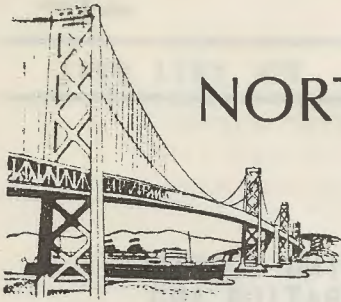

THERE WERE 93 PERSONS PRESENT INCLUDING GUESTS: DON MILLER-W9WNV, BILL RINDONE-WA6SBO, K6VTC, W6AOI, WB6KIG, W6PTS, W6CYO, W6VWY, W6GHG, W6ETR, W6ZMU, W6YZ, K6YGS, WA6GQC, VE3DXV/6, WB6KRW, WB6ICM, W6MVL, W2CEI, WA6AGC AND XYL, XYL OF K6ERV, XYL OF W6CLS AND K6BPR OF THE SCDXC.

MINUTES OF THE MAY 1967 MEETING WERE READ AND APPROVED.

FIRST (1ST) READINGS WERE GIVEN THE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS OF DAVID W. DEGREGORI-W6KOE, JOHN G. GIBSON-K6YGS AND BILL HANSEN-W6PTS.

ELECTION OF CLUB OFFICERS FOLLOWED AND JIM NEIGER-W6BHY NOMINATED JIM MAXWELL-W6CUF FOR PRESIDENT. JAY JUDD-W6UMI MOVED THAT NOMINATIONS BE CLOSED. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY LEE SHAKLEE-W6PQW. THE VOTE WAS CALLED AND MR. MAXWELL WAS ELECTED PRESIDENT BY ACCLAMATION.

NOMINATIONS FOR VICE-PRESIDENT WERE STEVE EICHMANN-WA6IVN AND ED ALEKS-K6DXM, (BY UNKNOWN ASSAILANTS). JAY JUDD-W6UMI MOVED THAT NOMINATIONS BE CLOSED. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY JACK STEVENTON-W6CLS. BALLOTING SHOWED 33 VOTES FOR K6DXM AND 16 VOTES FOR WA6IVN. ED ALEKS-K6DXM WAS ELECTED AS INCOMING VICE-PRESIDENT.

JOE BUTLER-K6CAZ WAS NOMINATED FOR A SECOND TERM AS SECRETARY/TREASURER BY AN UNKNOWN "FRIEND". NOMINATION WAS SECONDED BY MASS COLLUSION AND K6CAZ WAS VOTED IN AS SECRETARY/TREASURER BY ACCLAMATION.

DOUG MURRAY-W6HVN MOVED FOR ADJOURNMENT. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY LEE SHAKLEE-W6PQW AND MEETING WAS ADJOURNED AT 9:38 P. M.

THE MEETING WAS THEN TURNED OVER TO DON MILLER-W9WNV AND BILL RINDONE-WA6SBO WHO SHOWED SLIDES OF PREVIOUS DXPEDITIONS AND OUTLINED PLANS FOR FUTURE DXPEDITIONS TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY THEM AS A TEAM.

ATTENTION ALL DXers, DX PUBLICATIONS, AND CLUBS

Bill Rindone, WA6SBO, and Don Miller, W9WNV, are departing the USA on June 30th, to continue the 1965-1967 World-Wide DXpedition. The itinerary is not announced, but all DXers will be notified in advance as described herein. A number of rare and new countries will be included.

- 2. There will be more CW, more operation on all DX bands, 10 through 80 mtrs, and 160 mtrs when possible. There may be two stations in operation simultaneously (E.G., 14 Mcs SSB and CW or  $\&$  and 14 Mcs). Frequencies:

- 3. Receiving Frequencies: will be announced by operators while on-the-air. We will make QST announcements of plans three times daily during operations on normal operating frequencies:
  - 1500 GMT
  - 1900 GMT
  - 2300 GMT

If necessary, in addition to the above announcements, special announcements will be immediately forwarded to all Stateside Bulletins by the LIDXA, and to European Bulletins via Geoff Watts.

- 4. The ARRL Operating Codes will apply as closely as possible, and we will avoid working amateurs who are constant violators of the listed ethics. The policy of Direct QSL's still applies. QSL's via Manager are 100%.
- 5. Contributions have been sufficient to continue the Dxpediton. Checks may be made payable to Don Miller, Donald Miller, MD, WRpsa, Bill Rindone, DXpedition, DX Expedition, Etc., and information will be supplied, on request regarding tax deductions, for those making checks to WRPSA.
- 6. All SWL's go via VE3GCO  
All QSL's go via WA6SBO, and will be handled by Pat, (Mrs. WA6SBO). PLEASE include SASE's, do not send more than one card and SASE in each envelope (IRC's for foreign amateurs), all times in GMT. Return of cards may be delayed by including more than one per envelope due to times of receipt of logs and cards by Pat or log difficulties with one of them. Your donations help but are never required for a QSL card.
- 7. Notices: (a) Ack continues to handle cards for past operations.  
(b) Cards for K1IMP/KC4 (Navassa) and VU2WNV (Laccadives) are good and creditable toward every major award except DXCC.
- 8. We wish to thank the thousands of DX Operators and enthusiasts with whom we have met during the past 30 days on our Stateside trip; We hope you have enjoyed the slides and discussing past problems and the ways we can improve amateur radio and DXing. 99% of DXers are satisfied with our operations and in favor of our DXpedition and its principles, add on this basis we are continuing. Best 73, and we'll be looking for all of you on the DX bands shortly from some exotic locations,

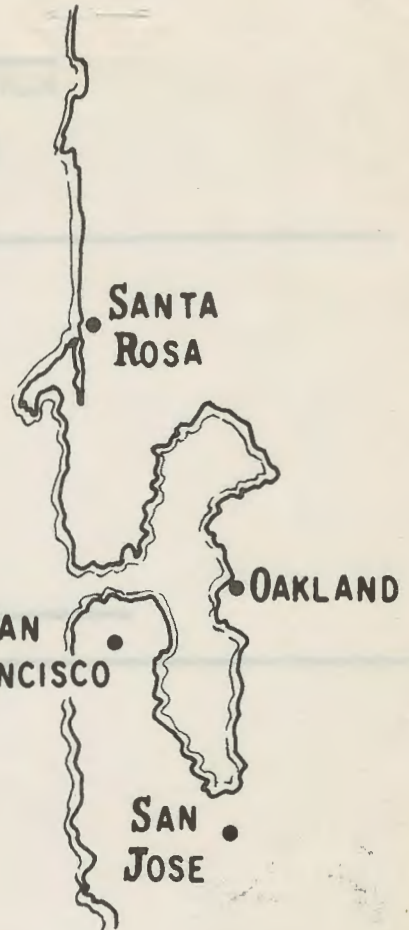
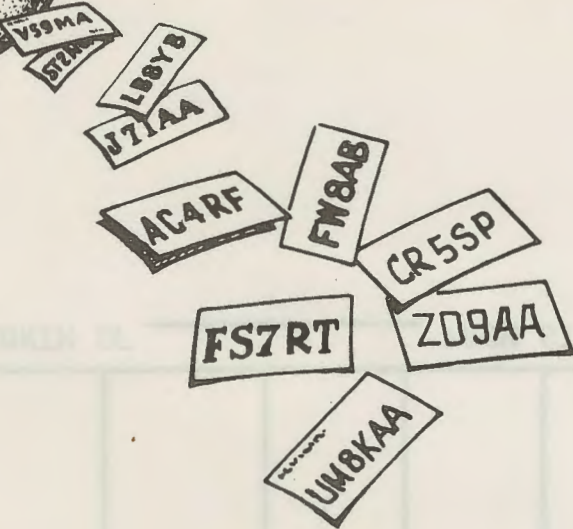
