ALBANIA The OH2BH/ZA operation lasted less than two days with some reports indicating that they had but a 24-hour permit. 780 QSOs reported as being made and several reports indicating that the gear was confiscated. Cryptic reports coming through from cablegrams sent from Tirana to Scandinavian amateurs. OH-Group supposedly returning to Finland this last week-end and there should be more details shortly.

If you were lucky to work them, be among the happy ones. Certainly the OH-group did prove it could be done. Whether it will be done again soon will have to be seen. Considering the problems, the OH-Group merit praise for their intrepidity.

CUS Gus departed Agalega early last week, reportedly off for the Chagos/Blenheim areas. Should be on now. Call sign to be used from Blenheim should be AC9/A/BR while the Chagos operation will be VQ9/A/C. Gus was operating from Blenheim Saturday.

PALMYRA KP6AL, Jack, now has a tentative opening date of August 1st. This will be a vacation trip with his XYL and family along. To provide for eventualities, Jack is trying to take along two pieces of everything in the line of gear. He will have a portable generator plus the power from the cruiser they will travel on. There is reported to be a power supply left on the island from the old landing strip and he may see if that works. C.W. will be the primary operation and he will listen for the QRP stations. K3RLY will handle the QSLs for this operation plus the Fanning one...VR3I...which will follow the Palmyra activity. VE7HE has shipped a tribander beam for the operation.

DAHOMAY Andre, 5VZWT, will be going to Dahomey on August 19th for a two month stay and will be signing TY7ATF.

CHINA BY1PK showed up at 14209kc at 1600Z last week...promised to come back the following day but did not show. Was on July 15th. QSL information was to Box 1, Peking. Beam direction was right but our JA-Honshu Desk reports that there have been reports that Radio Peking as announcing that no amateur licenses have been issued except for BY1PK and this station operates only on c.w. There have been reports from other sources that there are a number of China amateur stations on the air and easily copyable from adjacent areas. This one is hard to figure....but when in doubt, work them first....worry later.

4M2CI Active last week... showing up in mid-week and operating on the edge of the phone band. Was at 14201kc at 0400Z on July 17th and said he would be active for some 40 days. QSLs to YU2NEG. It is reported that the suffix in the call indicates the island in the Adriatic from which the operation takes place and possibly other calls with the 4M2-prefix but with different suffixes will show up. Good signal to the West Coast last week. Purported to be YU-DXpedition to Adriatic Islands.

YEMEN HB9YC/4W1 coming through last week...not especially strong signal. Was at 21001kc at 2300Z on July 11th.

strong signal to the Western Reaches. No QSL cards available as yet. John, the
operator, somewhat surprised at the response to his activity. Was at 21307kc on
July 13th.. .2200Z coming short path.

GREENLAND TEST OX5AP making a year long 6meter test at 50.15mc....on daily except
for the period August 5th thru 14th. Will make a 5 minute transmission on the
hour and will listen for 6 meter signals for five minutes after each test. OX5AP
available for 14m schedules between 2100 and 1100Z. ARRL asking for reports on
any two-way 6meter communication with OX5AP.

UPPER VOLTA XT2AA at 14193kc...listening 14207kc on July 12th at 0400Z.

JA-DX NET A Japanese Possession Net is meeting on Saturdays 2000-2100Z at 14170kc.
JDLIYAA and JDLAAH on Minami Torishima (Marcus) have been checking in. JDLABH on
Ogasawara (Bonins) has not checked in yet but is a possibility.

MARCUS KA9RC says that they will try the Marcus operation again in late September
or early October.

SHORTLY NOTED 40/80 reports practically non-existent this week. ZE3JJ looking for
80m c.w. contacts on Saturdays...around 0200Z. CR9AK reported at 7004kc/1300Z on
July 12th..said to QSL via VS6-Bureau. The low phone rates of 20¢ for 1st minute
and 15¢ each minute thereafter during the period 11:00p.m. - 8:00a.m. on any day
is encouraging more use of the long-lines for DX information. The word 'demonstrat-
ion' in Martins-OH2BH report from ZA-Tirana causing some concern. Some feeling it
meant dissidents parading up and down in front of the hotel, others feeling it to
mean that the operation was a demonstration of amateur radio communication. Some
paths are showing considerable life....during the last week W4BA worked every
area in the AX-calls except 8 and Ø and probably would have worked those if he had
wished. The 3B-prefix pretty well in use in the Indian Ocean. W2GHK has the logs
for J9XI up thru March and expects the April QSLs will be out in July. VKØKY on
Cocos-Keeling indicates he will leave August 18th. Some recent visitors to the
Funny Farm were VR3DY...KH6GLU holds the call and knows nothing of this one. ZALC
also around. XZ2AC was at 14042kc at 1600Z on July 16th. There was an AP2U on
July 14th...listening above 14200kc at 0030Z. Son of a Gun. Enough to make a
Spartan sob. CE3ZN commutes between the family's copper mine in the Andes and
Santiago for the CE9AT schedules....try 14208kc/0000Z on July 24th. No new word
on the possible Laccivides effort. CEØZK was running a phone patch into CEL-land
at 14169kc on Saturday, July 11th...1900Z. That would be Juan Fernandez but it
is the only activity reported. A Monks Island - 4MØA-- effort rumored for August
...around the 6th thru 9th. Good for WPX but not a new country..counts for YV.
The address for WA6ENF is George Rock, 214 Jackaranda, Vandenburg AFB, Ca. 93437.
FCC sometimes takes action on use of unassigned prefix blocks by U.S. amateurs.
Also issues citations for foreign operations using U.S. 11/Portable without prior
notification to them. NO9LB looking for California patches....21237/0400Z.

KURE Late word is that KM6DT, KM6DU, WB8GMA and KØMTM, all from Midway, would operate from Kure-KH6 over the past week-end and possibly up through Tuesday. Only frequencies given are 14050kc and 14310kc. The group was intending to run a considerable amount of phone-patches for personnel on Kure and would appreciate it if the breakers would hold off until they are finished.....after phone patching the DX is their next interest. Should this one have not come off this last week end, the alternate date for the operation was set for the first or second week in August.
