CAMBODIA Reports on W/Ks working XU1AA still relatively scarce, the action of fifteen meter c.w. on November 11th being the last one uncovered. Some more action is possible this week with VE7IR/XU etc supposed to be meeting his QSL manager in Singapore and then onto Phnom Pehh to operate XU1AA for four or five days commencing November 21st. The action is mainly expected on fifteen and twenty meters. On the activity around November 11th, this being by YBØABA, the report is that the QSLs do go direct to him. As mentioned previously, mail is opened for possible inspection coming and going into Cambodia. The inclusion of currency is said to introduce the possibility of some problems. VE7IR/YBØAAH is still planning to visit XZ-Burma in January. W5MVP is the QSL manager for YBØAAH and should there be any success in Burma, W5MVP will also handle those QSLs.

BRITISH PHOENIX VR1AC is often found around 21385kc from 2330Z working into the states, Monday/Wednesday/Friday being the main days of action but other days possible. QSLs for this station go to K3RLY. VRLAB may be departing the islands right after the first of the year and will make especial efforts to work into the East Coast on fifteen meters in the 1100-1300 GMT slot.....working around 21350-21375kc. This station also is often found on the Pacific DX Net...14265/0600Z. Often found week-ends on the 15m c.w. frequency. VR1AA is another active station, being reported a week ago at 21028kc from 2000Z. These last two also go to K3RLY for QSL purposes.

GABON TR8DG, Guy, usually around 21300kc Mon/Wed/Fri from 1930Z looking for Utah and Washington, D.C. Needs Utah for WAS. This is usually a sked with W8KGR and Guy will usually acknowledge courteous breakers. QSLs via Bx 2272 in Libreville.

MAURITIUS 3B8DA, Alex, also looking for some help with WAS. Alex is looking for Maine, Vermont, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, Washington, Wyoming, North and South Dakota. He needs these to complete his new WAS under the new call sign. Possible that Idaho might no longer be needed as K7RLS has been in there with Alex. 3B8DA says he hangs out around 14040kc from 0300-0400Z and from 1200-1400Z. QSLs go to 39 Brown Sequard Ave, Vacoas, Mauritius.

QSLs Son of a Gun, something is always bound to happen if you wait long enough. The 3C1 and 3CØ QSLs started to come to the surface last week, some of the Southern California volunteers madly licking stamps to get the QSLs into the mails. Those who received them were speechless with awe over the beauty of the QSL card. Those who did not get theirs in the first-go-round immediately started to scream. There were over 4000 QSLs to clear and it was not easy.....those 4000 were W/Ks QSLs. Patience helped.... On the HKØAA QSLs have been received by K3RLY and should be in the mails shortly... ..some might be received by the time you get this bulletin.

DARLENE Late reports on Darlene indicate that she is headed for TF-Iceland and will be at TF3YL for a week and then another week at a W5/TF QTH. The present schedule calls for two weeks in Iceland and then she will go on to New York City.

SHORTLY NOTED KM6DX QSLs to L R Collins, Bx 100 NAVSTA San Fran 96614. On the other hand, KW6GM QSLs sort of hard to come by...the story is that the station does not QSL...much. On 5VZDB, if W4SPX was not able to come through....not having the logs is the main trouble, you might try TT8AC direct. 5VZDB and TT8AC being the same cat. VA2UN from McGill University will be on until December 31st....possibly longer. QSL only via W2GHK. VB1MSA is also a special call good to the end of December.

On that upcoming VP2DAE effort, QSLs will go to K3RLY...there being a change on this chore. BY5XX on forty early this month said to QSL to F2DCY. Anyone with help on this one...F2DCY not listed in CB. QSLs for KJ6BZ should go direct with s.a.s.e and not through bureau. Station rules there are 100% QSLs. CBA for 9H1AF is apparently not right...try 9H1E or 9H1-Bureau. Some of the ET3ZU QSLs sent to I1IJ apparently did not produce. Best route would be via Bx 379, Asmara, Ethiopia.

LAØAD is being transferred to Argentine. Bob had just completed his 5BWAS when he got the orders. WA6MWG had logs for HC5NW from 1967 only. YA2AG QSLs sent to A.R. Baron, KABUL (ID), Dept of State, Washington, D.C. 20521 do produce results. Put nothing but address on outside of envelope. Bx 279 in Kabul should also be good. VP2AA (ex-ZD8J) is planning to run a KW on 160m.

The replacement for ZM7AG...who departs the Tokelaus in a few weeks...is Derek McKay who has been a teacher there on Fakaofu Island for some years. Derek became interested in the possibilities of amateur radio about the time Jim Sheedy did. The licensing problem recently noted does not stem from any lack of ability by Derek, the problem is to locate a qualified examiner. The technician on the last mail boat was not qualified to give the c.w. test. Something should develop eventually to get Derek qualified and licensed for more ZM7 activity.

The DX STAMP Service changes hands January 1st...will go to W2AZX. JT1AH QSLs are coming through but JT1AG is hard one...3HNK unable to help on this one. Some of the ZK2AJ action in early October was a pirate...ZK2AJ and ZK2AU being questionable. HL9KH (K6VOQ) will QSY to 40/80 when band opens to West Coast.

ZA2RPS A recent note from DL7FT indicates that there are still a log of people who have not QSLed for ZA2RPS. A recent check indicated that but 55% of those working the 1971 effort have QSLed up to early November. Frank indicates that the log shows c.w. contacts for many W6s still are outstanding along with a number of SSB contacts. Some from 1970 also were not QSLed and are still on the books. Not only are the W6s slow but also the other call areas. If conditions were bad during the action and there is doubt as to whether you are in the log, you can drop a note to DL7FT who has time now to go back and make checks. Also available is the ZA2RPS-Color Slides and a commentary tape. The color slides cover both the 1971 effort with some of the 1970 action and are available from DL7FT for club or group showing. Presently resting from the last efforts, Frank still has not forgotten that there are still some rather rare spots left and is still do some planning work.
