CAMBODIA The JA-DX Group were in Cambodia for the CQ Test this last week-end but at the time this weeks bulletin was closed off it was a bit early to gauge the success of the activity. In addition to JAKSO, JALCK was also reported as being in on the action plus possibly some locals.

Some **concerned was** being expressed on the talk of several DXpeditions to Cambodia to put XU on the air. Those in on the early action and the success of VE7IR/XU in getting activity started again have cautioned that the present situation there is delicate and a large number of visitors might cause the whole effort to tilt. It is frequently forgotten that there is a war going on in Cambodia and often there are hostilities right on the fringes of Phnom Penh. Within recent weeks the Prime Minister dissolved the Cambodian Parliament and is present ruling by fiat.

VE7IR returned to Cambodia on October 23rd and took a couple thousand XU1AA QSL cards with him. Presently there has been no decision on the handling of the QSLs though the JA-DX Group probably will handle their own cards.

XU1AA is located in a University Building and it does seem rather definite that the operating hours will be mainly 0100-1430Z or thereabouts. The station is also close to rooms occupied by one of the University officials and all-night action might not be encouraged.

As of last Friday, it has not been possible to determine if any W/K has worked the XU1AA station. Several have reported as hearing the station, no one has said they worked it. Perhaps last week-end changed matters a bit.

WEST AFRICA K4AEB will be heading for Africa this week and present plans call for some activity from 5T5=Mauretania this coming week-end, opening up on the seventh. There is also a possibility of his traveling on to FL8-land, FL8HM was discussing the possibility of some activity. Also in on the talking was 4W1 who was discussing a 4W1 license. Nothing definite though. Also, there seems to be no sign of DJ6QTs action in West Africa.

THE GAMBIA ZD3D is being found around 21405kc...plus or minus a few...on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1730Z. This may be a schedule so listen a bit before jumping in and giving him the full treatment.

DARLENE Darlene showed up in the Canary Islands a week ago, operating from EA8GZ. She arrived there on October 23rd and planned to stay to the end of the month. On Oct 30th she was to go to Stockholm and then on to Germany. On November 13th she will leave for Liechtenstein where she will sign HBØXIC...probably until November 27th. She says to watch 2855000-28600kc; 21355-21360kc; 14195-14200kc and 14295kc. On November 20-21st she will be at 4U1ITU and at this time the Monaco plans are not solid.

QSLs Without predicting any more definite dates, let it be said that some people have received their 300 QSLs. Some great number have not as of Friday. Patience...they are surfacing. Also, some European stations have the ET3ZU/A QSLs...if you cannot be patience, try a prayer.

SHORTLY NOTED

The 9I-Prefix being used by the stations in Zambia ended October 29th. Watch for a new prefix next October. CT1BH reported as scheduling CR9AK at 21235kc at 1230Z on Wednesdays. Courteous breakers often acknowledged and the action shifted to 21250kc or higher. FL8HM has been checking into the YL-SSB System at 14332kc...usually on or about 1930Z. CO2FA handling his own QSLs and apparently XE1AE no longer involved. Fernando away behind in filling out cards but says he will QSL 100% eventually. His problem is not being able to stay away from DX Contests. Sax of the mint stamp service says he is dropping the Czechoslovakia stamps...the OK-Government raising prices to the point where it would be 70¢ surface and \$1.35 for air. VP2LAM/FMØIX/8P6DM QSLs from W7VROs recent effort are being received. QSL route needed for YA2AG. Some XVs and 3W8s showing up in reports but Viet Nam still off limits. Some there on the scene are working on the problem. K4YCD was at the Georgia State Fair...QSLs via W4DQD. W6AM reports the full-KW mobile will be test flown on the Los Angeles Freeways in November....Don looking forward to some good c.w. freeway/mobile contacts. Late word was that JALKSO & Co. expected to stay active in Cambodia until November 6th.

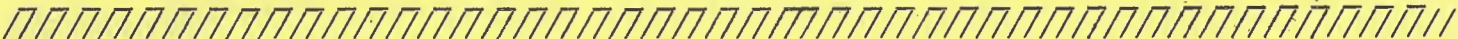
