

- AVES Indications continue to firm up the projected operation in December with the 10th of the month as the date of the opening. 4MØA or possibly 4MØAB as the possible call. Also, c.w. to be the predominant mode. Transportation seems to be the key to the operation at this time.
- CLIPPERTON Previously reported plans for an FO8-Clipperton still indefinite with sometime after the first of the year being mentioned as the time for the project. However, another group with a French license has indicated that they also are looking for a Clipperton effort early next year and will announce definite plans when things jell...which should be in February. The leader of this group has operated in the Caribbean and appears to have plans rather well developed. As it stands now, there are good prospects for a 1970 Clipperton effort.
- TROMELIN New stations being reported. FR7ZO/T was at 14213kc at 1435Z on Nov 11th
- REVIILA GIGEDO The XELJ/XF4 plans ran into a transportation snag at the last minute and had to postpone their planned operations for 30 days. Their plans now call for XF4-operations from December 16th to 18th...same frequencies and times as previously announced.
- KURE KH6NR-Kure opened on schedule last week and worked with consistently good signals as long as the bands were opened. Were being worked LP by Europeans who were beaming over the South Pole. No QSLs go to Kure Island but do go to 530 Peltier Ave, Honolulu, Hawaii 96818.
- SPRATLY VS6DR still firm on planning for early next year. The November issue of the Oriental Ham Magazine (OHM) announced that details will be available in December.
- MARIAN IS Des, the new operator at ZS2MI, does come on regularly Saturdays and Sundays from 0730-1000Z and during the week at odd times from 1300Z onwards. A tentative plan calls for ZS2MI to check with ZS6LW around 0300Z to see what conditions are like....and often ZS6LW acts as m.c. for the a.m. signal out of Marian. Trouble with the stations IMO have them using a Signal Generator and this seems to favor 14310-14315kc. They are scrounging for a SSB rig to put Marian Is solidly in business. Des will be on Marian for two years and is quite willing to be active.
- GABON TR8MC still persistent....14215kc at 1950Z on November 11th. QSL to W2YY who has logs and is mailing cards. Also active is TR8GD who was at 28613kc on November 10th. TR8MC has been on as late as 2200Z within the bottom 30kcs of the twenty meter phone band and frequently works by districts when the pile-ups get heavy. The handle for TR8MC is Claude...and TR8DG also around 21290/1900Z.
- FUNNY RARM XZ2DW, Toe in downtown Rangoon coming through at 14208kc at 1630Z on November 12th. Said to QSL via WA8NJP....who would rather you would not. Beam heading was 45-60°...Crooked Path. Easy to work...hard to QSL

Also found on fifteen around 21300-21310kc from 0900Z. 5T5YL, XYL of 5T5AD, also frequently found on these frequencies...sometimes with a F-land m.c.

NEW AMSTERDAM IS FB8ZZ, coming through at 21280kc at 1415Z last week...November 9th.

There is some suspicion that some of the FB8ZZ contacts were via the Funny Farm and may not show in FB8ZZs logs.

## SHORTLY NOTED

At the present time there still seems to be a survey group on Heard Island but no amateur operation...alack. VP8JV will be heading for South Georgia for a twelve month stay . VQ9B...at 14030kc/1500Z early this month...is reported to have a new boat and will be visiting the needed spots in the coming year. WAJATP is handling the VRIQ QSLs now. TG4SR with the wrong beam heading is suspected of being the perpetrator of some of the HH9DL pirating. Also looked at with some suspicion is FR8MAR who claimed to be on Comoro. HAITI HH9DL, Don, at 14212kc at 1225% on Movember 6th. Also on most week-days from 2345 to 0100%...skeds W5KYL at 0000% at 14215kc or thereabouts. Don says that he operated c.w. in DX tests about 15 years ago and has worked little c.w. since then...working c.w. only on rare occasions.

On the HH9DL c.w. contacts, Don says that his secretary, who also operates the commercial stations including teletype, voice and aircraft voice for the local airport, does most of his QSLing for him as he is often away from the station or out of the country. When the c.w. cards started to come through it caught her by surprise and QSLs were sent for c.w. contacts....which were made by a pirate. Over 500 cards for pirated HH9DL contacts were returned. Cards for HH3LV are frequently received...these apparently being for 5H3LV contacts. HH9DL is the only active Haiti station at this time and Don handles all HH9-QSL Bureau chores. He has been the honorary president of the Haitien Radio Club for over twenty years. Look for him on the above frequencies and wait until the sked is over...Don will work as many as time will allow.
