SPRATLEY--NOT YET VS6DR advised this week that the date on his Spratley operations was premature and that he will be in Europe on business during the next few weeks. At this time the possible date for the effort is after the first of the year. Phil has made inquiry to the ARRL what they will require for documentation. The call to be used is not definite, the VS6-call probably will not be used and either Phil's U.S. call or that of a Britisher who will participate in the operation will be used. Not only is Phil making definite plans for the Spratley operation but there are also a few other places in the Far East that they are looking at closely.

COCOS T18PE, Boots, still looking for some operators for the Cocos effort next month but finding few responses. As of the first week in November Boots advised that at that point it looked like he would be the only amateur on this trip with a number of fishermen clamoring for the berths being held for possible interested amateurs. The operation plans for six days on the island and Boots would be glad to hear from some phone operators also.

Departure is planned from Punta Arenas in Costa Rica December 1st with arrival at Cocos on December 3rd, landing at Wafer Bay.

Boots can be found daily at or around 21360-21380kc at 1500Z and at the same frequency Mon/Wed/Fri/Sun at 0100Z.

KURE KH6NR/Kure should be on when you receive this bulletin...or ready to fire up. KM6BI might be watched for late information....14240kc at 0600Z....and progress reports. The operators were due to leave Hawaii by Northwest Jet to Midway and then via Navy plane to Kure.

GLORIOSO Apparently the policy is to relieve the two-man weather teams on these French Islands every four months and Guy, FR7ZL/T says that an amateur will be assigned to Glorioso in the near future.

MADEIRA DJ6QT/CT3 coming through regularly on 10m and 15m. Usually found 28575kc to 28600kc from 1700Z. Around 1800Z often shifts to 15m and is found close to 21300kc. Has been on 10m as late as 1900Z though this is not usual. Name is Walt and QSL via W2GHK.

KERMADEC ZMLAAT/K, Roy, is being heard mostly on c.w. at this time. His rig fell into the sea during the landing and he has been trying to nurse it back to health. Hopes to be on SSB before long. Last week Roy was working them in bunches on the low end of the 7mc band from 1100Z. Roy also reports hearing U.S. stations on 80m but his set-up does not allow him to transmit on that frequency yet but he should be on shortly. QSL to ZL2AFZ. Also, 14038kc at 0700Z on November 5th

EAST PAKISTAN AP2MR, Rafiq, has received permission for operations in East Pakistan and is now planning for a January effort.

COMORO FR7ZG, Reliable Guy with the strong signal, says that he is planning to go to FH8-Comoro sometime in January or February.

MALTA 9H1BB showing up regularly. Was calling CQ at 28579kc at 1550Z on November 2nd and getting little attention. Also at 14215kc at 0330Z on the 5th....the lower 20 kcs seems to be the hangout of Law around this time. Also reported was 9H1BL at 28056kc at 1350Z on Nov 5th; 9H1M at 14224 at 1515Z, also November 5th and the same station at 14230c/1510Z a few days earlier. 9H1M usually slow QSLer.

Marcel does have regular contacts with the French stations in the South Indian Ocean...FB8ZZ, FB8XX, the FR7s etc. and often helps with information. With the new antenna Marcel will be available for schedules....Mondays only, either c.w. or SSB. Also being reported is FL8DG who was on 21276kc at 1200Z on November 6th. QSL for FL8DG to Box 538, Djibouti. FL8MB was also reported at 14027kc at 2130Z on Nov 4th.

ROYAL SIGNALS AMATEUR RADIO SOCIETY The group will celebrate their 50th Anniversary in 1970 and are looking for a proper observance by a number of DXpeditions..... Rockall popping up in the discussions from time to time....though this would be a tough one. Possibly some interesting ones may come in 1970 through the efforts of the Royal Signals Amateurs.

CYPRUS Long path bringing in the stations in the mornings. ZC4AK at 28594kc, 1250Z on November 5th....calling CQ. ZC4GM, Gordon, coming through LP at 14217kc, 1510Z on November 3rd....QSL to G3MCY.

CT2AT was coming through on 75 SSB during the CQ Contest.....was at 3797kc and listening at 3830kc. 9M2LN during November will schedule W1ELR Saturdays and Sundays at 1300Z on 14060Z....looking for Maine and Vermont for WAS. Nara has an 80m antenna up but local QRM has kept any signals from getting through. May make 40/80 schedules on his 20m frequency. ZE3JJ, Ivan, continues to get through to the Western Reaches on 80m...usually around 0300-0400Z. That DJ6QT/CT3 is said to be on 40/80m but no reports of any contacts received. The Triennial Conference of Region I of the IARU last May accepted a recommendation that 80m between 3500 to 3510kc, and 3790-3800kc be used exclusively for International Contacts. Europe/Africa asked to cooperate and observe these recommendations. However, some problems with W/Vs plus the novices might be expected.

YA2HWI says that he has put 2000 cards into the bureau recently. With LP in, some should recall that LP may range from 190 to 240°...if calling, specify area you are beaming. GUS W4BPD making plans for another Spring effort...a 60-90 day swing to include Chagos, Blenheim, St. Brandon, Agalega, Farquhar, Wizard Reef, Aldabra, Geyser Reef, Juan de Nova, Comoro and then possibly a fling at AC5/AC3

UPPER VOLTA XT2AA, Jacques, still in there. Was at 14217kc at 2130Z on Oct 29th. Also on that frequency at that time was TR8MC, FL8MB, TU2AZ and 7Z3AB. Jacques still has nothing definite on his TZ-Mali plans but feels that the prospects are encouraging. It would entail about a 900 kilometer run in the Land Rover and about 1½ days travel each way. Jacques is getting ready to go RTTY and is finishing up a TU...would be interested in a donation of a Model 14 TD should someone wish to help. Along this line of thought, 5T5AD should be on RTTY next month and TU2AK is already active. WB2VAE has a schedule with XT2AA every day at 14217kc at 2100z ...do not let the French language discourage you. Nick, WB2VAE will acknowledge a discreet and polite breaker.

SNARES ISLAND This is for real.....48° south, 166° east. Don't let the name trip you. ZM1BN/A will be active there from 20 November through February 1970. Will work all bands, c.w. and SSB. Probably too close to New Zealand to count for a new country...about 200 miles from the mainland...but it may be side trips to Antipodes, Bounty and Campbell Islands. ZM2AFZ, who will handle any QSLs, will also sound the clarion call if anything special is in the offing...will furnish frequencies, dates, etc.

RIO de ORO (AKA Spanish Sahara). EA9EJ following pretty much a set routine. His nominal frequencies are 14040, 14080, 7020, 7040 and 3520kc.....14040/7020/3520kc best possibilities however. Will be on the air every sixth day from 0030Z commencing November 11th. (November 11, 17, 23, Dec 5, 11, 17, 23, 29th). Usually opens on 20m, shifts to 7mc around 0230Z and sometimes to 3.5mc at 0300Z. Is using a FT-DX 150. On November 5th was on the above frequencies for 20/14038.850, on 7mc was at 7019kc and on 3.5mc was at 3519.
