CORSICA QRT/FC due to open May 4th for four week run..all possible bands.
GUINEA 3XLSJ supposed to show up about now for a 60 day effort.
POSSIBLE KM6DQ may open from Kure and ZKLAJ from Manihiki this month but no late information on either of these.
CARIBBEAN 8P6CP and 8P6AH to operate from St. Lucia/Montserrat/Dominica in June.
CLIPPERTON F0NH/F08 still in the planning stage....July still the target.

SUDAN ST2SA, Sid, appearing with some regularity. Was at 14028kc at 1510Z on April 23rd; at 21035kc at 2000Z on April 26th and at 14018kc at 0420Z on Apr 28th. Around 0400Z appears to be the best time for SP from Sudan. Sid working hard to promote contributions for some new gear. Spreading out helps to work him as his present, ancient receiver is not especially selective.

CAMEROUN TJ1AW showing up frequently including 75meters. Best time on this frequency is from 0300Z at 3510kc on Saurdays. Was also at 7011kc at 0000Z on April 28th as well as 3514kc at 0330Z on Apr 25th. On this Saturday operation CR6EI also showed up at 3513kc at 0425Z to help things a bit.

ZANZIBAR 5H5LV/A, Garth, showed up from Zanzibar again, operating over the week-end of April 25/26th and expected to be QRT by the end of the month. Was on both 15m and 20m....QSL to VE3QDX. 5H3KJ, his partner on the effort a few months back was operating from ET3DS last week, enroute home to Norway where he may be married in the coming months.

RODRIGUEZ VQ8CFB coming through almost daily from St. Brandons and says that he will be going onto Rodriguez next. Jacky was at 14026kc at 1440Z on April 26th, moving up a few to 14032kc at 1545. On April 23rd was at the usual 14026kc at 1400Z, this being the best place to watch for him.

CORN ISLAND HT4IM was on from Corn Islands on April 24th at 21093kc/1800Z. Said to QSL via W5QPX. These islands are about 50 miles east from Bluefields.

ANTARCTICA 8J1RL, Japanese, coming through at 21029kc at 1440Z on April 26th...on the LP. FB8YY, Andre, at 21041kc at 0520Z on April 29th.

6Z2A A station signing this call has been on recently, at 21048kc at 1525Z on April 28th. Claimed to be in Gambia and said to QSL via G6HV. Call Book shows this prefix assigned to Liberia.

EGYPT SU1IM, Ibrahim, on at 21024kc at 1630Z on April 28th. Reported to be on 15 c.w. rather frequently.

CANCELLED The projected effort of UALCK from Franz Josef apparently fell a victim to transportation problems at the last moment when the plane to be used to travel to Franz Josef was appropriated for other duties. Vlad somewhat upset but hopeful that something may eventually come off. The VR3AA trip to Fanning likewise appears to have been cancelled though no definite word on this received.

DAHOMAY On the TY6ATE matter, it does appear quite definite that the call was properly issued twice, once to Fred Powell, presently 3V8AL. The call was originally issued to Fred in 1967 for a three year period. Then in November 1968 it was again issued to Ted Schultz, a missionary then located in Natitingou in Dahomey.

Ted Schultz operated under this call from December 23, 1968 until May 6, 1969 when he had to return to the states for medical treatment. If you worked this station during this period, you might try sending a QSL to Ted Schultz, 605 Melba Street, Hattiesburg, Mississippi 39401.

On the third user of this call who did show up a couple of times during recent months, the general feeling is that this one is definitely a pirate.
