## Bulletin

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April 7, 1970 14-70

FANNING ISLAND VR3AA, Bob, should be active April 6-8th. Will operate 10 thru 40 in the limited time there. Will have a schedule with KH6GLU at 0400Z at 14265kc and short lists may be taken. Home call is KH6FNB...not a hardened DXer and pile-ups may bother. May try to pick up logs for VR3C while there and see if that station still active.

CLIPPERTON WB2VAE, Nick, has received endorsement to his F0NH for portable operation from Clipperton, the endorsement becoming valid June 15, 1970 and will be valid for three months. Nick has joined with some French DXers including F5NH, F2QQ, and they will attempt a joint effort. Previously these French operators have put on 3V8AA for some 12,000 QSOs. A weeks effort is being planned. The group is looking for up-dated information on Clipperton, particularly on the weather, landing conditions and any possible vessels in the Pacific Coast thereabouts that may be available for transportation. Anyone interested in helping with the operation or who may have information, can direct it to Nicholas A. Neuhaus, 160-42 85th St., Howard Beach, N.Y. 11414. It does appear definite that financial help will be needed.

JORDAN Another entry in the QRM Derby, EP2HL/JY1 appeared March 30th around 1500Z. Was at 14207kc at 1506Z....moved to 14209kc to try to clear the QRM, vanished after working a few there. The Friday schedules....with the lists...have not jelled with King Hussein. No consistent pattern to JY1 operations apparent, does get on when possible, often reported from 1300Z onwards on 20m.

SIKKIM AC3PT being reported as active. Was at 14211kc at 1650Z on March 29th...not especially strong but copied. Gave handle as Namu...coming through SP. Indicates that he would be active around 0130Z and 1330Z daily. Also reported as checking into the SEA Net, 14320kc at 1200Z.

GUS Ready to take off for the Indian Ocean area plus stops enroute. Waiting for the licenses to be cleared. Initial operations indicated for Blenheim Reef, Geyser Reef and Fernando Poo. Possible activity shortly.

ALBANIA-CRISIS With the deadline for the final planning for the ZA-effort by DL7FT and DL7VY in May reached and passed, the financial problem of mounting the effort seems to be the biggest problem at this time and one which may founder the long planning and effort.

It is reported that less than one-third of the anticipated costs have been raised and in hand to date. The devious route to be followed plus certain arrangements which are to be made within Albania will be more than the funds on hand will finance. The stipulation alone of two 'observers' to monitor all the operations is a sizeable problem alone to the DXpedition. There is no possibility of doing any of the operation on credit, Bank AmericaCard/American Express Card/Master Charge being no good in Albania....hard cash all the way....and in advance. With many interested in this effort but apparently waiting until a successful effort has been put on before helping, the financial picture is grim and may be the point on which the whole effort founders. Those in on the planning are holding tight for another ten days or so to see if further support is forthcoming, otherwise the whole thing may be postponed. All documents appear to be in order, it is finances that pinch. Anyone interested can direct their letters either to W6KNH or direct to DL7FT. Time is getting short on this one.

DAHOMÉY Adding to the information in the previous bulletin, there was a station signing TY6ATE who was active in 1969 and who was an Assembly of God missionary located in Natitingou, Dahomey. This operator did send TY6ATE QSLs for contacts which had his address. This missionary came back to the States late last Fall and is not expected to return to TY6-land until the Fall of 1970, being in the States for medical treatment. 3V8AL says TY6ATE has been his call since 1967. Somewhere along the line there probably is an explanation for all of this...and the WCDXB is looking for it. Hold tight!! Now there apparently was a third station signing TY6ATE...this is the one that seems suspicious at this time!

KERGUELEN FB8XX still boiling through...was at 14212kc at 1500Z on April 3rd. It is also reported that he shows up on ten meters, usually between 28550-28560kc.

UGANDA 5X5NM reported at 28047kc at 1645Z on March 25th.

CHAGOS VQ9CD continues to be reported. Was at 14032kc at 1500Z on March 27th and often shows up around this frequency at this time. Apparently Anand also works SSB and was scheduled to be at 14270kc at 1500-1600Z on April 5th. QSL via the VQ8-QSL Bureau. W6AOA disclaims any knowledge of VQ9CDC and is NOT his QSL manager.

CHAD/GABON/TOGO TT8AF reported as showing up at 14290kc at 0600Z on Sundays to join with TR8DG and 5VZBD on the frequency. Often m.c.ed by W4SPX/WA4MUB, TR8DG is looking for Montana, Wyoming, Utah and Arkansas...being crystal controlled on 14270kc and 14290kc. This round-up often starts around 0500Z on Sundays plus other activity during weekdays around this frequency...almost nightly in fact.
