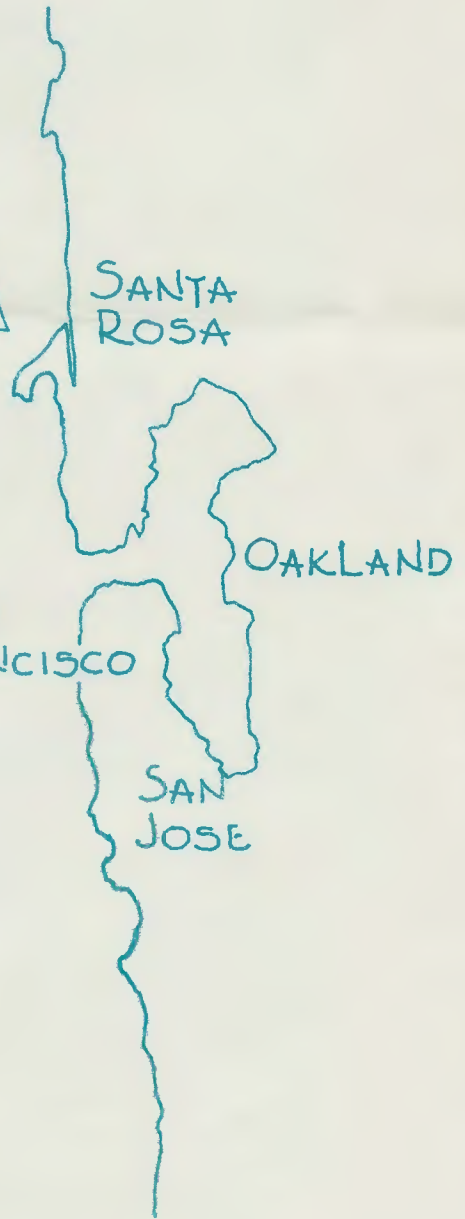

The meeting was called to order by the president, Wes Loudon, WB6UJO

The Treasurer, John K6AUC indicated a current bank balance of \$470.88 as of this date.

Jim Maxwell, W6CUE, made a motion as follows:

1. That the NCDXRA repeater exists for the purpose of aiding in the dissemination of information of general interest to the membership.
2. That the use of W6WX for repetitions or trivial comments or for ragchews of a personal nature is to be discouraged. Ordinarily, when such ragchews are expected, the repeated should be used only for the purpose of establishing an initial contact and for arranging a schedule on another frequency.
3. That each transmission over W6WX ordinarily be less than one minute duration, with a pause of no less than three seconds between successive transmissions.
4. That this resolution, including any future amendments, be published yearly in the NCDXC DXER, and be read over W6WX nightly for a period of one week after its adoption or after adoption of any amendment thereto.

The above motion was seconded and passed by the membership.

Jim Maxwell and Wes Loudon are looking into the possibilities of an outgoing QSL bureau for the NCDXC.

## DX NEWS HIGHLIGHTS

FRANZ JOSEPH LAND - Those of you who needed this one should have it by now. UK1ZFI opened on April 30 and has been on most every-night with a good Q5 signal at 14195. They will be on CW before they leave.

BHUTAN - 4S7AB has been trying to bring A51TY up on 14205 at 1200 every Monday and Thursday (LIDDXA)

CLIPPERTON - One group is definitely looking for a Clipperton operation but dates are not solid. This group believes that the landing permission which had to be obtained from the French Admiral in Tahiti will not be a problem this year. This is possibly within one month. The summer months are not regarded as good weather months for Clipperton (WCDXB)

KAMARAN - Look for a possible operation from ET3ZU in May. No details have been received but last word was go (LIDXA)

MELLISH REEF - VK3ZT, one of the operators for Mellish Reef, says the call that will be used will be VK9JW. (VELAMX) Apparently the operation has not been cancelled. At last communications, much funds were needed to even make it seem worth while considering a date. Donations can be sent via WB6IXC. If the trip does not come off, all donations will be refunded.

MINERVA REEF - Due to action by the DX Advisory Committee the Minerva Reef operation by KH6GLU and company and sponsored by INDXA for May 25th will be postponed if not scratched entirely. It will be the recommendation of the DX Advisory Committee that Minerva as well as many other countries now appearing on the DXCC list be deleted. The Board of Directors meeting is coming up in the near future when final action will be taken. K3RLY feels that because of the possibility and risk of deletion, the cost of the operation is too high to spend on a deleted country. There is the possibility of changing the operation to Manihiki/Nuié or Palmyra/Fanning. (K3RLY-K2KGB via LIDXA)

SPRATLY OPERATION by INDXA has received the same treatment as the Minerva reef operation. Plans have been stalled until it is clear what the status of this country will be. This operation was scheduled for August and if DXCC status remains unchanged it may still come off. (LIDXA)

ARRL DX ADVISORY COMMITTEE - will most probably make the following recommendations to the ARRL. Minerva Reef, Spratley and Geyser Reef should be deleted. Some others may fall into this category. Maria Theresa will at least be scheduled for deletion if a worse fate is not in store for it. This should pull down the total countries for the Honor Roll. A few more and I even might have a chance. (K2KGB via LIDXA)
