

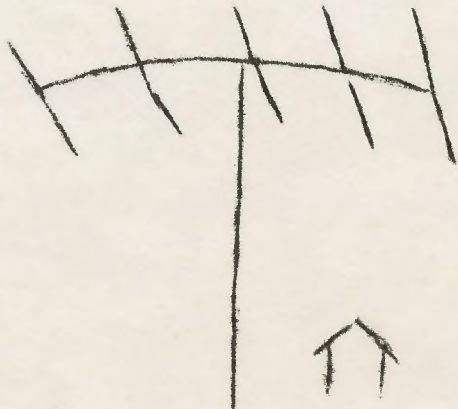
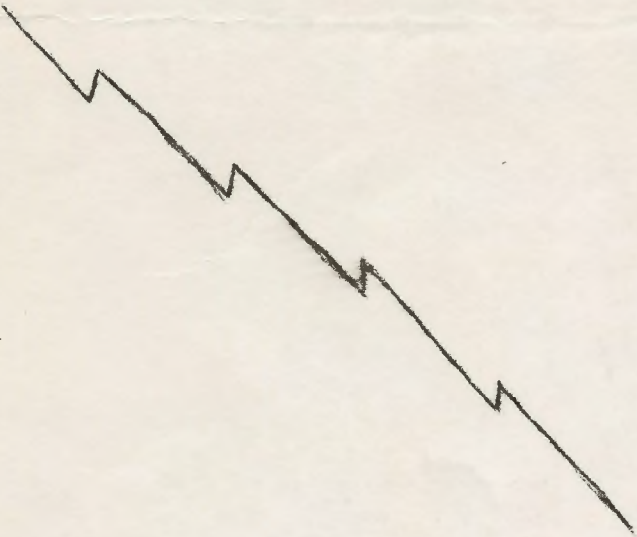

MINUTES - MAY 1971 MEETING - NCDXC

The May 1971 meeting of the NCDXC was held on May 14th at Mac's Tea Room in Los Altos. Present were 83 members, WYLS, YLS, and guests. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 P.M. by President, Don Schliesser, W6MAV.

It was motioned to dispense with the reading of the April minutes which appeared in the current issue of the DX'er. Secretary Vince Chinn corrected the April minutes by disclosing that WA6PKN and W6ZYC were voted into membership by a majority vote.

Treasurer, Vince, K6KQN reported a May 14th bank balance of \$965.62. Also reported by Vince was that the printers ran out of NCDXC QSL cards with the California Award on the back. An order of 11,00 was put in to absorb the current demand.

Announcement was made by Don, W6MAV that starting with the current issue of the DX'er Joh, K6AUC and Cliff, K6HIH were to be co-editors of the DX'er.

First reading was given to the application of Robert J. Saleeby, K6UXV, Aptos, California.

Second readings were given to the following applications and were voted into membership by a majority vote:

- (2) WA6INK Robert Faulkner Livermore

Don, W6MAV reported to the membership the progress of the NCDXC repeater. It was announced that the permanent home of the repeater will be located at the QTH of Lee, W6BH in Oakland.

Guest speaker for the evening was Yves, F8IX who elaborated briefly on various topics regarding French amateur radio.

For the first time in many years, the DX Roundtable occupied the majority of topics of the meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 11:30 P.M.

The booklet that the bureau now has to cover this type of question includes the DXCC list, the ARRL policy statement on the bureau, outgoing QSL bureau information, and DX newsletter information. From the return letters that I've seen, many people who would normally be turned away from DX for lack of information are now looking for that "new one".

The bureau is also giving a program to the Non-DX club. This program includes slides of the operation and A*V aids on QSL cards that arrive at the bureau. The program lasts about 60-90 minutes. If anyone knows of a club that would like a program, please have them drop note to the post office box and a date for presentation will be arranged.

There is one group of people that I must mention, and this group is our lifeline in getting rid of unclaimed QSL cards. W6WLV, W6DEF, and WA6BYZ plus all of the members of the Northern California Net and the Southern California Net. These fellows take the time to send the "thousands" of messages to those hams that do not have an envelope on file. Without these fellows help, our files would be overstuffed.

It can only be said that the W6 QSL bureau is providing a good service to the hams within the sixth district. This service can not be done without the voluteers that offertheir spare time to help. To those that would like to help, let us know who you are. There is always room for more.

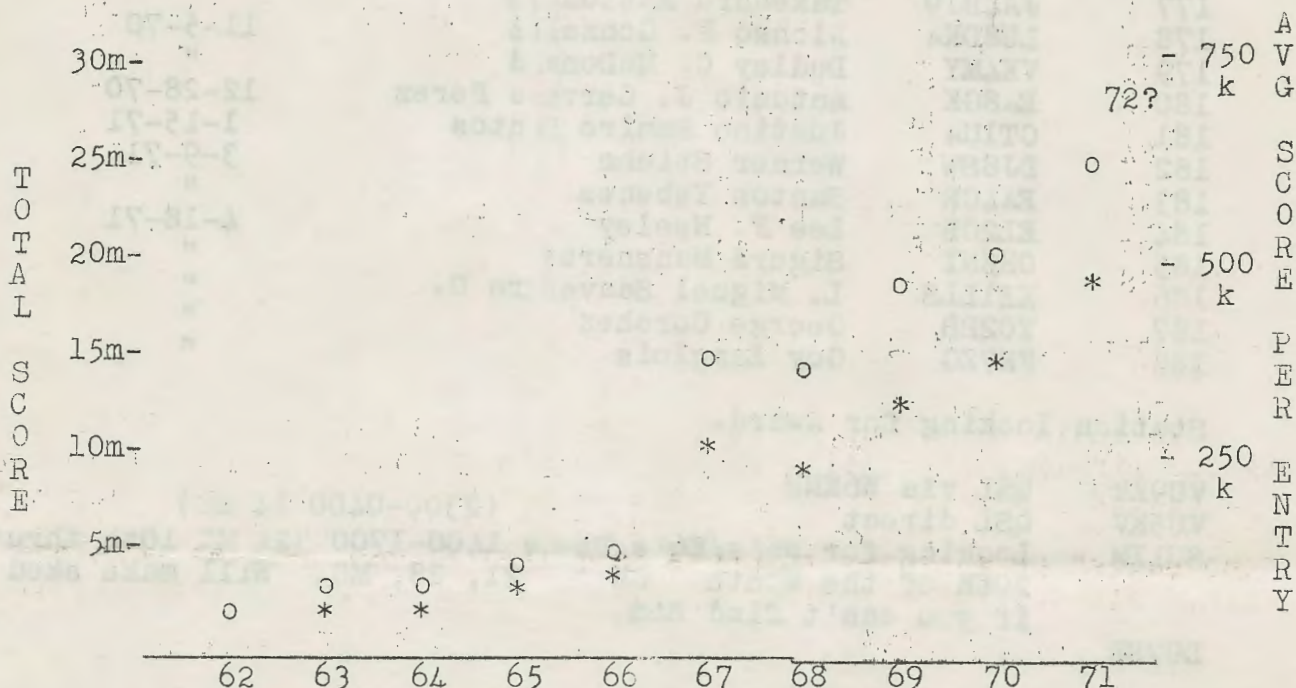

-- CONTEST NEWS --

The 1971 ARRL DX test is now history. The NCDXC output of 26.5 meg is a new club record bettering our previous record by over 5 million. Following is a chart showing the NCDXC scores for the last 10 ARRL tests:

1971 was certainly the year of the big scores. No less than 11 scores over 1 meg were submitted and two of these were over 2 meg. Interestingly enough, K6AHV's combined cw/fone score is just 400k short of being double the total NCDXC score 10 years ago. Guess you'll have to try harder next year Bob.

Over the last 5 years the number of member scores submitted for the NCDXC has averaged 61, ranging from 57 in 1967 to 66 in 1969 (58 this year). Over this same period the NCDXC membership has almost doubled!!!! And conditions have been the best in history. Let's start planning now to make the CQ test this fall and the 72 ARRL our biggest efforts yet both in total score and participation.

This column will appear on a regular basis in the DXer as part of the new format. It will be aimed at the CQ and ARRL DX tests but as agreed several months ago, the contest chairman will submit and report NCDXC scores for other contests of interest to the members. Ideas for the column would also be appreciated.
