GUS BROWNING Scheduled to depart New York Monday, February 17th on a flight to Dakar in Senegal. Gus is due to land in 6W8-land early in the morning of February 18th. His announced frequencies will be:

c.w. 3552, 7026, 14026, 21026 and 28026kc

SSB: 3796, 7196, 14196, 21396 and 28496kc

160m frequencies have not been announced though Gus says he will try that plus a try at 6 meters. QSLs go to W4ECI....and Gus needs help---financial.

MALPELO HKØTU this coming weekend under the guidance of HK3RQ commencing around February 21st. Landing conditions are difficult so watch for this operation even though it may not open on schedule. c.w. frequencies as given are just inside low end of band...no more than 5 kcs and listening up. SSB is 14195kcthat the only announced one but watch for the usual phone spots on other bands. QSLs to HK3RQ. Their schedule calls for departing for Malpelo on February 20th and landing on February 21st.....but rough seas may change this somewhat.

NORFOLK VK2BRJ/9 opened up from Norfolk Is. this past Thursday working twenty c.w. into the states. QSL to W4WS. VK2BRJ/9 due to operate for week-ten days and then W6BPO comes onto the scene to sign VK2BPO/9 for a week or so.

HEARD ISLAND Late reports indicate that the USCG SOUTHWIND will depart Perth around the first of March enroute to Heard Island for a week and then the SOUTHWIND will proceed onward to Mauritius. The schedule calls for the SOUTHWIND to be at Heard Island for one week. Two operators reported as available for the effort and the call to be used is reported to VKØWR. The schedule is subject to some variations due to operational assignments of the SOUTHWIND and it was indicated that it might be two or three days later than the above dates.....seems the SOUTHWIND had to break a path through the ice to extract a Swedish freighter. Additional late information is expected as the operation develops.

RAEM Ernst was reported aboard a USSR icebreaker in the Weddell Sea just south of the South Orkneys and east of the Palmer Peninsula last week...62° south, 30°w. transmitting at 14050kc at 0440Z on Lincoln's Birthday. Now hows that for giving even the location of the USSR vessels. The WCDXB has informants everywhere!!!

MacQUARRIE VKØIA coming through February 12th from 1530-1630Z, transmitting at 14195kc and listening above 14235. QSL via VK3IA...which apparently is not in the Call Book at this time. Anyone with information....???

FUNNY FARM 807BB, Bud, 21318kc at 2215Z on February 14th. Beam heading 100° from the West Coast. Said he was on the island of San Pablo.....1000 miles from Havana. Draw a 1000 mile circle around Havana and see what that takes in. Z1KAA & Z1KKB. Georg and Eugene on 21mc, January 25th. College students operating the club station there....Z1KAA was c.w. and Z1KKB was SSB. Who was it so said there is nothing new to work? ZD7DX, 3849kc at 0900Z Feb 2nd. Strong in Utah...weak on the coasts.

K6KA/F08AA Should be on this week-end....will have to have baby-sitter from the club at his elbow and may concentrate on the higher frequencies.

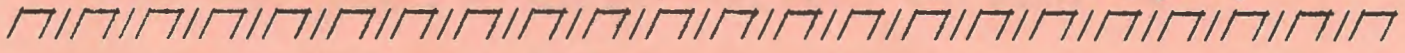
