

NOW THAT THE 1967 EDITION OF THE JOINT CONVENTION OF THE NCDXC AND THE SCDXC IS A MEMORY, A PLEASANT ONE FOR MOST OF US I SUPPOSE, WE ALL SHOULD THANK BOB THOMPSON, K6SSJ, FOR THE MANY HOURS AND DOLLARS THAT HE DONATED TO THE CAUSE. WITHOUT HIM TO COORDINATE THE AFFAIR AS HE DID, I AM CERTAIN THAT THE EVENT WOULD HAVE BEEN MUCH LESS ENJOYABLE. I SUPPOSE THAT A GREAT MANY OF US HAVE BUT AN INDISTINCT AND FOGGY MEMORY OF WHAT OCCURED IN FRESNO, BUT STILL KNOW THAT THEY MET THE COMPETITION.

HOWEVER, THE PRINCIPAL TOPIC OF DISCUSSION REMAINS UNRESOLVED AS IS TO BE EXPECTED; SPECIFICALLY, WHETHER-OR-NOT DXPEDITIONS SHOULD BE SPONSORED BY AMATEURS. BECAUSE OF THE PRESENT METHOD OF ADMINISTRATION OF THE DX AWARDS BY THE ARRL, A PREMIUM IS PLACED UPON MAINTAINING A POSITION IN THE PECKING ORDER PUBLISHED BIANNUALLY IN "QST". OFTEN THE POSSESSION OF ONE QSL WILL DETERMINE WHETHER-OR-NOT AN INDIVIDUAL QUALIFIES FOR THE "HONOR ROLE", AND THEREBY IS ADMITTED INTO THE INNER CIRCLE. CONSEQUENTLY, A "NEW COUNTRY" HAS AN INTRINSIC VALUE, AND THE SECURING OF A CONFIRMATION FOR HAVING WORKED A STATION BECOMES A MATTER OF GREAT IMPORTANCE. VARIOUS METHODS ARE USED, MOST OF THEM LEGAL, BUT THE FACT REMAINS THAT WHAT IS BEING PLAYED IS A GAME. "ONE UPMANSHIP" IS THE PRIME MOTIVATION FOR MOST OF US WHO PLAY IT AND IT DOES BECOME A QUITE EXPENSIVE PROPOSITION FOR MOST OF US. TO ADD INTEREST TO A SPORT A GOAL IS NECESSARY, AND THE WORKING OF NEW COUNTRIES IS INDEED A LEGITIMATE ONE FOR THOSE OF US WHO WORK DX.

FOR VARIOUS REASONS, A SIGNIFICANT NUMBER OF PLACES THAT ARE OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZED BY THE ARRL AS COUNTRIES HAVE NO ACTIVE HAMS AND ARE THEREFORE NOT NORMALLY AVAILABLE TO THOSE OF US WHO DO HAVE AN ACTIVE INTEREST IN CHASING DX. WHEN A FELLOW SUCH AS GUS OR DON MILLER, WHO APPARENTLY GREATLY ENJOY WORKING THOUSANDS OF FELLOWS FROM REMOTE AND NOT UNUSUALLY INHOSPITABLE PLACES UNDER THE WORST POSSIBLE CONDITIONS APPEARS, IN MY OPINION HE SHOULD BE ENCOURAGED. A PROBLEM OF FINANCING OCCURS, HOWEVER, IN MOST SITUATIONS, AS NOT MANY OF US ARE SO WEALTHY THAT WE COULD AFFORD AN EXTENDED TRIP OUTSIDE OF THE COUNTRY. SO, WHAT POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS TO THE PROBLEM EXIST? EFFECTIVELY ELIMINATE THE DXPEDITION BY INVALIDATING ALL QSLs THAT HAVE BEEN ISSUED BY ANY BUT A NATIONAL OF THE COUNTRY; REQUIRE A "DONATION" BEFORE EITHER A QSL WILL BE SENT OR A CALL HEARD; APPEAL TO SENSE OF SPORTSMANSHIP AND CHARITY OF THOSE WHO DO HAVE AN INTEREST IN CHASING DX AND ASK THAT A DONATION BE MADE, WHILE AT THE SAME TIME, NOT ACKNOWLEDGING THAT ANY SPECIAL PRIVILEGE WILL BE GRANTED TO THOSE WHO DO CONTRIBUTE, OR TO SIMPLY STATE THAT A CONTEMPLATED DXPEDITION IS IMPOSSIBLE UNTIL SUFFICIENT FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE TO FINANCE IT. THE PROBLEM IS FAR FROM SIMPLE AND ENOUGH TO DISCOURAGE ANYONE BUT A DEDICATED INDIVIDUAL. IT IS CERTAINLY TO THE CREDIT TO THOSE FEW WHO HAVE SUCCEEDED IN GIVING A NEW COUNTRY TO THE GREAT MAJORITY FOR SO LITTLE EXCEPT SATISFACTION. OF COURSE, A GREAT DEAL OF PRESTIGE IS AVAILABLE, BUT IT IS A RATHER INTANGIBLE REWARD AND PEOPLE HAVE BEEN KNOWN TO STARVE ON A STEADY DIET OF IT. ASK GUS HOW MUCH WEIGHT HE GAINED ON HIS LONG TRIPS.

AS A TOPIC OF DISCUSSION, DXPEDITION FINANCING WILL CONTINUE TO BE A VERY POPULAR ONE FOR A LONG WHILE I BELIEVE.

MOTION WAS MADE BY BOB VALLIO W6RGG AND SECONDED BY JAY JUDD W6UMI THAT READING OF THE MINUTES OF THE DECEMBER, 1966 MEETING BE WAIVED. MOTION WAS CARRIED.

JOE BUTLER K6CAZ WAS ANNOUNCED AS TAKING OVER THE REINS OF SECTY-TREAS FROM LEE SHAKLEE W6PQW EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY, 1967.

FIRST READINGS WERE GIVEN TO THE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS OF JACK MINTZ W6WLO, JOSEPH BRIDGES WA6YMX AND ROSS W. FORBES WB6GFJ. SECOND READINGS WERE GIVEN TO THE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS OF WALTER J. COOPER W6CDJ AND ROLLIN M. GALSTER WA6OIU AND BOTH WALT AND ROLLIN WERE VOTED INTO FULL MEMBERSHIP.

BRAD WYATT W6VUW AND LEE SHAKLEE W6PQW WERE NOMINATED AND VOTED IN AS DIRECTORS BY ACCLAMATION.

BOB THOMPSON K6SSJ REPORTED ON THE PROGRESS OF ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE FRESNO CONVENTION AND IN PARTICULAR ON THE MEALS AND SERVICES THAT ARE BEING GIVEN FOR THE \$ 10.00 REGISTRATION FEE. BOB ALSO REPORTED THAT HERB KLINE KIIMP WILL BE PRESENT AND SPEAK IN PLACE OF DON MILLER WHO WILL NOT BE PRESENT AT THE CONVENTION DUE TO HIS PRESENT INDIAN OCEAN DXPEDITION. BOB ALSO READ A LETTER FROM WILLIAM GRENFELL W4GF IN REPLY TO AN INQUIRY TO THE FCC IN REGARDS TO THEIR POSITION ON THE USE OF "HIGH POWER" BY THE AMATEUR RADIO FRATERNITY. TO SUM THE LETTER UP, "DON'T DO IT". IT WAS SUGGESTED THAT THIS LETTER BE READ AT THE FRESNO CONVENTION.

JOE HORVATH W6GPB REPORTED THAT HE NOW HAS FULL CAPACITY PLUS, FOR THE BUS TRIP TO FRESNO AND THAT WITH APPROXIMATELY 8 TO 10 MORE PEOPLE DESIRING TO GO BY BUS, A SECOND BUS CAN BE SECURED. MEMBERS WERE ADVISED THAT THOSE DESIRING TO GO BY BUS AND WHO ARE NOT ALREADY ON THE LIST, TO NOTIFY EITHER JOE HORVATH OR DAVE BAKER BEFORE WED. JANUARY 18TH.

JIM NEIGER W6BHY SHYLY REPORTED THAT THE BLUE TEAM LITERALLY WALKED AWAY WITH THE INTRA-CLUB CONTEST IN THE CQ WORLD WIDE DX CONTEST. HE ALSO STATED THAT THE SAME TEAM MEMBERS WILL BE IN EFFECT FOR THE ARRL DX CONTEST. RULE CHANGES WERE ALSO DISCUSSED.

JIM MAXWELL W6CUF, RED TEAM LEADER, CRIED A SERIES OF DISCONNECTED UTTERANCES, PLAINLY SHOWING THE DISAPPOINTMENT IN LOSING TO THE BLUE TEAM. HE WAS PROMPTLY HANDED THE CRYING TOWEL WHEREUPON MR. MAXWELL DRIED HIS EYES AND DECLARED THE RED TEAM WOULD DO BETTER IN THE ARRL DX CONTEST.

VERN HOWARD W6ERS REPORTED ON THE PROGRESS OF THE CLUB AFFILIATION WITH THE ASIA FOUNDATION OF THE DISTRIBUTION OF HAND BOOKS, CALL BOOKS AND OTHER AMATEUR RADIO INFORMATION SENT TO APPROX. 30 ORGANIZATIONS. VERN ALSO REPORTED THAT THE ARRL HAS BEEN SENT A REPORT OF THE PROGRESS OF THIS COMMITTEE AND STATED THAT ALL BOOKS DONATED BY CLUB MEMBERS FOR USE IN THIS WORK WILL BE HELD IN ESCROW AT HIS QTH UNTIL SUCH TIME AS DISPOSITION CAN BE MADE.

LEE SHAKLEE W6PQW BROUGHT UP AND DISCUSSED THE PROBABILITY OF CHANGING THE LOCATION OF PRINTING OF THE DXER TO A LOCAL IN THE VICINITY OF BOX 608, MENLO PARK SO THAT CLOSER LIAISON MAY BE MAINTAINED BETWEEN THE EDITOR AND THE PRINTER OF THE DXER. BOB THOMPSON K6SSJ REPORTED ON AVAILABILITY AND COST OF OFFSET PRINTING IN THIS AREA. IT IS HOPED THAT THIS MOVE WOULD ALLOW PRINTING OF THE DXER AT A COST OF \$ 30.00 TO \$ 35.00 VERSUS \$ 55.00 TO \$ 60.00 CURRENT MONTHLY CHARGE. PRESIDENT DAVE BAKER W6WX APPOINTED K6SSJ, W6PQW AND W6PHF AS A COMMITTEE TO INVESTIGATE AND REPORT AT THE FEBRUARY MEETING.

W4YZE PLAYED A TAPE RECORDED IN ASIA OF A NUMBER OF THE NCDXC MEMBERS AS HEARD IN THE PILE-UPS DURING THE CQ WORLD WIDE CONTEST. NEEDLESS TO SAY, THE OWNERS OF THOSE STATIONS RECORDED AND PLAYED BACK WERE PLEASANTLY SURPRISED AT THE LOUD SIGNALS THEIR RESPECTIVE STATIONS WERE PUTTING INTO ASIA. OUR THANKS TO W4YZE.

AN INTERESTING ROUND TABLE FOLLOWED AND THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED AT 11:45 P.M.
