HE WILL BE IN OUR AREA TO ATTEND THE ARRL PACIFIC DIVISION CONVENTION TO BE HELD OCTOBER 8 - 10 AT THE HOLIDAY INN IN SANTA CRUZ AND KINDLY AGREED TO COME A DAY EARLY TO BE OUR GUEST. WHILE IT HAS NOT YET BEEN CONFIRMED, WE EXPECT THAT CHRIS IMLAY, W3AKD, WILL ALSO BE OUR GUEST. CHRIS WAS APPOINTED ARRL COUNSEL LAST YEAR UPON THE DEATH OF HIS COLLEAGUE, BOB BOOTH, W3PS.

#### VIC CLARK'S HAM CAREER

VIC HAS BEEN AN ACTIVE HAM FOR NEARLY A HALF A CENTURY. HE EARNED HIS FIRST LICENSE, W6KFC IN SEPTEMBER, 1933 AT PHOENIX, ARIZONA. DURING THE 1930'S HE MADE HIS CALL WELL KNOWN IN CONTEST CIRCLES ESPECIALLY THE SS WHERE HE WAS A NATIONAL WINNER. LATER, AS W4KFC IN VIRGINIA, HIS CALL SOON BECAME WELL KNOWN TOO, AND I REMEMBER HE WAS A TOP DX CONTEST SCORER FOR MANY YEARS. IT'S HARD TO UNDERSTAND HOW HE FOUND THE TIME TO

SPEND ON THE AIR WHILE SERVING AS SCM IN TWO SECTIONS; ROANOKE DIVISION DIRECTOR FOR SEVEN YEARS AND ARRL VICE PRESIDENT FOR SIX YEARS.

HE WAS KEPT VERY BUSY PRIOR TO THE WARC 1979. DURING A THREE YEAR PREPARATORY PERIOD HE VISITED AND CONFERRED WITH NATIONAL SOCIETIES AND GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS IN 40 DIFFERENT COUNTRIES AND SERVED ON THE FCC WARC ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND ON THE IARU WARC PREPARATORY COMMITTEE.

AFTER ALL THIS PREPARATORY EFFORT IT IS FITTING AND PROPER THAT HE ATTEND THE CONFERENCE AS A MEMBER OF THE IARU TEAM. WARC WAS A GREAT SUCCESS FOR HAM RADIO AS A WHOLE AND VIS'S CONTRIBUTION WAS VERY SIGNIFICANT.

VIC WAS CHAIRMAN OF THE ARRL LONG-RANGE PLANNING COMMITTEE WHICH WORKED LONG AND HARD TO PREDICT THE COURSE OF HAM RADIO FOR THE NEXT FIVE TO TWENTY YEARS AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS OF ACTIONS TO PREPARE FOR THAT FUTURE. CHANGES IN THE ARRL ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE WHICH HAVE ALREADY BEEN STARTED ARE PARTS OF THIS PLAN.

DX NEWS

WONG WINS CHINA PERMISSION

China's great wall of radio silence may be broken next month - Tom Wong, VE7BC, says he has permission to operate SSB from BY1PK during a scheduled October business trip to Beijing. Amateur radio contacts with BY1PK, the country's only station, have been very few and far between since the historic re-opening of the hambands to the Chinese last March.

Wong's operating permission appears to be for SSB only, which fits the pattern begun at BY1PK. The resident operators have stuck to CW because none of them are fluent in English, amateur radio's international language. Party paranoia probably precludes the Chinese allowing their first-ever foreign operator to work CW (which could be difficult for the authorities to monitor).

A recent article in a west coast paper describes China's fledgling television programming (which is, incidentally, of higher quality than in the U.S. because it uses 625 lines instead of 525), and two programs aired to the entire nation are a basic electricity course and a "Radio Amateur Lesson."

During his October visit, VE7BC will also assist in final set-up of the BY7 station in Shanghai and he will attempt to confirm that all recent "BY1PK" 40 Meter operations have been (as suspected) bootleggers. No exact October dates have been announced yet.

## CLUB COOPERATION - 1982 CQWW DX CONTEST

LAST YEAR THE NCDXC GAVE ITS FULL SUPPORT TO THE NCCC IN ITS SUCCESSFUL ATTEMPT TO WIN THE CQWW DX CLUB COMPETITION. ALL CONTEST ORIENTED NCDXC MEMBERS ARE AGAIN URGED TO JOIN THE NCCC, AND DX ORIENTED NCCC MEMBERS ARE INVITED TO JOIN THE NCDXC.

BY THE TIME YOU READ THIS, KH60/B, OPERATING FROM THE HONOLULU COMMUNITY COLLEGE, SHOULD BE ON THE AIR KEYING ONE MINUTE AFTER K60PO/B -- I.E. 00:02:00. BUT ACTUALLY, THE KH60/B TRANSMISSION BEGINS ABOUT 1 1/2 SECONDS AFTER K60PO/B FINISHES! WATCH FOR 4U1UN/B WITHIN THE NEXT FEW WEEKS TO BE KEYING ONE MINUTE BEFORE K60PO/B I.E. 00:00:00, 00:10:00, ETC. FIVE OTHER BEACONS WILL BE SHIPPED WITHIN THE NEXT WEEK OR SO (OR WHEN YOUR EDITOR CAN FINISH TYPING THIS ISSUE OF THE DX'ER). THEY ARE BEING SENT TO: JA2IGY, 4X6TU/B, OH2B, CT3B, AND ZS6DN/B. EACH WILL OPERATE ON 14.100 MHz AND WILL KEY ONE MINUTE APART IN THE FOREGOING SEQUENCE. ON EACH TRANSMISSION, THE FOUR, 9 SECOND DASHES ARE IN ORDER 100-10-1-0.1 WATTS. THE ID AND SIGNOFF ARE AT THE 100 WATT LEVEL. THE POWER LEVELS INDICATED ARE RF OUTPUT.

K6RU, W6QHS AND K6KU HAVE PUT IN PRODIGIOUS AMOUNTS OF ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION TIME ALONG WITH SUBSTANTIAL HELP FROM W6VG AND K6DC ON THIS UNIQUE BEACON SYSTEM.

AUGUST 23, 1982

W6DU BEGAN THE MEETING AT 7:20 PM AT HIS HOME WITH K6RK, K6DC, W6VG, W6QHS, W6TPH AND WB6ZUC ALSO PRESENT.

AC6V AND HIS WIFE SHIRLEY, CAN NO LONGER PRODUCE THE DX'ER SO THERE WAS DISCUSSION OF OTHER ALTERNATIVES.

W6TPH, CHAIRMAN OF THE 1983 INTERNATIONAL DX CONVENTION IN VISALIA, FOR WHICH WE ARE RESPONSIBLE GAVE A REPORT ON PLANS. HIS PROGRAM COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN FOR THE EVENT, W6GO, SAYS THE NCCC HAS APPOINTED GARY, WA6VEF, AS THE CONTEST CLUB LIASON. GARY WILL ORGANIZE THE CONTEST FORUM. THE COMMITTEE HAS ALSO ADDED CHARLIE, W6ZYC, TO ORGANIZE THE AUDIO-VISUAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE MEETING.

N6ST, REGISTRATION COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN, SAYS SOFTWARE DEVELOPMENT HAS BEGUN LEADING TO REPORTING ON THE PRE-REGISTRATION AND REGISTRATION STATISTICS. THESE REPORTS WILL ALSO SERVE AS THE SOURCE OF DOCUMENTATION FOR THE ACCOUNTING OF ALL REVENUES GENERATED. THERE WILL BE A MAILING TO EACH PRE-REGISTRANT CONFIRMING HIS CONVENTION REGISTRATION.

W6QHS SAID PRIZE AND REFRESHMENT MONEY IS NEEDED FOR THE SEPTEMBER PICNIC AND IT WAS SUGGESTED THAT \$400 BE ALLOCATED FOR BOTH AND AN ACCOUNTING BE MADE FOR FUTURE REFERENCE. W6TMB, CHAIRMAN OF THE PICNIC, SAYS A RAFFLE PRIZE WILL BE OFFERED.

JAMMING AGAIN WAS MENTIONED AND CONTINUING SURVEILLANCE DISCUSSED.

MINUTES OF NCDXC MEETING  
AUGUST 13, 1982

THE AUGUST MEETING WAS HELD AT HARRY'S HOFBRAU IN PALO ALTO AND BEGAN AT 7:40 PM AFTER COCKTAILS. THE PRESIDENT, ERIC, W6DU, ASKED FOR INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS. THE FOLLOWING WERE INTRODUCED: W6JKV, W6OWM, HB9ABX, OH5BT AND W6DSZ. THE SPEAKER FOR THE EVENING, JIM, W6JKV, PRESIDENT OF TANDEM COMPUTER WAS INTRODUCED AND GAVE AN INTERESTING PRESENTATION OF HIS 6 METER DXPEDITIONS TO XF4, ZK1, ZF2, C5, 3D2 AND A35. HIS RECOMMENDATIONS FOR SUCH A TRIP ARE ALWAYS TAKE A RIG WHICH CAN RUN AT LEAST 100 WATTS, AN ANTENNA ON A 20 FOOT BOOM, GET A REPEATER TO SEND YOUR CALL ON 28,885 KHZ AND TO GO ON A WEEKEND WHEN MORE PEOPLE ARE AT HOME TO WORK YOU.

LOU, K6TMB REPORTED THAT PLANS FOR THE SEPTEMBER PICNIC AT LINDA VISTA PARK IN CUPERTINO ARE COMING ALONG WELL AND THAT THE DX PILEUP GAME OF LAST YEAR WILL BE HELD AGAIN.

## ALAND ISLANDS, OHØW

Most massive multi/multi effort ever will feature 30 top OH-operators as a team targeted for a new European phone & cw records in the CQ WW DX Contest. The special call OHØW ( W stands for winning ) was issued and there are people working full time to mount 1000kg of KLM aluminium up on seven 100 ft. towers.

It will be clean 6 el KLM double installations all through and 80/160 verticals will be mounted straight into the ocean. Complete intercomm network is installed to provide maximum benefit of the 500 meter radius used between the stations. Multiplier change is heavily focused with large investments on spotting operators and the gear.
