SHORTLY NOTED CTLBK QSL mgr for CR9AK..can arrange skeds. Next one March 4th. Some doubt on the TY6 on Ten a few weeks ago. The rig at TY6ATE is an EICO for 20/40/80 and TY6ATE, Ted Schultz, is presently stateside and will be until this Fall. Anyone with information. AP5HQ responds to W2SAWs mint stamps...plus persistence. ARRL indicates ~~nix~~-VE6AJT/KB6..apparently no FCC permission to operate. FB8WW expected to be active in 30-40 days. K6UJS thought the rash was because of the tension in the pile-ups...turned out to be measles. Anything goes when DX is on. March QST confirms OJØMR accepted as of March 1st. VE3IG reports no logs for two months from ET3USA but expects improvement with a new group at Asmara. MP4Q was coming through with good signals while WWV was reporting U-6. Some pessimism developing over the possibility of FR7ZU/E and FR7ZP/E QSLs.

WEST INDIES VP2AASL at 14269kc at 0320Z on February 23rd. Sam reported that all future provisional Antigua licenses for visitors will have a four letter suffix usually VP2AA plus two additional assigned letters. Home call for VP2AASL is W2BKU.

KURE QSLs KH6BZF has the KH6EDY logs from 1 January 1961 to 31 December 1969. Some 1969 logs may be invalid because logs were not properly signed. However, Lee will handle these ones on a case-by-case basis. If you are looking for a KH6EDY QSL for the above period, send s.a.s.e to KH6BZF. No cards will be sent via bureaus. DX stations send 2 IRCs for surface..4 IRCs for airmail. Any surplus or donations will be used to perpetuate the KH6EDY QSL operation and relieve Coast Guard personnel from any expense. Presently it is hoped that personnel on the island will pass their amateur exam and have the Kure station back on the air.

DEPARTURES ZM1BN/A reported to have shut down the Snares Island operation on the 20th of February....no operation expected from this spot for about a year. JX4GN is departing Jan Mayen in May and then may be assigned to Svalbard. VP9NS from Norfolk says that he will be leaving shortly.
