CAMBODIA For those who might be a bit apprehensive, the following is the FCC release on the Cambodian affair:

October 5, 1971

INTERNATIONAL AMATEUR RADIOCOMMUNICATION

The Commission has received notice from the Cambodian licensing authorities that pending government approval and eventual International Telecommunications Union notification, there would be no objection to communications between amateur Station XU1AA, Phnompenh, Cambodia, and U.S. licensed amateur stations.

The Commission has no objection to U.S. amateurs communication with Station XU1AA.

FCC

From the SouthEast Asia Desk comes word that XU1AA is located in a public building and operations most likely will be in the 0000Z to 1300Z segment. The present operators may not be ready to tackle any large scale pile-ups at this time and most likely will stick on 40 meters though some 20 meter operation might be possible. The station was reported at 21014kc at 1600Z on October 10th and it might be possible they are spreading out a bit. Most likely there will be no previous announcements of operating times or frequencies.

JALKSO will be there from October 27th and plans to operate in the CQ WW Test and Nobs says he will operate 40/20/15m SSB. VE7IR was expected to return to Phnompenh in mid-October and may be active at this time. HS3DR is planning to operate from November 2nd to November 5th.

Additional equipment is being supplied or procured from a number of sources and this includes exciters, linears and at least one good tri-band beam.

CEUTA There should be some activity from EA9-Ceuta starting around November 10th and running for four or five days. W5LZW has also been reported as planning some EA9 activity in November for a couple of days. These may...or may not...be the same operation. Most likely they are.

CANTON Those working Canton often run into a situation where they can have their choice of callsigns with it being KB6DB one time and VR1AB another time, depending on what you might wish. Art is the operator and this is your chance to work British Phoenix and Canton Island in a double-header. WB6IKI/KB6 is also VR1AC and both should be there for some time.

VR1AB had to return to the states last week, his father having passed away, and Art should return to the islands sometime late this week.

KAMARAN It is getting rather definite that Aldo, ET3ZU, is going to Kamaran towards the end of the year. QSLs for the last ET3ZU/A effort in the Red Sea are going into the mails this week, this coming from IØIJ.

DARLENE Darlene has been coming through from Norway, being on most days last week at 14170kc/1800Z. Her present plans call for some operations from Lichtenstein around the first week in November and Monaco late in November. Her Lichtenstein license is said to be the first ever issued to a YL or XYL.
