WHATCHA MISSED

The November meeting was held on Friday, November 10, 1978 at the Cabana Hyatt House, marking the 32nd anniversary of the Club.

Both the V.P. and treasurer were absent, W6BJH being out with poison oak and W6SC visiting ZL land.

John Doremus, W0AA, had previously volunteered to get printing quotes for a new run of Club QSL cards. After much searching the best price came from Club member Larry Loughran, K6SGD. A discussion then ensued regarding the complete redesign of the Club card since many expressed the desire for a new card. A motion was made and passed that 50,000 more cards, essentially the same as the old ones, be ordered and a study be made of a possible future redesign.

Merle, K6DC, suggested that the Club get together in several smaller groups for DX discussions and cheaper meals. (There has been some suggestion that the Club have regional meetings to make meetings more accessible to members, e.g., south Bay, Peninsula, East Bay, Sacramento, etc. Currently, the meetings are attended by perhaps 20% of the Club members. Regional meetings would allow more of the members to meet members in their own area. This could foster more friendship and cooperation between members. -- ED.)

LAST MEETING (CONTD.)

Adam, N6QR, notified us that a number of new members had received a copy of the "NCDXC Code of Ethics". It was pointed out that these had never been accepted by the Club. It was suggested that Associate members pay the same dues as full members. After a discussion the motion was withdrawn.

It was also noted that certificates are supposed to be issued to all Club members who score over 100K points for the Club in DX contest. (I never got one -- Ed.)

The recent CQ World Wide DX contest has been dedicated to the late Larry LeKashman, W2AB/W9IOP/W2IOP, one of the founders of the contest. The World, Single Operator, All Band CW Trophy that Larry has been donating for the past 20 years will be awarded in his memory by W1WY for the 1978 contest.

Larry and Herb Becker, W6QD, were the founders of our World Wide DX Contest 30 years ago, and it was through Larry's dedicated efforts that the contest was kept alive in the early 1950's when CQ gave up sponsorship. Wayne Greene, W2NSD, then editor of CQ, had a change of heart and the magazine again picked up the contest in 1955. That's when I came into the picture.

The '55 contest generated 1,005 entries. Last year we went over the 4,000 mark. With the exception of a few minor changes we have followed the original format set up by Larry and Herb. Their original idea of a world wide type contest has now been developed into the World Championship of all DX competition. W2AB may be a "silent key" but come the last week-end in November each year his spirit will still be alive.

DX AWARDS

- 1) The "Gold Sardinia Award" (GSA) is granted to any amateur radio station and SWL who has had a QSO with any ISØ station after January 1, 1976 on any band and any type of emission.
 - a) The DX station must collect at least 15 points.
 - b) The European stations must collect at least 20 points.
 - c) The Italian stations must collect at least 30 points.
- 2) The contacts with any ISØ station is granted 1(one) point on each shortwave band (80-10) and 2 points on VHF bands. The contacts with any ISØ station member of U.R.S. Club is granted 4 points on each HF band and 5 points on VHF. There will be a wildcard station valid for 6 points on HF and 7 points on VHF. (ISØLYN is the wildcard station)
- 3) Same stations can be worked again on same band but after 24 hours or same day but on different bands. Lowest reports are RST 338, RS 43.
- 4) It's requested that extracts of the station log, verified by 2 other hams, or a Club, or QSLs with sufficient return postage and one personal QSL with 15 IRCs or \$4.00 (L. 2000) be sent to: U.R.S. Club (Unione dei Radioamatori della Sardegna) via Sardegna 16, (I) 07100 Sassari, Sardinia Island - Italy.

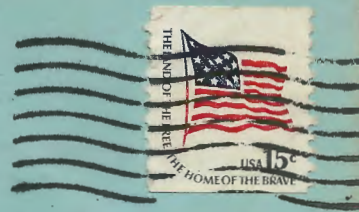
