EGYPT SULMA working the SWAN Cygnet and was at 14216kc at 1655Z on January 18th. Coming through with 5/8 signal SP to the West Coast. QSL to Abdel Moety Attiya, P.O. Box 840, Cairo.

FERNANDO de NORONHA PY7AWD/Ø being reported both on 40 and 20m. Was at 7006kc at 2320Z on Jan 15th; at 7015kc at 0145Z on the 17th. Also reported at 14029kc at 0050Z on January 20th.

EAST PAKISTAN The Northern Europe Desk reports that AP2MR, Rafiq, has all the gear, a CTH to operate from and everything else for an East Pakistan effort. Rafiq can get there in a 3-hour flight but is presently tied up with examinations. May go there in a few weeks...may not make it for months. May show up unannounced. Mr. Ahmed of the Pakistani Postal Department visited the WCDXB last week. The first thing we asked him was when was he going to get some amateur operation in East Pakistan. Son of a gun....don't say we will not go right to the top to stimulate activity. Wish we could report success but Mr. Ahmed said that all the Pakistanis..almost...are in West Pakistan. Sort of confirmed our suspicion

ALBANIA Frank, DL7FT, sending late information for next weeks bulletin. Still looks good and Frank is optimistic about a possible operation this Spring. The North Europe Desk reports lots of ZAs being reported, three of them on at once this past Monday.

AWARDS The Rome Centenary Award can be gained by working 8 stations (if you are outside Europe) during 1970. You need 8 points, each QSO counting 1 point, but if you work any on September 20, 1970 they will count for 3 points. Send the certified list with 8 IRCs to Bx 361, Rome. That may interest you in those IRØ-calls.

The Lenin Award is available for working 50 Russians during 1970 and the list must include 3 QSOs with each of the regions where Lenin lived including UA1, UA2, UA3, UA4, UA9, UAØ.

TURKEY Some new calls being reported...at least they have not surfaced before. TALMS was at 14216kc at 1455Z on Jan 20th. TA2SC at the same spot at 2025Z a few days earlier. The latter also checking into the YL-SSB System, appearing around 2000Z. Has also been reported around 14235kc.

BELGIUM ON4DY and ON4UN running regular schedule 0500-0630Z on Saturdays and Sundays. Usually close to 3502-3504kc. Being heard on the West Coast. ON5VW workin with an m.c. at the band edge at 3500kc, moving up the band at times. Was coming through with a good signal from 0440Z on Jan 17th.

SINGAPORE 9V10Y has been making week-end schedules for 80m from 1430-1600Z. Says that 3502-3505kc frequency helps him avoid an Asian RTTY station. QSL direct. Some indications are that some 7-land stations fare better with Mal than the 6s.

SAMOA KS6DH now on 80m. Weekdays can only be active 0400-0900Z. Can be on later on week-ends. Jerry indicates that around 0600Z best for the states and he is hearing VS6 and HL9 at that time, also. Was at 3510kc at 1200Z on January 17th ...that being a Saturday. Also putting up a TH6DX. QSL to Gerald A. Johnson, Dept of Education, Pago Pago 96920. KS6CK also reported as active on 80m.

LIBERIA EL2BE with strong signal coming through on January 16th at 0330Z.. also slightly earlier on the 17th at 0255Z. 3501.5kc. QSL to Charles Yaciw, American Embassy, Box 98, Monrovia.

SUDAN ST2SA reported as looking for QSOs on 80m from 0100-0330Z. Presently having some problems with the high level of static at his QTH. Willing to try schedules around 0330Z. MARKET REEF Word from Eric, OH2BW, reports that the OJØ effort worked 140 countries during their 9200 QSOs, they working 6 bands including 144mc. Main effort was on 20 to give the maximum number of individuals an OJØ contact on the first Market Reef effort rather than looking for multiple 5BDXCC contacts. C.W. was mostly 40/80 though 20 c.w. was used quite a bit the last few days. C.W. probably will be given more emphasis in the next effort which may be in either May or July and it is expected conditions would be better into the Pacific. Except for some not getting Eric's sea-legs, the high seas which delayed the return, the breakdown in their vehicle in -15°C. temperature enroute home and the long tow necessary, Eric said the trip was a success.... 9200 QSOs would indicate that. Another source says the correct pronunciation of 'Market' would be 'Mark' in English.

SENEGAL 6W8GE and 6W8XX operating tandem....21025kc from 2000Z usually. Somewhat confusing with these two stations calling CQ, eaching sending one letter and answering calls in the same manner. Good operators but adding a wrinkle which may throw the unwary. Answer both with separate signal reports and you may end up with two QSOs. 6W8XX said to be in bed with a broken leg.

COCOS The TI9CI effort expected to leave TI-land February 6th and be on the air on February 8th....1800Z anticipated time. Six or seven operators are lined up for the trip and they are expected to keep the bands busy....80 thru 10m. QSLs go to TI2CMF for this effort.

WA5GFS is advising that he has not received as yet the logs for the TI8PE/TI9 operation....but does expect them just about this time in January. Boots presently is in the states and the QSL cards he ordered are expected from the printers, Boots wishing some special cards made up. WA5GFS, Lee, hopes to be putting the cards into the mails within a few days of receipt....meanwhile, patience.
