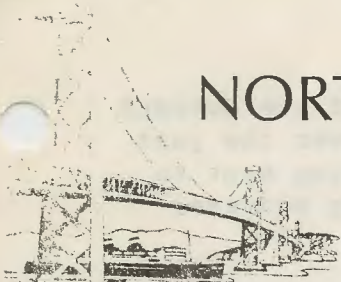

THE MAY MEETING OF THE NCDXC WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 9:08 P.M. BY PRESIDENT DAVE BAKER-W6WX. THERE WERE 38 PERSONS PRESENT INCLUDING GUESTS WB6CQY, WB6K1G, W6CYX, W6KNH AND WB6UJO. MINUTES OF THE APRIL MEETING WERE READ AND APPROVED.

PRESIDENT BAKER READ TO THE MEMBERSHIP A COPY OF THE MAY 4TH LETTER FROM THE ARRL REGARDING THE OPERATIONS OF DR. DONALD A. MILLER-W9WNV. THIS LETTER ANNOUNCED THE REINSTATEMENT OF THE DXCC AWARD OF DR. MILLER AND THE LIFTING OF THE SUSPENSION ON CERTAIN OF HIS DX OPERATIONS EXCEPT THE KIIMP/KCL NAVASSA AND VU2WNV-LACCADIVE OPERATIONS WHICH REMAIN SUSPENDED. DAVE ALSO READ DON'S REPLY TO THE ARRL.

SECOND READINGS WERE GIVEN THE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS OF K6CQF, W6KNH AND WA6AHF. ALL APPLICANTS WERE VOTED INTO MEMBERSHIP.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY EDDIE HOETZEL-W6DZZ TO ADD THE NCDXC PREAMBLE TO THE DX'ER. SECONDED BY JACK MINTZ-W6WLO. MOTION CARRIED.

IT WAS ANNOUNCED BY JIM MAXWELL-W6CUF AND CONCEDED BY JIM NEIGER-W6BHY THAT THE WINNER OF THE INTRA-CLUB DX CONTEST IS THE "RED TEAM".

VICE-PRESIDENT BOB VALLIO-W6RGG REPORTED ON THE PACIFIC DIVISION DIRECTORS MEETING ATTENDED BY HIMSELF AND DON SCHLIESSER-WA6UFW AS REPRESENTITIVES OF THE NCDXC.

WALT COOPER-W6CDJ AND JOE BUTLER-K6CAZ WERE APPOINTED BY PRESIDENT BAKER AS NCDXC COORDINATORS WITH THE SCDXC ON THE COMING ARRL CONVENTION TO BE HELD IN LOS ANGELES ON SEPTEMBER 8, 9, 10 1967.

JIM MAXWELL-W6CUF WAS APPOINTED THE NEW EDITOR OF THE "CURRENT AND CHOICE" SECTION OF THE NCDXC DX'ER, REPLACING JAY JUDD-W6UMI WHO IS RELINQUISHING THE POST DUE TO OTHER COMMITMENTS. JIM NEIGER-W6BHY PRESENTED A WELL ACCEPTED TALK ON "DX CONTEST OPERATING".

ED ALEKS-K6DXM PROPOSED TO THE MEMBERSHIP A CULTURAL EXCHANGE OF TOP DXERS BETWEEN RUSSIA AND THE U.S. TO BE CO-SPONSORED BY THE NCDXC, ARRL AND THE U.S. STATE DEPT. IT WAS MOVED BY RAY BALCH-W6ESI AND SECONDED BY STEVE EICHMAN-WA6IVN THAT THIS PROPOSAL BE ACCEPTED BY THE CLUB. MOTION CARRIED AND PRESIDENT BAKER APPOINTED THE FOLLOWING COMMITTEE TO PURSUE THE PROPOSAL: ED ALEKS-K6DXM CHAIRMAN, DAVE BAKER-W6WX, BILL EITEL-W6UF AND JOHN TROSTER-W61SQ.

Each issue consists of 2 to 6 pages (usually 4) mimeographed, legal size. The first two pages usually consist of hot tips, rumors, coming events, contests, etc., while the remainder have listings of rare to semi-rare stuff worked over the previous week. Price for one year airmail: \$6.00 to VERON, Postbus 9, Amsterdam.
