MINUTES OF THE BoD MEETING - JUNE 7, 1983

The meeting was convened at W6VG's home, with W6VG, K6DC, K6UD, K6RK, W6TPH, W6DU, and WB6ZUC attending. W6DU, Eric, opened the meeting at 7:15pm, June 7, 1983 with W6TPH presenting his final report as Chairman of the 1983 DX convention. The bottom line is that we made \$2515 after expenses for a super convention. Bill prepared an itemized balance sheet compiled from reports from each of his committee members and this will be a great help in planning the 1985 convention. Kudos to K6FO for publicity; K6TMB for food & drink; W6GO & K6HHD for speakers; AA6AD for prizes; N6ST for registration; K6ANP for the Redwood Empire DX Assoc's help; WA6VEF for video tape; and W6ZYC for audio-visual. We are proud to have that kind of talented help in the club.

There was agreement that the awards part of the convention program drags, so it was recommended that only the club award for DXer of the Year and the 3 perpetual trophies be handed out at the convention in the future.

Eric, W6DU, said there will be a final meeting of the BoD on 11 July to clean up details of his presidential year.

K6UD gave a brief report on jamming. We need more logs for records. Please contribute and do your part. The board voted to allocate \$2100 to RF equipment and private detective work and this amount will be reduced by any contributions marked for the jamming fund. This requires the authorization from membership to spend \$1600.

K6DC presented the logo design in various colors for our choice. It was voted that 300 be ordered. They will be sold to members to recover the costs.

After discussion it was recommended we give the money for the Dave Baker award to CQ (CQ WW award) and not buy our own plaque since they supply the logo and we would be duplicating the plaque.

It was decided that the meeting Friday evening that ballots be handed out to each member of the club if there is more than 1 candidate for that office.

W6VG declined to serve on the ethics committee for HF.

W6GO's report on the ethics committee for VHF will be held over to the next meeting due to his absence.

K6RK presented a forecast for the 1983/84 budget. Operating income does not quite cover operating expenses. A short fall of several hundred dollars is expected. Due to the healthy surplus in the treasury augmented by the convention income it was decided not to recommend a dues increase at this time. Recent increase in badge costs make it necessary to again raise the price of a badge to \$6.00 at this time.

It is estimated that new rosters this fall will cost \$250.

Merle, K6DC, has agreed to write a solicitation letter for funds to be used for the jamming fund.

Fred Laun's offer to submit ideas for the W6's and JA's to get through to Malpelo was noted. K6UD has already sent a letter to them from the foundation. KR60 and W6QHS were appointed to a committee to recommend ideas and W6TPH was appointed to suggest propagation ideas.

W6NLG was approved for Life Membership. The meeting was adjourned at 9:30pm.

MINUTES OF THE JUNE NCDXC MEETING

The June meeting of the NCDXC was held in Palo Alto at Harry's Hof Brau on June 10 and called to order by W6DU, at 7:40pm.

Guests this evening were F6EPN, KE6ZE, KA6PKW, K6EWM and W6DSL.

The slate of officers submitted by the nominating committee headed by W6SC was: Pres. K6RK, Vice Pres. K6TMB, Sec. WB6ZUC, and Treas. WB6WKM. KR60 was nominated from the floor for Treasurer. The following officers were elected: President, K6RK - Vice President, K6TMB - Secretary, WB6ZUC Treasurer, WB6WKM

Eric announced that W6ISQ has been told by J1BKB that XU, Kampuchea, may get on the air soon.

K6DC announced that logo pins have been ordered and will take about six weeks for deliver.

AA6AD requested and it was approved that we send a thank you letter to SRG (Radio Club of Yugoslavia) for their aid in putting 9N1MM and BY1PK on the air.

K6SSJ proposed J1BKB and K5YY for honorary membership (which costs the club about \$10 a year to mail the bulletin). Both were approved. W6MUR suggested the Board of Directors consider at the next meeting how many of these per year might be allowed in view of the cost. The board will research and come up with a procedure. KR60 suggested DJ6SI for honorary membership and was requested to write a supporting letter which will be considered after the above research is accomplished.

WA6VEF, Gary Caldwell, gave a talk on "Meet the NCDXC People", the video film he made for the convention. He got permission from the George Slaughter lab in Hollywood where his father produces "Real People", to use their lab and equipment. It took him 14 weeks to shoot the film showing the stations and antennas of the following members: W6BIP, W6QHS, and KA6HSM, W6KH (who simulated a contact with Albania and put it on 2 meters for the club!), W6DU, N6RO, W6RGG, WB6ZUC, K6ANP, and N6DCJ, W6GO and K6HHD, K6FO, KB6OZ, AI6V, K6ERS and W6RQ. Gary's explanation of the special effects techniques and the work which went into this video tape was most interesting. A viewing of the tape followed.

Eric announced that the annual dues of \$12.50 are due as of 1 July.

K6UD spoke of the need for more money for various purposes in the jamming program. After discussion \$1600 was unanimously authorized for this purpose (to be paid back from contributions received). K6DC is drafting a letter requesting such contributions.

W6TPH, chairman of the Visalia convention, said \$2515 revenues over expenses was received from the convention. Data from that meeting will be given to N6AN who is collating this information as a help to the next committee to run our convention.

W6RC, Dick, said he is checking out Deer Park Farm in Rancho San Antonio at W6SC's suggestion and that it looks good for the picnic site.

N6RC and K6LM of the Convention Site Committee reported they met and are soliciting ideas for the 1985 convention site. Some wild suggestions have been heard on 2 meters for the site. Hawaii?

Eric announced that the BoD voted to limit the number of awards at the next convention to the 3 perpetual awards (as listed in the Procedures Manual) and to the DXer of the Year Award: this in an effort to speed up the action Saturday evening at the convention. The meeting was adjourned at 10pm.

DX HAPPENINGS:

DJ6SI (The following is reprint from The ARRL LETTER, Vol 2, No. 12, June 9, 1983)...."In Vol 2, No. 9, we reported that according to press reports the survivors of the DJ6SI DXpedition to Spratly had been rescued by the Linden. From the beginning of this story, there have been some intriguing incongruities. Thanks to KB2FS we've been able to obtain a translation of a story appearing on pages 212 and 214 of Der Spiegel, No. 19, 1983.

Der Spiegel takes cognizance of the fact that DJ6SI is a counter-espionage agent for the German government, and the other members of the crew seem to have ties to the intelligence community. According to DJ6SI, the survivors drifted in a 14 foot dinghy without food, water, shelter or protective clothing for 10 days. During the time adrift, there was no rain and few clouds. Temperatures reached 104°F. Medical experts cited by Der Spiegel felt the maximum survival time under such conditions to be three or four days. Not only did the group survive 10 days, but they required little medical attention.

Der Spiegel also notes that in spite of the fact that the wind was blowing north and the currents were constant to the northeast, the boat drifted 230 nautical miles in the opposite direction during the 10 days. Apparently, the agency employing DJ6SI has refused to comment to Der Spiegel. "This has to be a 'mysterious miracle'" is the conclusion reached by Der Spiegel. (Editor's note: Der Spiegel is a popular middle of the road German news magazine).."

Othmar also states that his TH3jr is defective on 20 meters and that is why very little activity there. One thing that should make us smile is the following: ".....the bigger problem than shortwave propagations are perhaps the pile-ups that are growing up from several continents as soon as I come on the air. Impossible to tell a european station that I'm looking for american west coast. They don't listen, and don't ask me why they call me every week again on the same band???? Thats why I enjoy the 21 MHz during the night..... It's almost relaxing to work a disciplined, co-operative North American pile up...." He also states that the best way to QSL is direct to PO Box 815, in N'Djamena. 2 IRC's are OK for one card airmail. You can QSL via the bureau to HB9CLA (home call) BUT".....please don't write to my home address." Othmar will be QRV until September or even longer.

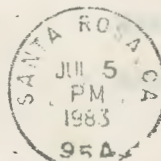
