPE THESE MEMBERS WILL HELP US THIS TIME TO MOVE THE NIGHT TO FRIDAY, AS IT CAN'T POSSIBLY MAKE ANY DIFFERENCE TO THEM.

WELL, MAYBE IT'S TIME TO REVIEW AND START THINKING ABOUT WHAT YOU WOULD DO IF YOU HAD THE CHANCE TO MAKE DXCC ANYTHING YOU YOURSELF PERSONALLY WOULD DO IF YOU HAD THE CHANCE TO REWRITE ALL THE RULES. ONE OF THESE DAYS THE QUESTION OF DXCC IS BOUND TO COME UP FOR REVIEW BY ARRL'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS (THEY REQUESTED A REVIEW OF CONTESTS--ET VOILA--A ONE WEEK SS). LET'S BE CAUGHT WITH SOME GOOD IDEAS. MAYBE WE CAN DISCUSS SOME OF THE POSSIBILITIES AT A CLUB MEETING SOON. (WE'LL ARRANGE FOR WEEKEND ACCOMODATIONS). THOSE NCDXC MEMBERS OUTSIDE THE SF AREA (AND ALL READERS ACROSS USA AND OVERSEAS) ARE INVITED AND URGED TO HONOR US WITH SUGGESTIONS. WRITE TO THE DXER, BOX 608, MENLO PARK, CALIFORNIA.

EASTER ISLAND. NCDXC MEMBER BILL EITEL, W6UF, REPORTS THAT HE AND ED CUSHING, W4QVJ, WILL USE THE CALL CE3AJ FROM AKU-AKU-LAND. ETA AT CE3 IS NOW SET FOR NO. 29, ALTHO THIS IS NOT YET ABSOLUTELY FIRM. THEY WILL MAKE THE FLIGHT FROM SANTIAGO IN A PBY. 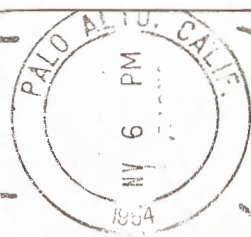
