

# West Coast DX

## Bulletin

August 26, 1969

GUS Gus arrived back in the states last week-end and his Indian Ocean efforts are suspended until next Spring. Weather conditions in the Indian Ocean are not the best right now with the approach of the winter season there. A deposit for a vessel to be used in next Springs efforts is said to have been made and it is hoped that Blenheim, Geysler and others will be put on the air at that time. On the question of country status for Bandepuse Cay, Bertaut Reef, etc., all the available papers will be sent to the ARRL for consideration and decision there. According to relayed reports, these reefs are uninhabited, unlivable at high tide and the indigenous population is mainly crabs and ants. Gus's equipment is following him home to South Carolina and was not lost when the trimaran capsized.

FRANZ JOSEF LAND One station active at this time and a DXpedition effort possible around the turn of the year. UALKED being reported at 14022kc at 1730Z on August 19th. This station will be active for a few months...has been reported as high as 14060kc and as early as 1230Z. UALCK says that an operation from Franz Josef is possible in four or five months...two or three operators...the call-sign to be either UALCK/Franz Josef or possibly UALKBW/.

CHAD Operations from this area in mid-September by 5A3TX who will then go on to EP3-land. QSLs for the TT8 operation to be handled by WA3HUP.

OGASAWARA IS. The JARL effort from the Bonins is due this week...scheduled to open on August 25th...using the prefix JDL... and operating until September 5th. JA3UI who will be in on the effort says that he will put 1KW on the 160 meter band.

COCOS IS Word from HPLJC indicates that the TI8NAM/TI9 operation of early July should be accepted for DXCC Credit. Juan advises that the captain of the vessel, the SS Caribe, noted in the ships log that he had landed and picked up Noggy Morales, TI8NAM from Cocos. It is also reported that when the vessel was in New Orleans, that a certified (notarized) statement was obtained attesting to the operation. TI4JP also working on the QSL cards and information received indicates that the necessary documentation will be forwarded to the ARRL.

SERRANA BANK The plans by K6JGS/HK3 and HK7BKX for a quick try at Serrana Band fell through when transportation difficulties developed. As of Thursday the plans were still on but when the boat to be used developed engine trouble, it was not possible to line up a replacement in time to make the trip and be back on San Andres by Monday. Possible that an operation may come off in the Spring when weather conditions would be more favorable. WA6AHF may join in the effort if the plans jell. Baja Nuevo was also mentioned as a possibility in this effort and it is possible that both may come off in the Spring.

UGANDA 5Z4KL/A showed up as scheduled last Friday.

TUNISIA Much activity. 3V8AC at 21310kc, 1840Z on August 19th. 3V8MOL almost daily at 14211kc at 0300Z. 3V8AC running 1kw to GP 24' up in air. 3V8AA using several operators for almost continuous operation 80-10m....look for this station on 20m around 14215kc from 0100Z....c.w. around 14025kc from 0000Z. 3V8NC also hanging around the low end of twenty phone from 0200Z.

5BWAS and Other Matters Some questions being raised on the effective date of 5BWAS now being January 1, 1970. Some point out that DX stations after going through the rollers on the 5BDXCC now will have to start all over if they are interested in the 5BWAS. Suggested that effective date be rolled back to coincide with the 5BDXCC.

Directors of the ARRL will hold special Board Meeting November 1st. If you or your club have any ideas on the pending second-stage of the Incentive License implementation due November 22nd; the 5BWAS or the documentation requirements for DXpeditions....or other matters, this is the time to see your Director and give him your ideas.

EGYPT SULIM at 14000kc...or possibly a few lower...on August 19th at 0440Z. Was listening up inside the band.

KAZAKH UL7SG at 14228kc, 0415Z on August 23rd. UL7NW at 14213kc at 0355Z same date.

NEW HEBRIDES YL8JM at 14039kc 0930Z on August 21st.

HAITI Some stations affirming that cards have been received for c.w. contacts w/HH9DL. The same time, others saying that calls by W/Ks and some countries not answered. Other reports that Don has not worked c.w. for some years....other reports that he is on regularly. It does seem an inconsistency. There does seem to be good reason to believe that someone at times has pirated Don's call....beam heading from states not in HH9-direction. Anyhow, if you hear him...work him first and then try to clear the confusion later.

INDIA Strong signals coming through SP from 1500Z. VU2KV consistently coming through with strong signals...helped by a 2-element Quad 130' above the ground. Also coming through are VU2DK...14257kc/1500Z; VU2QN...14025kc/0140Z; VU2SL/14024/0200Z

MARION IS New operator on the island...but no action, schedules in the amateur bands. ZS6OB who used to m.c. for the previous operator has been on vacation and is expected home shortly. Efforts to contact ZS2MI through the South African Department of Transport have not been successful.

SHORTLY NOTED A few issues back we listed A2CAU as AC2.... it was the speedy typing that did it. K5AAD could not operate in 9Y4-land....could not get his gear out of customs. XT2AN continued to show up during the last week...but difficult to work on the West Coast. No further word on the Nevada Boys DX trip after they by-passed Monaco. CR8AIs QSL cards confirm that Torres (c.w. operator) is the third hand at the station. IRCS are good in Okinawa....in fact they are good in any U.S. Post Office...APO--FPO..or home-grown variety. Sometimes problem with those issued in the U.S. Many rumors of some having accomplished the 5BDXCC goal...worked/not confirmed including an OH...a G3..etc. W4BRB is down to 10 on 80 to complete his effort. WB4JXV expects to operate 40/80 from KW6=Wake around the end of the month. Also, KJ6BZ said to be available...if a sked made...on 40/80. Make the schedule on 14mc SSB...look for him around 0300Z. Also within 10 of the goal is W4AQW and W4IC. A TI9-operation is being scheduled for the 1st week in January.

THAILAND Still no clarification on the HS stations and still no information on the reciprocal agreement being signed. Word from the ARRL DX Desk would indicate that the WB2WYX/HS operation is not an authorized one and that third party traffic (phone patches) is definitely out.

QATAR Some reports of possible operations. OD5BZ who has been working on a permit for an operation is reported to have things cleared for a possible November or December operation. Some indications that military personnel have little hope of getting permission to operate but civilians may get the okay from the Sheik. OD5BZ in the U.S. Embassy in Lebanon also holds the call MP4QBR. Also reported is a possible 14mc c.w. effort from Qatar around the end of this month. Mobile equipment would be used in this one.

SPANISH SAHARA EA9ER still the active station and usually around 21335kc from 1730Z though one source indicates that due to change in working hours that 1900Z to 2400Z might be a more productive time. Has also shown up elsewhere in the band, having been worked around 21117kc. Also on c.w. at times around 14025-14030kc around 0200. EA8EJ also reported around the same c.w. frequency, being worked last week at 14038kc at 0220Z on August 20th. Some confusion at times over location of EA9ER...some saying the station is in Spanish Morocco (Ceuta and Mellila). EA9ERs QSLs give his QTH as Spanish Sahara. Active from EA9-Ceuta and Mellila has been EA9AI and EA9AZ.

TOKELAUS ZM7ES at 14010kc, 1740Z August 23rd. Listening up twenty...said to QSL to VK3AE.

MALI TZ1NE operating at 14130+ 10/15 around 1900Z. No QSL information. Others skeptical of this one. Also reported is a possible operation around Aug 30th with 14125kc--SSB given as the operation frequency--0300Z. Mali apparently is a country which has never issued an amateur license.
