CHINA In spite of considerable skepticism, BY1F continues to show up on the low end of twenty between 1300 and 1400Z. Name is Chin...slow c.w. operator. There still is mail service to China if you can find out where to send a QSL.

FRENCH GULANA Still no signs of the projected PZ1BX. VE1KG, Serge, does have a regular schedule with FY7YM around 14260kc at times. FY7YM does not like pile-ups, is transceiver operation. VE1KG may be of help if you need this one. (WB6UJO)

INTERNATIONAL HAM CONVENTION 4th Annual Convention scheduled for Sept 13-15th at Knokke, Belgium. Information can be obtained from Lucien Vervarcke, ON4LV. W6GTE will head West Coast contingent. Big program...Ws invited.

ANDORRA If you miss with all the August activity from PX1-land, DL5NJ will be operating from there in last two weeks of October, including the CQ contest. Name is Jim and expects to operate 10, 15 and 20 with possible call of PX1BW. Plans to use Don Miller's frequencies. (WA6OIU)

SVALBARD JW2AP being worked on the West Coast. Handle is Bob and QSL via NRRL. Good signal around 0400-0500Z around 14235kc.

MALAYSIA 5R8AS schedules his QSL manager rather frequently at 14220kc around 1400-1500Z. Handle is Chet.

FAROE OY7FRA is scheduled to be on until August 21st, operation by DL3SA. Also, SM5WI/OY is scheduled to be on from now to Sept 6th with c.w. operation 25kc up from low end. Also reported is OY5NS around 21400kc from 2000Z.

YUGOSLAVIA YU0M being worked on the West Coast around 0500Z. Special call and will be on only a short time longer. Look around 14187kc from 0330Z.

KUWAIT 9K2CC and 9K2CB still coming in almost daily on 15. Frequencies change, 21318 one day, 21360 another. 1700Z on seem to be best time.

PORTUGUESE GUINEA CR3KD has been reported operating at times. Sometimes found low portion of c.w. bands and operating both 15 and 20. 2200 to 2400Z seems to be best time to look for him as high as 70kc from bottom of band. QSL via W2CTN.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS DXpedition An announcement from the Northern Illinois DX Assn state that they will sponsor an excursion to an island west of Peru and will operate August 30th thru September 4th. Call sign not yet assigned by OA authorities. State that the operation will count for a new country. The operating frequencies will be 14105 and 14205kc and 21245 and 21345kc. QSL to NIDXA, 708 East Marion, Arlington Heights, Ill. 60004
