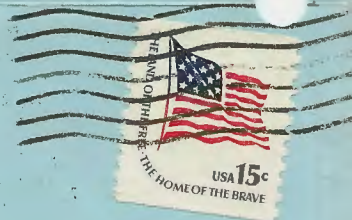
NCDXC DX BULLETIN BROADCASTS

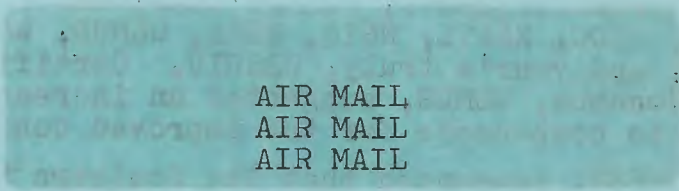
