November 24, 1972 CLIPPERTON There have been a number of persistent rumors on a possible FO8C-Clipperton operation, some of these developing during October and continuing to pop up right up to last week.

The most persistent is that some VES would open from Clipperton this last week-end and operate through the week. VE8RA was mentioned as one of those who would be in on the action.

Karl apparently was in Paris last week and this would seen to spike that story. He was very interested in Clipperton last spring after his return from FW8-Wallis and VJ8-New Hebrides but by late summer he indicated that the whole matter was off. Landing permission still seems to be the main problem. There has been reports indicating that the French have personnel on Clipperton and do not want any outsiders on the island. The speculation ranges from atomic tests, which would hardly seem possible on such a small island and particularly with the French conducting such tests several thousand miles further south, to possible tracking operations of satellites or rocket launches.

Clipperton will come some day....and all the rumors will turn out to be solid. It might even be this week but the indicators would not tend to support the hope....

St. PETER AND PAUL ETC PY2WH will on his solo effort to St. Peter and Paul right after the first of the month. Departure will be in the first few days after the turn of the month..some say December 1st and a late report says December 3rd.

Les plans about three days of operation on St. Peter and Paul and then on to Fernando de Noronha to sign ZWØWH for four or five days, running to about December 8th or 11th depending on the start of the whole operation.

The question of operating from Rocas Atoll apparently has not been determined, some of the problem being the determination of whether this might count for DXCC. The atoll is less than 200 miles offshore from Brazil. Should Les go there he will sign PSØWH. Frequencies to be used are:

QSL'S Son of a Gun!! TI9C QSLs started to surface last week or so...these being sent out by TI2GI whose address is Box 2811, San Jose, Costa Rica. OJØSUF QSLs also have started to come through, one of the local QRPers who needed one to stay at the 319 mark showed up waving one. And UK1ZFI QSLs are also being reported as surfacing, these may be ones not sent through bureaus but rather direct. Most things come to he who waits.....most times. Even a few A51PM QSLs have been received.

HAITI HH9DL, Don Lungwitz, will be ending his long stay on Haiti and will no longer be on the air after December 1st. Last week Don was in Dutton, Virginia, and his absence will possibly make Haiti a somewhat tougher one in the coming years. Don confirms that HH2JT is okay and this station has been active in recent months. HH2JT has been in the states on vacation but should be returning to Port au Prince sometime after Christmas.

PITCAIRN ISLAND Tom Christian, VR6TC, returned to pitcairn island early in November after a long stay in New Zealand for hospitalization. Tom was evacuated to New Zealand last July. Tom and another passenger in a longboat were crushed against rocks in Bounty Bay when the boat capsized in heavy weather. Both men had to be evacuated for treatment of their injuries.

The return should put Pitcairn back on the air with VR6TC expected to resume his usual Tuesday/Wednesday schedules on 15 and 20 mtrs. It also means that commercial communications will be restored with his return, the interim operator there being unable to repair the equipment when it went out last month.

WEST AFRICA The OH-Group with OH2BC, OH3BCP, OH2BH, OH2MM returned to Finland on November 8th after making over 14 000 QSOs from four countries. The call signs used on this trip included ZD3X, ZD3Y, ZD3Z, OH2BH/6W8, OH2MM/6W8, 5T5BH and TZ2MM. All of these QSL to OH2NB

Ville, OH2MM, will return to Gambia this week to operate in the CQ WW DX Test and will sign ZD3Z. Ville plans an all-band operation starting with 1833kc and going to 3503kc, 7003kc, 14030kc, 21030kc and 28030kc. While primarily aiming for c.w. action in the contest, ville will also operate SSB before and possibly after the contest as conditions permit.

The OH-Group is looking for some help and especially from those QSLing as the total cost for their recent operations is over \$4000.00. These helpful items along with QSLs go to OH2NB....a single-stop, full service arrangement!!

TYØABD was being operated by DJ6QT early last week and by Saturday Walter had moved on to Togo where he was signing 5V8WS. These two along with TZ2ACQSL to DJ6QT CBA... The planned 5Z4LW/5Z4KV Juan de Nova effort is looking like December 8th. This one is well along and more definite word should be out shortly.

SIKKIM A station signing AC3JA was worked on the West coast on November 13th...this one being at 14043kc/0240Z. Said to QSL to JA3GZN. No further word has been heard on the JA-A51TY plans and this one, if good, could possibly be an off-shoot. Said to QSL to JA3GZN

SHORTLY NOTED This week we again ran out of space....out of paper also when an expected shipment did not arrive. If any of the stock looks unusual, it was procured locally down in the village.

Deception Island is in the South Shetlands and ER7AI is on Europa. We suspect that sometimes we are having some programming problems as we start out right but it ends up wrong on the stencil. THE MELLISH FILE There has been no further word released by the ARRL on the Mellish Reef-VK9JW operations and the cards are till in limbo. The WCDXB did get access to some correspondence which might throw some light on the matter, the correspondence originating with some of the principals involved in the Mellish Reef trip.

The assumption that the credit for DXCC was suspended because of allegations made over log entries appears to be essentially a correct premise. There was apparently considerable rancor and bitterness among the operators on the trip, the signs pointing to the group splitting into pairs and ending the trip hardly on speaking terms.

One of the principals did write to the ARRL reviewing at length the whole matter but specifically making the following statement which is a direct quote:

"On another occasion Roy and I commented about the list of call signs John had who had paid or were going to pay some money. I heard a lot of these fellows called, but heard no replies from them. I know what happened to the log. As I did not want to become involved I went outside and did some fishing".

A review of the letter indicates that this might be the statement that caused the ARRL to suspend accepting the VK9JW QSLs for DXCC credit. A reading of the above paragraph might indicate some inferences but actually no outright accusation.

It would at this time appear that eventually the ARRL will make a decision on this one.

ARRL...SATELLITE DX AWARD A new certificate will be available December 15th from the ARRL, this one being for operating through OSCAR 6....and will be called SATELLITE ACHIEVEMENT AWARD. This will be awarded on a point total and will require 1000 points to attain.

A QSO through the satellite counts for 10 points, each new country worked counts 50 points and each new continent counts 250 points. Contacts must take place after December 15, 1972 and only one contact per station, regardless of mode.

This award will only count for communication through OSCAR 6. Beyond this award, the ARRL is seeking to find a suitable method of recognizing and encouraging space communications generally.

MORE ARRL.... As long as we are on the subject, the following are some of the petitions ARRL reports as having been filed recently for rule changes.

RM 2074 Puget Sound Council of Amateur Radio Clubs. Asking to waive the second application fee when the amateur attempts within one year to pass an examination element previously failed.

RM 2076 W2WLR. To authorize simultaneous voice and facsimile long-time sequence per frame transmission of a.m SSB and FM voice.

RM 2080 K1CCL, K1IGD, W1NXY and WA1PXT. To adopt a system of call sign prefixes primarily to indicate class of license.

ALDABRA VQ9HCS has been showing on fifteen and twenty, often with a.m.c. in there to try to help speed the effort.

Lenny, W2OVC, often meets VQ9HCS at 21295kc/1630Zalso appearing at 21370kc at 1730Z. Both of these frequencies get action so check one or the other....and possibly a bit in between.

Harry, VQ9HCS, is using a KW200B with a ground plane. He does not expect any sort of mail service until mid-december so QSLs will not be surfacing for several weeks.

QSL address is Harry Stickley, BX 84831, Mombassa, Kenya. Present indicators are that he will be there on Aldabra doing some scientific work until next spring.

THE RAIN/SNOW/GLOOM BIT When should you get your WEST COAST DX BULLETIN? Many may say "yesterday"....but with some reporting getting the bulletin later and later, let's run through the game plan.

The bulletin is almost always mailed on Saturdays in late afternoon or early evening. The only exceptions are when we are out of town for the week. For practical purposes you can say it is mailed on Saturdays.

(The postal service has "National Service Standards". These are the level of service which are intended to be met. When the bulletin is mailed Saturdays, look for it--

AIRMAIL

Should be delivered anywhere in the contiguous 48 states by the second day or by Monday.

FIRST CLASS

Should be delivered anywhere in the contiguous 48 states by the third day or Tuesday.

These are based on mail being deposited by a certain time and we usually meet these times. Check the postmark, a minus (-) in front of the 'PM' might indicate it was mailed late but generally these shouldn't be noted....

If you are not getting it.....complain to your local postmaster...or write your congressman. All we are doing is listing the postal service policy.....
