- DAITO Is. The KD6AA operation was to take place from Daito Island, 500 or 600 miles from Saipan and might count for a new country.
- PAPUA VK9DJ has returned to the air after being gone for about eight months. Name is Graham and says he will be on rather regularly around 1200-1300Z, 14210kc.
- EAST MALAYSIA 9M8RY another Pacific Station coming through around 1300Z at 14210kc.

 Handle is Yong and QSL via WB6LED. (W6ZC)
- HONGKONG VS6AA, Maurice, coming in at 14022kc at 1430Z on June 30th.
- MACAO CR9AK reported at 21350kc and at 14190kc, on twenty the time was 13152. Strong signal reported for the 20 meter operation. (K6CQF)
- EASTERN CAROLINES KC6CQ still a good bet from 0700Z onward and as late as 130QZ.

- SHIRBS(?)ISLAND WAIDXU/FF1 on 14036 on the 4th of July. Anyone have anything definite on this one. (K6CQF)
- TUNISIA The Radio Club de Bois-Colombes, F50J, will operate from Djerba Island,
 Tunisia from August 1st to 30th with the call 3V8AA. An SB 101 will be the
 rig, crystal controlled, with a VFO for reception. Present crystal frequencies
 are 14225, 21225 and 28725,c. QSLs to F50J.
