## Bulletin

CHAGOS VQ9SM, Jacky, active from Chagos. Was heard at 14232kc at 1600Z on Oct 4th and at the same frequency at 1430Z on Oct 7th. This apparently is a crystal controlled operation with the frequencies available being 14232kc and 14130kc. Jacky will be on Chagos for a year. One source says to QSL via the VQ8 Bureau, another says to send the cards to JA0CUV/1 who is having cards printed.

SOUTH ORKNEYS VP8LV showing up frequently...was at 14273kc at 0300Z on October 3rd and at 14240kc from 0025Z on October 5th. Name is Tony and QSLs go to Box 137, Port Stanley, Falkland Islands.

CAMPBELL ISLANDS ZM4OL and ZM4JF should be on this week...if you have not heard them already. ZM4JF operated previously from Campbell in 1965, his handle being Ian P. Johnson. His home call is ZL2AZS and he has also operated ZL5AA from Scott Base in Antarctica; ZL1ABZ from Kermadec and ZL3VB from Chatham.

IRAQ Late reports indicate scant hopes for any possible operation. The recent political activity has cooled prospects for anything this month though those who were interested are still seeking out possibilities. There are hopes that there will be an YI-Iraq effort in the near future but nothing definite at this time. Some sources figure that this will be one of those operations where the gear is brought in and set up and if no one says nix they go ahead and operate. The plans continue but the dates are indefinite.

NEUTRAL ZONE There is an 8Z3A reported active at this time and being found almost daily around 1200Z at 21280kc. Some reports say that this is Ron Maples, W3DWG who operated from Pitcairn Island back in 1967. While some indicate some skepticism, it is pointed out that he is work W3s who apparently know him and some stations in Kuwait say that the Neutral Zone is active.

EAST PAKISTAN AP5CP is still available should AP2KS been missed. This one from Dacca is in most mornings, coming through to the Western Reaches Long-Path around 1400Z...plus or minus. Last week he was at 14022kc at 1520Z with Mohd the operator. AP5HQ in West Pakistan also being heard around this time.

GALAPAGOS During the CQ WW Test, HC8AA will be active on all bands. This will be activated by HC1RF who expects to go to the islands on October 20th...and HC1GS and HC8GS will be in on the activity. HC8GS was at 14215kc at 0300Z on October 4th with a very strong signal.

GLORIOSO FR7ZU/Glorioso on almost daily...on a variety of lists. One is taken often by MP4BHH who is transmitting at 14192kc and listening 14200kc and up. This one usually starts around 0230Z with the list to be run at 0300Z. Jacques, FR7ZU/G, has turned down offers of a QSL manager and says he will handle his own cards. One indication is that some cards may go out on a plane due to visit the island within a few weeks. Some speculation that the cards may show up via the bureaus.

FRESNO INTERNATIONAL DX MEETING The big annual DX meeting will be held at Del Webbs Town House in Fresno on January 30-31st. The Northern California DX Club will be the host club this year and Bob Thompson, K6SSJ, is handling the details. Prepare!!

SHORTLY NOTED    Lots of DX NEWS this week but little of the earth shaking variety. However, among the good news is that LILA is back.....This good one(?) was at 14206 at 0530Z on Oct 2nd. 4Z4HF will be on during the CQ Contest...with rhombics for 40/80m. Listen for him at 3798, 7098, 14225, 21325 and 28575kc. On 40/80 will listen within the U.S. band....QSL to WB2WOU.  
 A YI2AK was heard last July...some worked him, none got a QSL.. Georgia State College is using the KP4GSC prefix this month...and another prefix on the unusual side is HC7DC...usually at 21340kc from 0130Z.....running phone patches. Scotts QSL Service offers their services free to any DXpedition. FR7ZO/T was on from Tromelin last week...14084kc at 1515Z on the 7th. OH2BH stymied on his hopes for a YI effort is also thinking of a return to ZA-Albania in the Spring. FB8WW on Crozet usually comes on frequency at 1230Z....look for him around 14073kc. He usually is there for about two hours. QSL via F5QE. With list a four letter word in some quarters, the quick and easy way to appraise a list is whether you are on it or not. The WCDXB mailed about 50 copies airmail in the states a few issues back...wished to what the delivery would be. Mostly they were delivered on Tuesdays...one day in advance of usual delivery. Possible that the Post Office Department taking a second look at the system which has been in effect since January....hold on.  
 ZK1CD active....some say he is on Niue using ZK2LF's rig...some say he is in Rarotonga. ZL3VE/C reported as a new station on Chatham...was at 14220kc at 0800Z on October 7th. OA3Y is at Huraz in Peru...will be there for six months. Active at 7001-05/14055/14155/21055/21155kc. Last week was operating at 9000 feet and going higher. QSL to SMØFO. QSLs are in the mails for TY7ATF and for TI9CF.... JA3XPO, now QRT, will QSL 100% for all contacts.

At this point about 13,000 QSLs have been sent out and it looks like there are about 13 000 more to go. The financial balance for the effort is not good and the expenses were in excess of \$10,500.00. At this time support has only covered about half of the expenses and some solid support would be appreciated.
