CHINA There was a rumor a week or so ago that BV2AA might operate from BY-China in April. This was mentioned as a possible 10 day operation. While it has not been possible to nail this down, it also should be pointed out that there will be a trade exhibition in Canton from April 15th to 23rd

Some DX sources have speculated that there might be amateur activity during the exhibition with one report saying to watch for a possible BY2KAN or BY2CAN. While this is possibly mostly hope, it may be well to watch for some possible action when the bands are open to the western Pacific. Something will undoubtedly surface one of these days, if not this one, something else.

There was a BY1AS working c.w. into JA-land last week in March. This one worked only a few JAs, saying to QSL to the JARL. Few taking this one for real.

FRANZ JOSEF UR2AR was advising over the air last week that he will be in on a trip to Franz Josef Land, opening up about May 1st or 2nd and operating until May 14th. The announced frequencies..so far...are:

3530kc 14190kc 21290kc 29240kc 7080kc 14005kc

The call to be used is UK1ZFI. Enn is looking for a big score in the May USSR C.W. Test...May 13/14th...and will not be looking for W/Ks at that time as he will be trying to run up his score.

Both SSB and C.W. will be used in the period May 1-12th and the last two days will be c.w. only in the contest. UR2AR and UR2DW will be making the trip to Franz Josef Land. Enn, UR2AR, was at 14212kc/0400Z on April 4th discussing the plans.

RHODES SVØWJ plans to operate from Rhodes this coming week-end, April 14-16th, operating 10 thru 40 meters. Frequencies mentioned are 14220kc/14280kc and 23550kc.

QSLs will go to WA1HAA. SVØWJ has mentioned a possible future Crete effort but nothing definite as to dates.

SVØWU continues to show up from Rhodes, being permanent party there. On April 1st Ike was at 21321kc at 1900Z. Last Saturday was again on 15mtrs in the same vicinity.

CRETE SVØWEE still aiming to open from Crete on April 28th and operate to May 1st.

Late word is that it will be a split frequency operation, 10 through 40 mtrs but with no 80mtr action planned. Hopes for a tri-band beam that K6VA and the So.Cal DX Club was contributing did not jell as transportation problems made it questionable that it would arrive in time for the trip. The effort will use a 14AVQ and a 4BTU antenna. Gear will include a YAESU transceiver and a SWAN 350 transceiver along with a spare back up rig. SVØWEE will probably be returning to the states in mid-June.

When asked about the possibility of a Mt Athos operation...this being a mountainous religious monastery and a possible new country counter, the advice was that there was scant possibility at this time for any non-Greek citizens getting up there.

JORDAN 7Z3AB, Henry, will be visiting in Jordan next month and will be signing JY9HF from the Palace. Henry plans to operate many hours a day, using King Huessein's gear and if he maintains his usual 7Z3AB schedule, look for him around 14250kc from 1430Z on the long path.

SHORTLY NOTED The CE0-San Felix DXpedition passed through Panama a week ago and last Saturday was maritime mobile enroute to the island. By the time you get this bulletin they should be well into the pile-ups.

That FP0BS...reportedly a proven bootlegger...apparently picks a strong forty meter signal and nominates that person as his QSL manager. A good method for saving on QSLs but irritating to those looking for a FP0 QSL. WB2AQC, George, and his XYL, WA2BAV, Eva, have their itinerary well nailed down and will be off for West Africa on April 18th...stopping on their trip at Mauritania, Senegal, Gambia, Sierra Leone, Liberia, Ivory Coast, Togo, Niger, Dahomey, Cameroon and Jackson Heights.

VEGRA, Karl, returning from Wallis and New Caledonia, was due to pass through the San Francisco Bay Area last week after his successful efforts. XU1AA was at 21310kc from 1800Z last Saturday working many stations including the East Coasters who have been having their problems getting past 6-land. K4ZCP along with 9M2WM makes list for BV2AB on Saturdays...14224kc at 1130Z. However, Bob has not shown up the last two Saturdays and there was a report that he was off the air. BV2AA continuing to come through...last week was at 14240kc at 0400Z. VK0KA on McQuarie Island continues to show up regularly at the low end of twenty SSB...from 1200Z.

A translation of the report in Spanish from the LU-Desk confirms that there is little possibility of a South Sandwich operation by any LUs in the foreseeable future. It is felt that the last bushel of rumors may have stemmed from an Argentine official doing some jawbone calisthenics. That W0KON in the last contest was in KG6-country. There will be some special prefixes used with the launch of APOLLO 16, due this coming week-end. The calls that will be heard until splash-down will be WC3SFC at the Goddard Space Center and WP6JPL at JPL Headquarters in So. Calif. W4OPM the WPX Kingpin has been under the weather recently. 6D4J says the first 6D4 QSLs were in the mails March 30th...or thereabouts. K6GLC will visit KC6RS the latter part of April...will possibly sign KC6JM daily at 14240kc/0600Z. A01TY was visiting in India last week.

Both Senator Mansfield and Scott, respectively the Majority and Minority Leaders in the U.S.Senate announced recently that they would be going to China. With all the smoke, someplace there may be some fire. Listen....work everything...and worry later. There will be plenty of time for that.

PANDORA'S NET The Pandora's Net has asked that their overall intent be clarified and the operation of the net explained.

"Net Rule #1: TO PUT DX IN CONTACT WITH DX From the very beginning we were sure that it would be impractical to include Mainland USA stations in the net...on several occasions when we did try it..results were disappointing and enforced our original contention.

"Propagations conditions between Pacific and European/Asian Stations far different than from the mainland; sheer volume of mainland check-ins would make the net unworkable; many DX stations need contacts in the Pacific Area

"..maximum of ten KH6-prefix check-ins...last to contact the rare DX station. First choice given to other DX Stations, then Europe and Asia.

"DX stations pleased with net operation....would resist any changes allowing U.S. mainland check-ins...

"As soon as willing and able Mainland station can be found, a Mainland Section will be established...20khz above the regular net. Any DX Stations that are in need of the U.S. and can be copied...will be asked to QSY to the Mainland Section after making contacts as needed on regular net....

"..No malicious intent to bar anyone from the net, but there must be sensible rules in order to operate, and we feel that excluding Mainland check-ins from the regular meeting is both sensible and necessary if the net is to continue...we would welcome comments from interested amateurs....

IARU Robert Denniston, WØDX, is assured of election to the presidency of the IARU on the basis on a majority reached on the mail vote returned to the end of March. This election came after the ARRL Board of Directors in January voted to request that the presidencies of the ARRL and the IARU be separated due to the increasing burden of work on both offices. This will be in the June IARU Calendar, the election of WØDX.

JAPAN DESK Some of the major newspapers in Japan were running articles on TVI/BCI recently with some unfortunate results....the JA-PTT shutting down many JA stations. Some well known JA calls are presently QRT with scant hope of getting back on the air in the immediate future.

The recent news articles about a series of homicides by an extremeist group in Japan ...which was well covered in the stateside papers....also will have some effect on JA activities. It is reported that the group were use 2 mtr transceivers and did include some amateur licensees among their group. There has been some talk of pushing to reduce the power allowed JA amateurs.

On the TVI front, one source estimates that up to 75% of the JA-amateurs have problems with TVI, a good many of them getting into arguments with their neighbors over the problem. The stations running full KW power often found the after midnight period the time to operate....all night TV programs now has put a crimp on that.
