GUS Gus still on Comoro up to last Friday, June 12th. Reported that next appearance will be from Geyser Reef with June 12th as date to open up. Should be there for better part of week. Frequencies and times of operation given in 21-70 and 23-70. Was supposed to sail from Comoro on the 10th...apparently did not.

MARCUS No 40/80m activity planned for the coming KALB effort due to heavy interference from a 13 megawatt LORAN transmitter in close proximity to the operating spot. The 24-hour daily operation will be from July 2 through July 8th. To update the previous frequencies, they will be:

EASTER ISLAND A new operator is on the island, Father Dave Reddy (K2BUI) who will be in charge of the Franciscan Mission there and will possibly sign CEØAL. Father Dave was issued the call CEØAE and on arrival on the island was met by the Air Force Group who were a bit upset. The previous one on the island to whom the call was assigned had forgotten to renew it and it had been reissued. There were several thousand CEØAE QSLs all printed up, etc, etc. Father Dave agreed to relinquish the call to the Air Force Colonel in charge of the installation and the authorities in Santiago reissued it to the Air Force, all this with the understanding that he would get his own call. He has a NCX-1000 Transceiver and Father Dave will be found often on the YL-SSB at 14332kc.

EUROPA QSLs For those with the FR7ZU/Europa QSLs which were issued with the call-sign of the recipient written a couple of times...for extra clarity...Bob White of the ARRL DXCC Desk has indicated that these will be accepted for DXCC credit. He says they leave something to be desired but they do have the information for the FR7ZU/Europa operation already on hand.

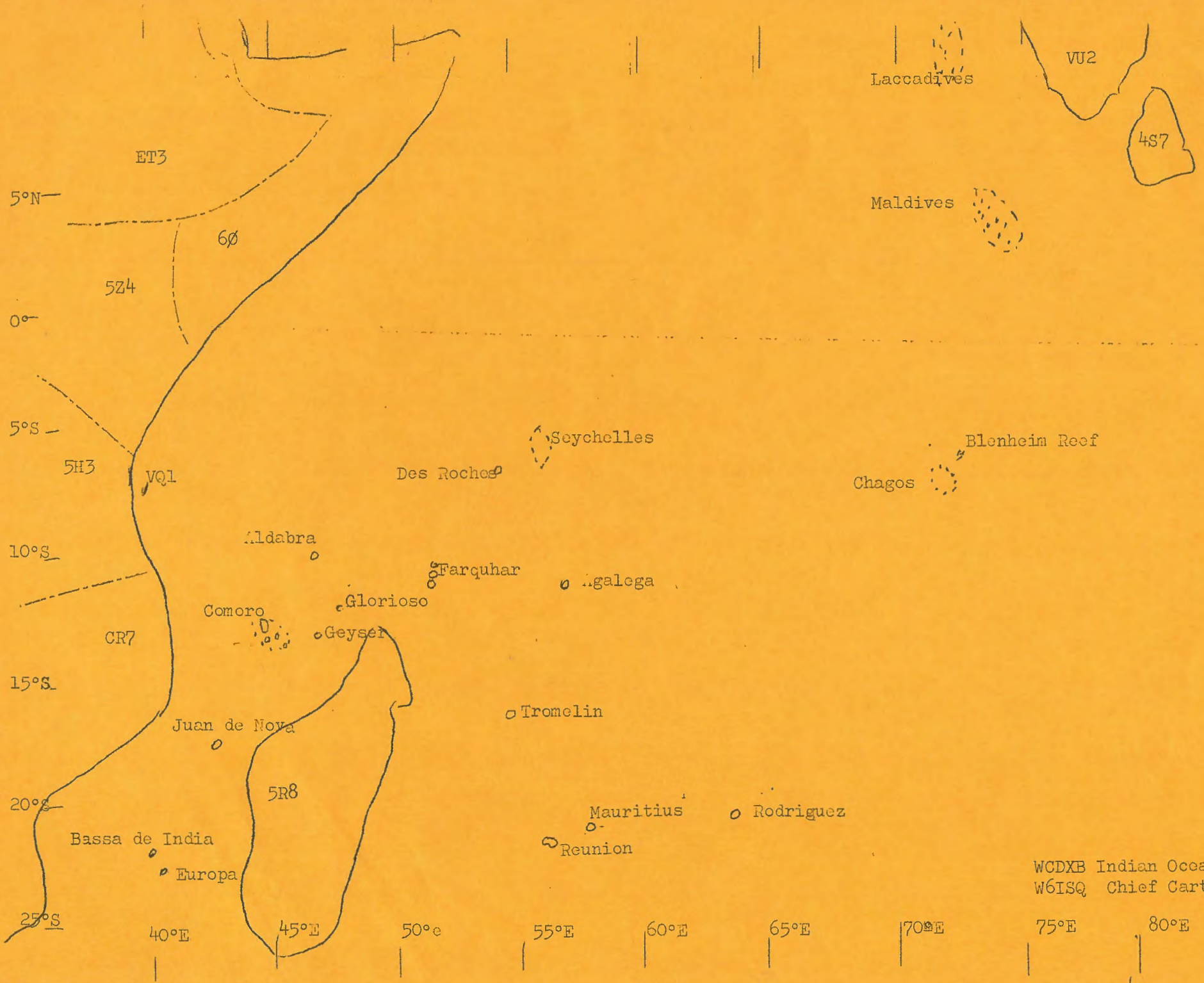

There will be amateur gear aboard and the possible call may be HC9EP. Inquiries have been made to ARRL on the exact status of Jarvis. Many scientists aboard will be from different countries, some question whether any are proficient in the English language. HPLJC working with the group trying to facilitate their planning. Jarvis Island expected to be the point where they change course and head for Australia.

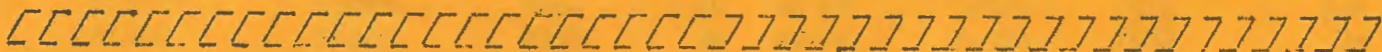
W4AMG/mm Jens Jensen, whose boat figured in the Spratly plans some months back, pushed on into the Indian Ocean after repairs were completed in Singapore. A few weeks back Jens lost the mainsail for the EXODUS and ran low on fuel off the Maldive Islands. The VS9-operators talked the Royal Navy Fleet Auxiliary at Gan Island to search for him and they found him after fifteen hours of searching. With a supply of fuel from the RN Fleet Auxiliary, Jens made it to Gan Island.

ALBANIA Plans by OH2BH group and DL7FT continue to go ahead...hopefully and with fingers crossed. The OH2-Group will depart Denmark on the weekly flight to Tirana on July 10th. In Tirana they will be quartered at a hotel whose perimeter is marked by a barbed-wire fence. Hopefully they will be able to get on the air. DL7FT still looking for September but this may be moved up slightly. The OH2BH-Group is going to investigate the possibilities and advise to watch 14195kc during the period they are there.
