ST. PETER AND PAUL ROCKS PY7AOA operating /mm aboard Brazilian Navy Vessel enroute to the Rocks last week. Announced landfall was set for 0800Z Sunday morning. Allowing for time to land and set-up, they should be on when you receive this bulletin. Fifteen to one-sixty operations planned....minimum of 72 hours operation. QSLs for PYØSP (SSB) go to PY7AOA and for PYØDX (c.w.) go to PY7AOO.

LORD HOWE IS. VK2BKM/VK2 is due to open up this week using a Swan 400 plus a TH6DX beam. Scheduled to start November 19th and operate to November 28th. Initially will be an SSB operation, then c.w. for the CQ contest, then both until the end of the effort. Plans for 10 thru 80 meter operation. Frequencies announced are:

c.w. 3505, 7010, 14060, 21060, 28060

SSB 3600 (3690 for Ws above 3800), 7070, 14185, 21300, 28550.

Operating times for U.S. 10m 2200-0100, 15m 0100 onward, 20m 0400-0800, 40m 0900-1100 80m 1100-1200

Dipoles will be used on 40/00. QSL via W2CTN

ALBROHOS PYØOK and PYØOM opened up November 13th, transmitting on 14191kc and Tistening above 14200kc. Usually working Ws by districts...not especially strong signal but every Wo that got through was S9 there. Initial plans were for a 10 day operation. Also reported as operating at times on 21240kc and 28550kc.

SOUTH ORKNEYS VP8RD reports that he will be operating from Signy Island in the south Orkneys in January with an SSB rig. Presently only VP8JH is there and c.w. only.

CONGO REPUBLIC TN8AA showed up last week at 14201kc at 1600 hrs. Handle is Guy and QSL to CBA.

TRISTAN de CUNHA ZD9BL is due to leave this locale on November 22nd. Butch is on almost daily, usually on 15 meters around 21270kc from 2100Z on. Strong signal to the western reaches....QSL via WA6AHF. Also ZD9BK at 14080kc at 2000Z...Johan.

VE-DXpedition VRIP expected to break out of British Phoenix about the latter part of this week. They have been heard intermittently....usually between working on their generator. Still nothing definite on next operation...Manihiki...Tokelaus or Tonga mentioned and transportation the key problem. Tonga may be the most likely spot from all indicators. VE6AO has mailed QSLs for the first part of the VRIP operations. This is still a shoe-string effort and any assistance...send to VE6AO ...will be appreciated and helpful.

GLORIOSO FR7ZR/Glorioso still being heard LP early last week but no pile-ups being noted towards end of the week. Originally scheduled to be active until November 21st Reported as not intending to submit any documentation to the ARRL Awards Committee.

Last previously noted operation here was Don Miller as FR7ZP in November 1966.

DON MILLER Speaking of Don, his 'final' word is in the November CQ. Whatever your leanings, you should read everything to know what is said on both sides.

CHATHAM ISLAND Further information via Ed Hoetzel, W6DZZ, confirms the January 2nd departure for the Chatham Island effort. Letter being sent out by ZL2AFZ shows that 10 thru 80 meter operation planned. QSLs will be handled by ZL2AFZ for the four stations in the effort. Plans for this ZL-effort do seem to be firming.
