JUAN FERNANDEZ - RECAP K9KNW, now safely home in the bosom of his family, reports that he and W9IGW enjoyed the trip, stopped over in Bogota and San Andres Island on the return but San Felix was never part of their thinking.

The Juan Fernandez effort saw some 4300 QSOs made, they opening up March 17th in the afternoon and shut down Sunday, March 21st, also in the afternoon. 80/40m was somewhat exasperating but they did manage to work 105 stations on 80m and 158 on 40m. With rare exceptions, they report that the behaviour of the anxious ones in the pile-ups was very good. Most were gentlemen and it was enjoyable from the CSE end to have them.

QSLs will be made up soon...photographs from the trip are at the processing laboratory and it is planned to have a picture of the island on the card.

SHORTLY NOLED If you got your copy of this issue via Airmail, do not panic. It was felt that with the Andaman operation coming on short notice, the troops had to be alerted. Certainly would be a shame to have Venkat come on from the Andamans and no one answering his CQs!

FR7E/E QSLs are being received via the INDXA. Some have inquired what the 'E' stands for...Juan de Nova, the 'E' being silent in this instance. If you are a bit confused over that erudite statement, it actually stands for Europa which counts for Juan de Nova...and how did we get started on this line of confusion.

VU2PJ who had hoped for an Andaman license apparently had not received it up to last week. Joshi plans to come to the U.S. in May, and this may put a crimp in any plans. XW8AX has RTed in Laos and is now in Cambodia. Some months back Bill said that he was certain he could operate from XU-land once he arrived there so something may develop in the next month or so. VP2KS likewise thinking of XZ-Burma but this may be a bit in the future. Martin, OH2BH, said to be headed for an EAØ-spot when every thing is ready. INDXA also consulting with Don Riebhoff, HS3DR (TI9J) etc on some Spratly planning. Andorra--C31-land--reported as being activated come June. JYL, King Hussein himself, was on 20 SSB last Monday. Looks like it takes a lot to upset him. TYLABE, usually Extra Class CW, will move up if requested...will even do it if you write him for a sked. QSLs for VR5DK, due from the Tongas any moment, go to WA6JWW. The W6 QSL Bureau report some 50K WB6s QSL cards on hand...less motherhood...more saze envelopes. VS9MM is a new one from the Maldives..goes to G3LQP. VP2SF goes to the INDXA for QSLs. TIØBK showed again last week after an absence. WB6WIM has a 40m beam (402B) for sale..looking for inquiries. The FCC has issued a Notice of Inquiry to manufactures concerning TV interference--Interesting Ask for Report No. 9775, "Broadcast Action", issued March 25, 1971.

MELLISH REEF K2IXP, Larry, extended his operation on VK9MP-Norfolk until April 12th. Up through April 4th some 7500 QSOs had been made by this operation. Larry has obtained the license to operate from Mellish, according to late reports, and there has been tentative approval of the operation for DXCC Credit. Finance and transportation seems to be the problem at this time, a good vessel being required for the trip. At this time the operation is scheduled for mid-May...if all goes right. Mellish Reef is in the Coral Sea, southwest of Willis. You might scan you maps in the vicinity of 155.5 east longitude and 17.2 south latitude, and if your map is great for small details, you may find it. Definitely something developing...as Lord Baden Powell, the Hero of Mafeking would often say: "Be Prepared!!".

BRASILIA CONTEST - 1971 LABRE has announced the 1971 edition of the Brasilia Contest, to take place from 1500Z on April 24th to 1500Z on April 25th...24 hours. This will commemorate the 11th Anniversary of Brasilia, the capital city of Brazil. Logs have to be submitted to LABRE, Bx 07-0911, Brasilia DF, Brazil by May 31st. There is an extensive trophy list...full details can be obtained by writing LABRE. The object of the contest is to work a lot of stations...PYS count more and PY2AAA counts most of all. All contacts are good for points whether PY or not.

SCRATCHED Late word in the middle of last week indicated that the 5HLLV-Zanzibar operation had been scratched as the problems facing the operation could not be solved. And on Gus, in spite of the reports that Gus was here, there and everywhere, it does seem that the lack of travel authorization across India to the ACs has kept Gus from getting started at all. With the monsoon usually reaching Northern India by late May, the passage of time would work increasingly against possible activity..without things being a bit damp...
