KAMARAN Reports continue that Aldo is packed and ready to travel but the political situation in Yemen seems to have deteriorated in recent weeks. Newspapers last week carried a Reuters report that North Yemen had occupied Kamaran that the border situation between the two nations was tense.

North Yemen was accusing South Yemen of mass troops on the border and fighting which flared last month had subsided. A mediation team from the Arab League was trying to quiet things. Check the location of Kamaran in the Red Sea, 150 miles north of South Yemen....the island decided to go with South Yemen when the British withdrew in 1967.

Mt. ATHOS SY1MA opened last Friday but from the Western Reaches the early signals were not exactly strong....in fact SY1MA could not be heard. WWV was forecasting U-5 and many were sticking close hoping that conditions would improve as the week-end progressed

KURE KH6HGP is working up plans for an October 22nd departure to Kure to operate through the CQ-DX Test. A number of operators are included, and among them are K5CIT, KH6HLK and KH6HOY. Operations are planned for some days before and after the CQ Test. QSLs will go to KH6BZF and the group is looking for a HY-GAIN 18AVE/WB to install for continued operations by KH6EDY. SOUTH SHETLANDS/SOUTH SANDWICH LU1ZC, Albert Hernandez, has indicated that there will be another operation from Deception Island in the South Shetlands during the latter half of October and in November. Frequencies to be used will be 14195kc....listening 14200kc and up to 14210kc.

Additional operations from South Sandwich look good by LU1ZC or other Argentine field surveys sometime during this winter. LU1ZC will make further information available as soon as matters start to jell. QSLs for LU1ZC go to K4MZY.

SOUTH YEMEN 4W1BC showed last week....21295kc/1650z. The station is running 100 watts to a dipole and the signals were not especially strong....but some said the station may offer a better possibility than 4W1AF. Handle is Geoff, has a British accent, and QSLs go to G4ATQ...G R Hawkins, 13 Sandfield Cres. Saul. Gloucester.

CONGO REPUBLIC TN8BK, Bernard, back on the air after his vacation. Was at 28597/2000z on October 8th. QSLs to JA4DLY.

CAMBODIA Reports are that John Van Lear, 9M2IR, will operate from Cambodia during the CQ WW Test. Some say it will be at XU1AA....some say it will be under XU1IR call-sign. XV5AC also planning big operation and testing the new antennas last week. Was at 28565kc and also on 40mtrs with Don Riebhoff apparently the operator.

CARIBBEAN The information on the GERRANA/Baja Nuevo/Navassa etc change in sovereignty seems to check out okay. Look for some more possible deletions.....alas!!!!

FB8s The FB8s can often be found around 14120kc at 1100z where FB8WW is on most days and FB8XX and other FB8s are in QSO. The schedule calls for a c.w. session one day and SSB the next, following this alternation. Often conversations are in French and FB8XX also meets VE6AYU at this frequency.

KURE QSLs KH6EDY now has obtained logs for KH6EDY for the period December 71 through August 1972. Lee is cutting into the stack of QSLs awaiting a KH6EDY confirmation and expects to have them cleaned up by the end of October. Lee says one of the main problems is matching the times as some are coming through with local standard time rather than Greenwich time. A good number of these are being kicked back.

GRAND CAYMAN ZF1EP will be on for the CQ WW Test from the Grand Caymans, this station being operated by Dr. Louis E Persons from Ft. Myers. Actually he will be operating in the October 27-30th period and in the DX Test will be trying for a single-band award working on ten meters exclusively. His frequency will be around 28600kc as close as he can operate and will be looking for multitude of contacts. QSL go to Dr. Louis Persons, Bx 1647, Ft. Myers, Florida 33902.

CQ DX COMMITTEE The report has popped up a number of times that K4IIF and the entire CQ DX Awards Advisory Committee have resigned.....there is absolutely nothing to this rumor. K4IIF advised direct to the WCDXB that this story is without foundation and the CQ DX Award Advisory Committee has just celebrated its 5th Anniversary is more active than ever.

SILENT KEY HC1FG, Carlos Cordovez in Quito, passed away on September 20th. He was an active DXer for many years and remembered by many Old Timer DXers

ZK2AF-ex Those looking for the present address of Wally Christie who operated ZK2AF on Niue up to the first part of last year can be reached by writing to him at 328 Mt. Albert Rd, Auckland 3, New Zealand. According to word passed along by WA0ETC, two have held this call, the previous one being in the early 60s when W0BN handled the QSLs. However, for this one try to catch Wally at his New Zealand QTH.

NEW ENGLAND DX DINNER This dinner held earlier this month in Waltham had better than fifty there for the banquet and heard W1YRC on the XV5AC operations, Bob showing slides to illustrate his talk. Also a guest speaker was Joe Goggin, K9KNW, who showed slides of the Gerrana Bank and San Felix operations. K9KNW said that one of the worst irritations of these operations were the jammers and those deliberately interfering. Inasmuch as those present included some who had missed CQ-San Felix because of the jamming and interference, there was an unanimity of opinion on this practice.....

MEXICAN ROAD RACE The National Off-road Racing Association will be sponsoring the MEXICAN 1000 Race at the end of this month and K6QPE will be operating as XE2QPE.. during the dash from Mexicali on the border to La Paz at the tip of Baja California. Nick will also have SSTV equipment with him and will operate 14230kc for the SSTV group. He will also be found at 21295kc. Anyone working XE2QPE can QSL to K6QPE with the s.a.s.e. or s.a.e and IRC. The race will extend from October 30th thru November 3rd and Nick expects to be active daily.

SOMALIA Recurrent reports are that one of the SMØs who operated at 3X1P also have a valid license for 601-somalia and may turn up from there late in October. Nothing definite. The 3X1P operation was supposed to secure early last week though there was some hope that the equipment would be left for possible future use.

CARIBBEAN There has been some verification that the U.S. has agreed to recognize Colombian sovereignty over Gerrana, Roncador and Quitasueno reefs. Hondouras has been recognized for Navassa. All of this was supposed to be effective on the first of September and does raise some questions as to the future of these for DXCC. A quick check indicated that these may not be 500 miles from the mainland which could result in some more eliminations from DXCC.

Undoubtedly there will be more on this before long but after noting the way Minerva was wiped off the list, early action may come on these.

But Minerva may not be off the list forever. Linn's Stamp News of September 25th went into the matter quite extensively, noting that Tonga's claim may not be as strong under international law as the Minervan claim and noted that Tonga has some strong internal problems including a weak economy which possibly cannot stand many such excursions such as the Minervan Expeditionary Force. There are indications that the Minervans may be proceeding with their plans for development of the reefs in spite of the Tongan claim and, son of a gun, Minerva may be a counter for DXCC once again.

Anyhow, hold onto those Don Miller specials. Minerva, unlike Maria Theresa, may rise triumphant from the depths.

SPRATLY The scoop on the spratly hopes is that the vessel for the effort has been moored at Boonwong Boatyard at Pataya Beach in Thailand waiting for the end of the monsoon season. The pointers are still for the first part of December. As Lord Baden-Powell, the Hero of Mafeking, would often say: "Be prepared".

BRUNEI VS5RL is presently active and will be around for about the next six months.

The home call here is WB5HJZ. The signal coming out of Brunei should be a bit stronger shortly as they are putting up a TH6DXX beam.

The handle there is Rick Lawrence and apparently he wants no donations as he does not request s.a.s.e or s.a.e with IRC. One report is that the local post office there does not understand what an IRC might be. QSLs go to P.O. Box 337, Kuala Belait, Brunei.

On that IRC bit, technically an IRC is good at any post office anywhere in the whole wide world. In actual practice they are infrequently seen and thus the difficulty in getting a post office to accept them stems more from unfamiliarity than anything else. When a country shows with no IRCs shown as required for postage, and this is true of the U.S. International Postal Manuals, all it indicates is that the country has not established the number of IRCs needed for airmail service.

CORSICA F5RV is presently active from Corsica signing FC5RV and will be active until the first week in November. The handle there is Rudi.

His home QTH is in Cannes, France and his usual operating area is in the 21290kc to 21300kc.

FC6ABP who also holds the F04WH call has been active from Corsica, mostly 21mc SSB and was being reported in the 21300-21305kc country from 1700z.

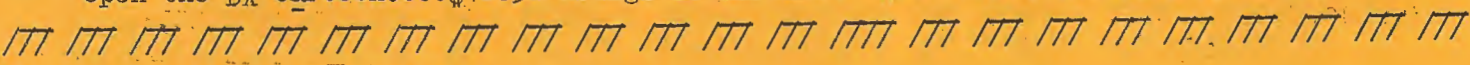

FCC The FCC is kicking out a lot of decisions these days, including the Eyebank matter and after noting that W1AWs operations by paid personnel is illegal, the FCC issues a waiver and proposes some new rules for this type of operation. The FCC is also inviting comments on the new requirements on logging of 3rd party messages handled. Briefly, part 97 has been amended to prohibit amateur operators from transmitting messages for business and commercial third parties (Docket 19345-Eyebank). Third party traffic is amateur radio-communication by or under the control of an operator at one station to another amateur radio station on behalf of any one other than the control operator. The commission said that traffic, the sole purpose of which was to facilitate business and commercial traffic was not in keeping with the intended purpose of amateur radio and licenses would not be issued to schools, companies, corporations, associations or other organizations. The FCC also said that part 97.114b prohibits compensation for the operators of W1AW but did propose a rule change which would permit this compensation and did allow W1AW to continue until this is decided.
