

DX CHASING TO THE INEXPERIENCED IS OFTEN A FRUSTRATING AND APPARENTLY DIABOLICAL PLOT TO DESTROY THE MIND. DX CONTESTS AND DX-PEDITIONS ARE MERELY SKIRMISHES PRECEDING THE FINAL ONE THAT WILL BE TERMED ARMAGED-ON, BUT ALL SHOULD TAKE HEART, FOR AN INFALLIBLE METHOD OF LOCATING DX OF ALL DEGREES OF RARITY HAS BEEN DISCOVERED. FOR THE WANT OF A BETTER NAME IT WILL BE CALLED THE FRUSTRATION FACTOR, AND THE PRINCIPAL CAN BE USED EFFECTIVELY BY ALL DX CHASERS. A GREAT DEAL OF TIME CAN BE SAVED, PARTICULARLY DURING DX CONTESTS AND A PERSON WHO ASPIRES TO BECOME A "BIG DX'ER" BEFORE HE IS FINALLY LAID TO REST CAN USE IT TO EQUALLY GOOD ADVANTAGE. WHY THE PRINCIPAL HAS NOT BEEN USED BEFORE THIS TIME WILL PROBABLY NEVER BE KNOWN, BUT THE TIME HAS FINALLY COME THAT IT SHOULD BE DISCLOSED.

STATED SIMPLY, THE PRINCIPAL IS THAT THE INTENSITY AND THE DURATION OF QRM ON THE FREQUENCY OF THE RARE ONE ARE INVERSELY PROPORTIONAL TO THE SIGNAL STRENGTH, DEGREE OF RARITY, LID FACTOR AND AMOUNT OF SOUR GRAPES. WHEN PROPERLY APPLIED MUCH TIME CAN BE SAVED WHEN RAPIDLY SCANNING A BAND AS THE RARE ONES ARE INVARIABLY TO BE FOUND UNDER THE MOST HORRENDOUS DOG PILES, WHILE THE MORE COMMON ONES ARE ASSOCIATED WITH PROPORTIONATLY LESS QRM.

CLASSIC EXAMPLES OF THE FUNCTIONING OF THE PRINCIPAL AND ITS' VARIOUS SECONDARY EFFECTS WERE PARTICULARLY EVIDENT DURING THE PAST SEVERAL MONTHS AS A FEW DX-PEDITIONS AND SEVERAL CONTESTS OCCURED DURING THAT TIME. ALL THAT IS REQUIRED TO LOCATE THE "RARE ONE" IS TO FIND THE MOST OBNOXIOUS LID QRM AND TO LISTEN CAREFULLY A FEW CYCLES TO EITHER SIDE OF HIS SIGNAL TO FIND THE DESIRED STATION. PERHAPS THE NEXT ADVAN-CEMENT IN THE STATE OF THE ART WILL BE THE "LID FILTER", BUT MUCH R&D IS NECESSARY INTO THE POORLY EXPLORED FIELD OF SOUR GRAPES.

BY PRESIDENT DAVE BAKER-W6WX. 45 PEOPLE WERE PRESENT INCLUDING GUESTS. GUESTS WERE ARRL PACIFIC DIVISION DIRECTOR HARRY ENGWICHT-W6HC, W6PTS, K6CQF, K6YGS, VE3DXV/6, WB6KIG, WB6DOQ, WB6ICM AND WA6AHF.

JIM NEIGER-W6BHY AND JIM MAXWELL-W6CUF REPORTED ON BLUE AND RED TEAM SUCCESS IN THE PHONE PORTION OF THE ARRL DX TEST.

FIRST READING WAS GIVEN TO THE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION OF PETER "PETE" VON SIVERS-WB6DOQ.

PRESIDENT BAKER REPORTED ON THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS WHICH WAS CALLED TO DISCUSS PROPOSALS TO CHANGE THE STRUCTURE OF THE ARRL DXCC AWARD COMMITTEE AND THE ARRL SUSPENSION OF CERTAIN OF DON MILLER'S OPERATIONS.

HARRY ENGWICHT-W6HC WAS INTRODUCED AND HARRY READ THE COMMUNICATION THAT WAS SENT TO ALL ARRL DIRECTORS CONCERNING THE SPECIAL MEETING AT ARRL HEADQUARTERS BETWEEN DON MILLER AND THE AWARDS COMMITTEE.

VICE-PRESIDENT BOB VALLIO-W6RGG READ TO THE MEMBERSHIP A PROPOSAL TO MODIFY THE CURRENT ARRL AWARDS COMMITTEE AND ITS ADMINISTRATION OF THE DXCC AWARD. AFTER PRO AND CON ARGUMENTS IT WAS MOVED BY JIM MAXWELL-W6CUF AND SECONDED BY JIM NEIGER-W6BHY TO HAVE THE CLUB SECRETARY TRANSMIT THE PROPOSAL TO THE ARRL AND ALL OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES. THE QUESTION WAS CALLED AND A MAJORITY VOTE BY SHOW OF HANDS CARRIED THE MOTION. 16 FOR, 8 AGAINST AND 12 ABSTAINED.

LEE SHAKLEE-W6PQW WAS CALLED UPON TO READ TO THE MEMBERSHIP A SUMMATION OF THE ARRL CHARGES AGAINST DON MILLER AND DON MILLER'S REBUTTAL TO THE CHARGES. JIM NEIGER-W6BHY READ A COPY OF HIS PERSONAL LETTER OF OBJECTION ABOUT THE DON MILLER SUSPENSION WHICH HE HAD SENT TO THE ARRL. A PRO AND CON DISCUSSION FOLLOWED. IT WAS MOVED BY BOB VALLIO-W6RGG AND SECONDED BY AL BURNHAM-K6RIM THAT THE CLUB SECRETARY TRANSMIT THE LETTER OF SUMMATION TO THE ARRL AND ALL INTERESTED PARTIES. THE QUESTION WAS CALLED AND A VOTE BY HAND COUNT SHOWED 10 FOR, 8 AGAINST AND 18 ABSTAINING. THE MOTION WAS CARRIED.

THE MONTHLY ACTIVITY ROUND TABLE FOLLOWED AND THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED AT 11:00 P. M.
