- SAN FELIX Joaquin, CE3ZN, confirms that he has definite plans for a San Felix-CEØX trip in January. The definite date will depend on whether there is any rare DX scheduled as Joaquin reports when he made his CEØZ-Juan Fernandez trip last year that he missed two new ones. So sometime in January....watch for Joaquin.
- CLIPPERTON This is strictly unverified rumor but the story is that a French officer may operate from Clipperton for a week sometime in December. No date—no times—no frequencies—not much of anything except a possibility. Watch anyhow.
- REPUBLIC OF GUINEA 7G1CG being reported on a.m. between 21270-21280kc around 2000Z.

 Not especially strong signal but has been heard on the West Coast.
- TIMOR CR8AI, Louie, worked on the West Coast last week at 23082 at 21255kc. Not strong on his English but will understand when spoken slowly...very good on Spanish though. Reports that only CR8AI and CR8AH only active stations on the island. QSL to Dili, Timor...no box number needed as Dili not that large.
- INDONESIA ARRL bulletins over the air saying that it is okay for Ws to work the YBs now.
- BRUNEI VS5TJ, Slim, coming through occasional mornings on the low end of two my around 17-1800Z. Also, VS5MH, Mike, departed San Francisco November 20th via freighter returning to Brunei via Hongkong and taking a KWM-2 and a 30L1 with him to put second station on the air regularly. Should be on by mid-December.
- TONGA Last word on the VE-DXpedition was that the boat had left American Samoa to pick them up and they hopefully are on their way back from British Phoenix now. Their next operation still appears to be VR5-Tonga and they should open up this coming week-end or within a day or so of December 8th.

 Their future plans are still indefinite, financing being the major problem. One report has them going to ZL/VK land looking for some employment so they can continue. Any assistance certainly appreciated and can be sent via VE6AO.
- WALLIS IS. KH6GLU, Ed DeYoung, reported as aiming for this area late in January after a trip via KS6/5Wl area. 10 day operation planned...late January and early February.
- TRUMELIN FR7ZL/T reported to be again active and heard around 1700Z....14125-150kc.
