

# West Coast DX

## Bulletin

August 4, 1970

30-70

GUS Gus operated from Chagos early last week, then moved on and was scheduled to open from Aldabra last Saturday. Forty c.w. has been good to the Western Reaches with some consistency with Gus going there between 13-1400Z and operating around 7001kc. On July 30th Gus was operating /MM enroute to the next location. Tentative plans called for about five days from Aldabra and then a short operation from Geyser and then onto the FR7s.

W6s-7s frequently having some problems due to band conditions. However, this is not confined to the West Coast only as it is reported that the VK/ZLs also are having their problems....Indian Ocean open to the area only for short period from 0500 for about two-three hours.

PALMYRA Jack, KH6CHG, was transmitting enroute last week at 14265kc and said that he expected to arrive at Palmyra around last Friday and be ready to go on Sunday. Frequencies he advised to watch were 14205kc for SSB and 14050kc for C.W. Jack also said he would check into the Pacific DX Net at 14265kc. This was planned for a five-day operation and if all went well, Jack should be on the air right now.

MACAO CR9AK was operated last week by VE7IG...QSLs go to CT1BH. Reg, who operated the station is on an extended tour of the Orient and will operate from other areas. He has a license for VS5-Brunei and also plans to operate from 9N1-Nepal. He will be in India and will attempt to work on a Laccadives license.

UGANDA 5X5MP reported at 14208kc at 1700Z on July 27th. Said he would be there for another two weeks. QSLs go to LA8ML.

FERNANDO de NORONHA PYØAD is on regularly on forty c.w. from this island...was at 7005kc at 0030Z on July 22nd...a few days later on July 25th was at 7009kc at 0130Z. This is ex-PY7AWD/Ø. Also in this area is a rumored effort from the St. Peter and Paul Rocks around August 14-16th but nothing definite on this. The PYØAD also shows up on 20 c.w. and has been reported on twenty SSB.

ALBANIA DL7FT, Frank, firming up his projected ZA operation. Frank saying that he definitely will be operating from ZA-land September 22nd to 25th with possible operations a few days before and after this date. Frequencies will be 14195kc with 14185kc as an alternate; 21245kc with 21235kc as an alternate. His transmitter will be crystal controlled and he will be found within a few kcs of these given frequencies.

Details still coming through on the OH/ZA operation. Martin reported to have talked with the proper Albanian officials and indications were that they would not object to a return effort. Martin may try another run at a ZA-operation within the next couple of months.

The ARRL DXCC Desk was queried on credit for any possible ZA-Operations some months back and it was indicated then that if anyone succeeded in getting into Albania and operated that the operation probably would be accepted.

TRUCIAL OMAN MP4TDI on twenty SSB last week. Was at 14208kc at 0045Z on July 23rd, at the same spot the following day as last as 0245Z. Say he would return the following evening but did not show.

XT2AA showing up with K3RLY a couple of times a week...14220kc at 2230Z...try Mon/Wed/Fri. Clipperton planning continues but nothing definite.
