

NOW THAT THE ARRL HAS MADE IT'S DECISION TO DISALLOW CREDIT FOR DON MILLERS' RECENT EFFORTS, IT WOULD WISE TO COMPLETELY EVALUATE WHAT HAS OCCURED. HOWEVER, AT THE PRESENT TIME, THE ARRL HAS NOT RELEASED SUFFICIENT INFORMATION TO PERMIT ONE TO COME TO THE SAME CONCLUSION AS THE AWARDS "COMMITTEE". AFTER READING THE PROCLAMATION SEVERAL TIMES, I CAME TO THE CONCLUSION THAT BECAUSE OF THE VAGUE WORDING AND THE APPARENT RELUCTANCE TO SPECIFICALLY NAME ANY PARTY, THAT THE COMMITTEE FEELS UNCERTAIN THAT IT CAN JUSTIFY ITS' DECISION. IT WOULD BE IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE DXCC AWARD IF THE "COMMITTEE" AT THIS TIME WOULD COMPLETELY REVEAL ITS' SOURCES OF INFORMATION AND THEREBY ALLOW THE REST OF US TO EITHER CONFIRM OR DENY THAT THE APPROPRIATE DECISION HAS BEEN REACHED.

ONE CONCLUDES AFTER READING THE "PROCLAMATION" THAT CERTAIN UNNAMED INDIVIDUALS BELIEVE THAT THEY HAVE BEEN SLIGHTED IN NOT BEING ABLE TO WORK DON WHEN THEY BELIEVE THAT THEY SHOULD HAVE. BUT BECAUSE THE "COMMITTEE" HAS NOT BEEN SPECIFIC IN ITS' ACCUSATIONS AND IN THE REVELATION OF ITS' SOURCES OF INFORMATION, I BELIEVE THAT THE DECISION IS UNJUSTIFIED. TO DECIDE, THAT BECAUSE OF AN APPARENT DISCREPANCY, DOUBT IS JUSTIFIED IN WHETHER-OR-NOT LEGAL OPERATION OCCURED FROM ONE QTH, THAT ALL SHOULD BE SUSPECTED, IS ARBITRARY AND CAPRICIOUS AND REMINDS ONE OF THE METHODS USED BY THE INQUISITION TO ENCOURAGE ACCEPTANCE OF DOGMA. IN ORDER FOR THE "COMMITTEE" TO JUSTIFY ITS' POSITION, IT WILL NECESSARY FOR EVIDENCE OF LEGAL OPERATION FROM EACH PLACE BE SUBMITTED AND INDIVIDUALLY EVALUATED, RATHER THAN TO REJECT ALL OF THE CLAIMS.

CERTAINLY, IF THE "COMMITTEE" WISHED TO DISCONTINUE THE DXCC AWARD A BETTER WAY COULD NOT HAVE BEEN CHOSEN, AS THE NUMBER OF "LEGITIMATE" COUNTRIES IS SOMEWHAT LIMITED AND IN ORDER TO PREVENT STAGNATION OF THE "HONOR ROLL", STIMULATION OF INTEREST IS REQUIRED TO PREVENT THE EVENTUAL ATROPHY OF THE AWARD. THE CREATION OF NEW "COUNTRIES" HAS BECOME THE MEANS OF STIMULATING INTEREST, BUT APPARENTLY THE CRITERIA USED FOR THE DETERMINATION OF THE VALIDITY OF COUNTRY CLAIMS HAS BECOME INCREASINGLY INCONSISTENT. THE "COMMITTEE" HAS VERY EFFECTIVELY CREATED A MEANS FOR THE EVENTUAL DESTRUCTION OF THE DXCC AWARD BY CREATING DOUBT IN THE MINDS OF THOSE WHO WOULD HAVE PARTICIPATED IN DX'PEDITIONS TO AREAS FROM WHICH LITTLE OR NO ACTIVITY AMATEUR ACTIVITY OCCURS. WILL ANYONE FEEL THAT IT IS WORTH HIS TIME, FINANCES AND HEALTH TO JOURNEY TO ANY "RARE COUNTRY" FOR THE SAKE OF GIVING A "NEW ONE" TO APPROXIMATELY 3000 INTERESTED INDIVIDUALS, WHEN ALL OF HIS EFFORTS CAN BE NEGATED AT THE WHIM A "COMMITTEE" NOT KNOWN FOR ITS' CONSISTENCY OF DECISION?

I AM AFRAID THAT THE RESULT OF THE DECISION REGARDING DON MILLER WILL NOT BE THE ONE EXPECTED BY THE "COMMITTEE", AND WILL CREATE INSTEAD, ENOUGH ILL WILL AMONG THOSE OF US INTERESTED IN CHASING DX THAT FURTHER CONSIDERATION OF ITS' DECISION WILL BE NECESSARY. THE LAST DOG HAS YET TO HOWL.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 9:45 P. M. BY PRESIDENT DAVE BAKER-W6WX. 37 PEOPLE WERE PRESENT INCLUDING GUESTS PADDY GUNESAKERA-4S7PB, RUBIN HUGHES WA6AHF, PETE VON SIVERS-WB6DOQ AND JOSEPH BRIDGES-WA6YMX. MINUTES OF THE JANUARY MEETING WERE READ AND APPROVED. REPORT FROM THE TREASURY WAS:

BOB THOMPSON-K6SSJ REPORTED THAT THE 1967 FRESNO CONVENTION WAS A COMPLETE SUCCESS WITH MUCH FEWER COMPLAINTS THAN IN THE PAST AND IN GENERAL COMMENTS WERE GOOD. A VOTE OF THANKS TO BOB FROM THE CLUB FOR A JOB WELL DONE. REPORTS WERE HEARD FROM THE BLUE TEAM LEADER JIM NEIGER-W6BHY AND THE RED TEAM LEADER JIM MAXWELL-W6CUF WITH BOTH CAPTAINS PREDICTING THEIR RESPECTIVE TEAMS WOULD WIN THE INTER-CLUB COMPETITION.

SECOND READINGS WERE GIVEN TO THE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS OF JACK MINTZ-W6WLO JOSEPH BRIDGES-WA6YMX AND ROSS FORBES-WB6GFT. ALL THREE APPLICANTS WERE VOTED INTO THE CLUB.

LEE SHAKLEE-W6PQW WAS APPOINTED TO REPRESENT THE NCDXC AT THE FORTHCOMING PACIFIC DIRECTORS MEETING. THE CLUB AGREED BY HAND COUNT THAT THE PROPOSITION BROUGHT UP BY HERB KLINE TO PETITION ARRL IN REGARD TO THEIR POSITION ON THE KIIMP/KC4 NAVASSA OPERATION BE INCLUDED BY LEE SHAKLEE AS ONE OF THE ITEMS ON HIS AGENDA TO BE PRESENTED AT THE PACIFIC DIRECTORS MEETING.

JIM MAXWELL-W6CUF POINTED OUT THE DISCREPENCIES THAT MAY EXIST IN THE STANBINGS OF COUNTRIES WORKED/CONFIRMED REPORTED BY THE INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS FOR PUBLICATION IN THE DXER. DAVE PALMER-W6PHF WAS ASKED TO CORRESPOND WITH BOB WHITE OF THE ARRL AND SECURE INFORMATION OF THE MAXIMUM COUNTRIES CURRENTLY POSSIBLE LESS DELETIONS, AND PUBLISH FINDINGS IN THE DXER.

THE SECTY-TREAS. WAS DIRECTED BY PRESIDENT DAVE BAKER TO CONTACT GUS BROWNING AND INQUIRE AS TO THE CLUB TALK AND SLIDE FILMS AVAILABLE FOR RENTAL. THE SECTY-TREAS. WAS FURTHER DIRECTED TO CORRESPOND WITH JOHN HUNTOON OF ARRL AND REMIND ARRL THAT NCDXC IS AN ARRL AFFILIATE CLUB, AND ADVISE HIM OF THE CLUB OFFICERS AND P. O. BOX NUMBER.
