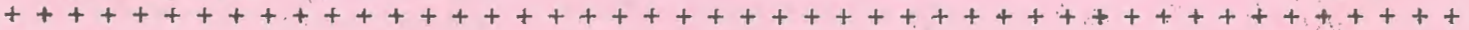

SAN FELIX The group for the San Felix--CEØ effort were reported as on their way to the take-off spot in Chile last week and if all goes well should open up this week-end for four or five days of operation.

Late word is that K5QHS will not make the trip but W9IGW and K9KNW are on their way and it is possible that both W9IGW/CEØ and K9KNW/CEØ will be signed from the island in the Pacific off Chile.

The announced frequencies will be:

SSB 28595kc 21295kc 14195kc 7095kc 3795kc
C.W. 25kc up from the bottom of the band.

There will be 160 mtr operation if the group is able to erect a proper antenna and get it working. Target day for the operation is this Saturday, April 8th and QSLs will go to K3RLY.

CAMBODIA XU1AA was being operated by Tony last week at 14220kc from 1430Z..or possibly earlier...and was working well past 6 and 7 land to the east. This was on March 30th and XU1AA was coming through for some hours. This did switch to a list operation with a list being taken up frequency. On Saturday he was at 14224kc from 1630Z.

On the QSLs, Tony asked that they still be sent to P.O. Box 484 in Phnom Penh but that the W/Ks not include IRCs but rather to send a self-addressed envelope with 11¢ U.S. Airmail postage on the envelope. They are apparently still on the vertical.

SHORT NOTES That list of calls that DL7FT waits to hear from and which we ran in last weeks bulletin was for the last ZA-operation. We thought we had all of it down in our usual lucid fashion but realized it when we cooled off and sat down to read the bulletin to find out what was going on. It being that we failed to identify it was ZAs. The GC2ZIP should be GC3ZIP....that was our high-speed typing and in the QSL addresses that YZ2ZL should be YA2ZL. This is a matter of getting the correction before you note the error as this is on the next page. In case you are curious, we do not cut the stencils in sequence.

Some of the FT-DX 400 equipment often put out a spurious signal due to misadjustment of trap coils. SPECTRONICS has put out a bulletin on some of the FT-DX 560/570 gear to eliminate a second harmonic of the 3180KHz IF. This sometimes affects 28mc when the rig is driven hard...YAESU working hard in tracing down these problems and coming up with some quick cures for mysterious signals heard on the bands. Some gear have turned up with signals 250 to 500Khz from the desired frequency, often on the opposite side-band but in the c.w. mode as well. It does pay to check well on each side if you have any doubts.

K4MZU is mailing out the QSLs for LU1ZC operation on South Shetlands in January. LU1ZC, Alberto Hernandez, was the operator and the QSL is a landscape photo of Deception Island.

W2FXA is current with the QSLs for 9H3C and promises 24 hour service on any incoming ones. EA9EJ will be departing in a few weeks for a four month tour on a fishing boat. It seems that the APO address for KP4DJI is incorrect...that's O9831....the Post Office returns it saying there is no such APO. And while speaking of the Post Office, a recent Postal Bulletin advised that you get 15¢ in stamps even though your letter may only be going to Mexico or Canada where 8¢ is the 1st class rate.

VK9XX on Christmas Island was on last Friday....14217kc at 1500Z. The advice was passed that the Radio Club on the island meets on Mondays and the club station is usually active during the meeting. Listen from 1500Z...or maybe a bit earlier. W8GKR is trying to get some activity out of TNSBK for the French Community Net but says that Bernard is hard pressed for operating time with his medical duties at the clinic there in Brazzaville. TR8DG lost his rig and needs a pair of 6HF5 tubes to put him back in business. The 6th Annual California QSO Party last year brought entries from the Azores, Japan, Brazil and Mexico. Always someone looking for the elusive 6s. Not VS6DR...he is looking for the elusive North Dakotans. He needs one for WAS. Anyone sighting an abominable dakotan, snap a photo quick. Phil will not believe they exist.

Our social reporter says that Darleen is planning a marriage soon and will live in Ecuador where she hopes to acquire a 'HC' call. The new 3D2-prefix in the Fijis causes some questions but its for real...

This cat is consistent with rare calls....consistently on c.w.... consistent on a beam head of around 300° from the states...consisten in being evasive when questioned but is always in there. Work them first and worry later. SV1CH on 14022kc/0000Z March 23rd is on Lesbos in the Dodecanese Islands...as is SV0NU who is on Rhodes. UW3EH often at the low end of twenty running interference and a list for UG6JJ who is not especially strong. Watch from 0130Z onwards...twenty SSB. Anyone with QSL information on YB/AE, 3A/0FN and VR4EZ...W8COG needs the word. WB6UDC needs information on the W0KON/? that was on in the contest. C21AA was at 21287kc at 2000Z Saturday working by districts.

W7GOC will bring YA2ZL up around 14235kc mornings when he can...sometime after 1500Z. 9M2WM still looking for the elusive 6s and the California Award.

VP8ME has been absent the last couple of weeks. Seems that the supply ship showed up in the harbor and everyone is busy unloading and stacking the supplies. It is Fall there in the South Orkneys with winter just around the corner. Last Saturday around 0400Z there was UF50B at 14018kc, UF50C at 14022kc and UF50A at 14025kc.
