MACAO CR9AK will be operated for two days by VS6DR on October 18th and 19th. The frequencies to be used will be 14240kc and 21340kc, listening up 10kc. The operation will be aimed at North America. QSL to VS6DR. 5 IRCs with s.a.s.e. will bring quick QSL, otherwise Phil plans to QSL entire log through bureaus.

CLIPPERTON (Rumor) There is a story that a license...with the call-sign FO8EC... has been issued for a Clipperton operation. A well known DXer involved. The effort was initially scheduled for August but had to be postponed. Possibly will come off in October or early November. This is a rumor...passed as such. There may be something to it...there may not be. Time...the great equalizer... will tell.

CHAD TP8AF has been showing up occasionally. In late September showed up on 21295kc around 1945Z one day and could find no great number of takers. QSL to Bx 444, Ft. Lamy. Has also been reported at 21265kc around 0900Z. Has also been noted in the past on twenty just above 14100kc as late as 1900Z.

GABON TR8MC showing around 14220kc almost daily around 2000Z. Often opens with a QSO...in French...with WB2AVE and sometimes takes list from Wick. TR8DG may sometime show up on week-ends on 15....sometimes right on 21275kc....sometimes around 21300kc around 2100Z. F9GL m.c.ing. QSL information for TR8MC is W2YY.

SPRATLEY VS6DR still working on a possible operation from this island sometime this Fall. DX1HMI also in on the planning. Transportation no problem....finding out something about the topography, landing sites, surrounding waters is the big hangup. Phil would appreciate any information on this.

SOUTH SHETLANDS CE9AT at 14029kc, 0120Z on October 1st. Operator was Jose and QSL to CE3ZN. CE9AF on King George Island until next year....21026kc at 2100Z Oct 3rd

MONGOLIA JT1AG starting to come through again. Was at 14212kc at 1400Z on Sept 29th. Last season this was a rather consistent performer around this time and frequency.

AFGHANISTAN YA1SG at 21281kc at 1500Z on October 7th. Said he would be on this band every day, usually around 21255kc from 1530Z. May move higher in frequency at times. Will be in YA-land for a year.

EUROPA FR7ZP/E still coming through. Was at 14201kc at 1300Z on October 7th.

CRETE SV0WN on his Wednesday schedule again. Was at 14220kc last Wednesday, Oct 8th at 0330Z. QSL via K3EUR.

NORFOLK VK9LB often on 21mc before the band goes out, usually around 21290kc from 0230Z. Was there on October 10th. In the mornings is found on the low part of the 20m phone band...was at 14198kc at 1430 on October 7th....at 14020kc at 1500Z on the same date.

EASTER ISLAND CE0AE still on the air but advises no plans for 80m operation at this time. Paul, the present operator said last week that they have no permission to operate there and besides, they have heavy traffic schedules. Was at 14225kc at 0800Z on October 7th.

MEXICO Some rumblings.....apparently newspaper criticism early this year of licenses being issued to foreigners. Suspected to be caused by XEs unhappy over privileges being given without a reciprocal agreement. New regulations being imposed by Mexican government effective end of this year.

All amateurs licensed since 1951 must pass a code test....10wpm for a ten minute period for a Second-Class license; 15wpm for 15 minutes for First-Class and passing mark of 91% must be attained.

No non-citizens currently getting new or renewed licenses but in the works is an amendment to the present law to delete the citizenship requirements and this is expected to pass. No temporary mobile permits being issued right now to visiting amateurs.

ALGERIA 7XØWW being reported. Was at 14028kc at 1800Z on October 8th.

UZBEK UI8CD coming through rather consistently. Was at 14215kc at 1230Z on October 4th coming thru LP. At 14230kc at 0330Z on Oct 8th...SP and also at 14205kc at 0400Z on Oct 10th...again SP. Consistently good signal.

MARTINIQUE W4OPM has schedule at 1700Z some where between 21390-21400kc. Joe, who is also the QSL manager for Pierre, FM7WQ, will be on the schedule a bit ahead of times to take a list of those wishing to work FM7WQ.

FRENCH GUIANA The effort of PZ1BX has been postponed until late this month...probably will be the last week of the month. Expected call to be used - PZ1BX/FY.

QSLs VS5MC and FØUS/FC...both last July operations...are being bounced back by the ARRL DX Desk. However, TI8NAM/TI9 cards are being accepted for credit.

OHM (Oriental Ham Magazine) The Hongkong-based Pacifica Publishing Company has turned out the first issue; slick paper, pictures and news of the Far East Amateur operations. Intended to be a month publication, it goes for \$2.00 per year via surface mail. Address is OHM, Bx 16321, Hongkong.

AWARDS Two Awards to mark the 200th Anniversary of Captain Cook explorations in the Pacific are available. From New Zealand the award comes for work 50 ZM stations, at least one each from ZM1-2-3-4. Send certified list including log data to ZL2GX with 3 IRCs to cover surface mail. Band/Mode endorsements available.

From Australia the award is for working 50 AX stations during 1970. Send alphabetical certified list with full log data to WIA, Box 67, East Melbourne, Victoria...mark 'Cook Award' on envelope. No charge for surface return...8 IRCs for airmail.
