VE-DXpedition Presently the VE-group is split up in the South Pacific with George in Fiji, Don in Pago Pago and Ron (non-operator) in ZL-land. Lack of funds has brought a temporary suspension to their activities.

At this time the VR5-Tonga operation will go when sufficient funds become available. Don is presently scheduled to go to FW8-Wallis Island with Ed DeYoung

early in February:

The ZM7-Tokelaus operation has been placed 'off-limits' until after the hurricane season. Authorization for the ZM7 operation has been secured but it will not be valid until April 1, 1969. The New Zealand Government has decreed the area 'off limits' to all vessels during the hurricane season of December to April.

It might be recalled that Chuck Swain K7LMU and Ted Thorpe ZL2AWJ along with others were lost in 1966 when enroute from Wallis to Samoa in late January. Wallis is to the west of Samoa, the Tokelaus to the north but all in the general area of the Pacific. (W6KNH)

- CHATHAM IS Still a go for right after the first of the year. This is an operation which will be on most of January and should be looked for from January 5th onward. Frequencies for operations given in 33-68.
- REPUBLIC OF GUINEA 7G1CG still active at 2100Z around 21310kc and usually within 10kcs of that frequency. Name is Carlo Gola and works through WA3HUP, an YL who also handles the QSL cards. Also reported as active is 7G1IX from OK-land.
- PYOBLR-TRINIDADE For those who have given up hope on getting a QSL for this operation, take courage!! within the last ten days a confirmation was received direct from PY4BLR. It would seem that some cards are being sent out...but slowly.
- NAURU ISLAND VK9RJ is still scheduled to be there for another 18 months. If you have not caught up with Jack you might listen around 14220kc from 0600Z onward. K6UJW still the QSL manager.
- NORFOLK IS. Pending the operations scheduled by K6KA in February plus the one also scheduled by W6BPO et cie, also in February, you can still listen for VK9RH, Ray, around 14150-14170kc. Ray schedules a VK2 friend at 0700Z on Tuesdays around 14150-14155kc. Gets irritated at c.w. breakers, however. If you wait until his sked is over, he sometimes will listen for callers inside the American Phone Band. However, in another six weeks the W6-operators will be ready to work everyone...
- TURKEY More calls showing up LP in the mornings. TAIRF coming through at 14212kc at 1600Z. QSL via DJ4SK. TA3CC also in about the same time and frequency with a very strong signal from an antenna 5-wavelengths on each side. Handle is Ike and QSL direct.
- JAN MAYEN JX3XD coming in at 00002, transmitting 14198kc and listening four or five kcs up.
