EAST PAKISTAN W4UDF will arrive in East Pakistan August 14th and expects to be issued a license for operations commencing August 15th. Reports say that call will have AK5 prefix. 20 meter operation and expected check-in with the VL SSB System on 14332kc. QSL to home QTH in CB. (W5LZZ)

FAROEES SM5WI will operate portable OY from August 16th to September 6th. Mainly a c.w. operation but may go SSB on request. Indicated operating frequencies will be up 25kc from bottom of band. QSL direct to SM5WI home QTH.

KUWAIT 9K2CB and 9K2CC showing up regularly on 15 and sometimes on 20. Frequently found from 1800 to 2100Z at 21360 or close by. 9K2CB handle is John and 9K2CC is Bud. QSL to DeLong, Box 509, Kuwait. They report that 9K2BV, BG and BJ are the only Kuwait stations relatively active at this time besides themselves. (W6DZZ)

St. PIERRE In spite of reports that the French authorities would no longer issue licenses to non-inhabitants, FP0EB has been heard in the quiet zone around 14195kc. Seems that the FP0-prefix will be issued to foreigners.

GIBRALTAR ZB2AY continuing to show up on the West Coast around 0100Z and often with strong signals. Transmitting frequency usually between 14185 to 14195 and listening up as high as 14220kc. QSL to CBA. Handle is Roger.

SWAN ISLAND KS4CG operating contest style at 14068. Signal report and nothing else. Operating around 0700Z. (WA6JDT)

XMAS ISLAND VK9XI reports that he will only be on for five or six more weeks. Is on every Monday and Wednesday from 1200-1800Z. Handle is Steve and QSL via W2GHK. Usually found around 14320kc. (W6CYO)

ISLE OF SARK GC3SVK and GC3TTN operating portable from this Channel Island just below 20meter phone band around 0400 and later. QSL go to G2MI. Some question of country status raised but also some doubts. (W6HVN)

ON SCHEDULE 3V8AA from Djerba Island and will be on until end of August.  
CR9AK from Macao due to QRT August 5th.  
F0CH/FC from Corsica went QRT July 31st  
PZ1BX/FY due August 10th.

WALLIS Is. FW8RC, Robert, frequently found 14245-14265kc around 0500 with Thursdays and Fridays best bet. QSL direct. (WB6GF)

PITCAIRN IS. Pile-ups indicate that VR6TC is still being looked for. Again, his schedule is Tuesdays on 21350kc at 2100Z and Wednesdays at 14225kc at 0600Z. Some times W6HS compiles a list so if you are desperate, show up a bit early for assembly-line DXing.

ISRAEL LZ4HF from Northern Israel, handle is Joe and can be looked for around 21350 or plus a few around 1800Z onward. Expects to be transferred to the Sinai soon and will be on the air as 4X9. (W5LZZ)

BALEARIC IS. DL7FT reports that EA6AR will be in operation September 12th-22nd. Main operating frequencies will be 14005kc, 14195kc, 21245kc and 28545kc. Operations will be c.w. 0800-2000Z and SSB 2000 to 0800Z. (W6HVN)

QSL handled by DL7FT are EA6AR, HBØLL, KL7EBK, M1FT, TG9EP, W4UAF/KH6, XE2YP 3AØCU, 3V8BZ and 4A2YP.

TRISTAN de CUNHA Try looking for ZD9BF around 21255kc at 1800Z.

ZAMBIA 9J2NW just outside the 20 meter phone band at 14195kc and listening up around 14210kc. Name is Tony.

GEORGIA UF6CW, Tamaz, operating inside the band August 1st at 14207 at 0440Z. (W6HVN)
