The August meeting of the NCDXC was held on the 13th of the month, 1971, at the Fork and Cork Restaurant in San Mateo. The meeting was called to order by Don Schliesser, W6MAV.

A Motion was made by Don, W6MAV to issue Dave Baker's call, W6WX, in memorium, to the newly organized NCDXC Repeater Association to be used for the repeater in lieu of the current call W6TI/6. (W6TI will still be retained as the NCDXC call.) It was motioned to establish and sponsor a David P. Baker Memorial Award to be given annually to the highest U.S. C.W. single operator. Both of the above motions were unanimously passed, by the membership.

Then the meeting was turned over to the new President, Wes Loudon, WB6UJO. Wes introduced the guest speaker, Jack Curtis, WA6JNJ, of Curtis Electronics, who talked about his newest keyer and some basic keyer principles.
