W6BHY and W6CUF were retained as team captains for the upcoming ARRL Test. K6SSJ reported on finalized plans for the Joint Convention on January 21st and 22nd. W6GPB announced the bus schedule, which will be in the January issue of the DX'er. Cost is \$10 per, to be mailed to Joe or paid upon boarding the bus.

W6MUC moved, and W6DZZ seconded, that a letter be sent to Tom Hall, W6SC, expressing the club concern over his illness and wishing him well. Approved.
