

# Red Eyed Louie's West Coast DX Bulletin

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April 17, 1973 16-73

Mt. ATHOS The end of last week found two different groups looking at Mt. Athos...one headed by HB9KB and the other by DL7FT. One group appeared to have their plans rather well jelled, the other was facing some financial problems.

One group is headed by HB9KB and includes J0AHL and SV1DB and SV1GA. These are firm to participate in the operation and there may be additional operators which may include amateurs from OE/OZ/DL-lands.

The present plans for this group call for it to rendezvous in Salonika on April 20th and after organization work has been done, to proceed to Mt. Athos. Their present itinerary calls for them to arrive there on or before April 21st and they hope to open the operation on April 22nd and to run through April 25th.

Their license to operate provides for a four-day operation during the life of the license which is good for less than a month. They can operate ten through forty and there are no plans for eighty meters, apparently they cannot get permission to operate on that band.

The group will operate both CW and SSB. The only frequency mentioned is the well known 14195kc with listening above 14200 c as announced. On other frequencies you can tune around and listen.... More information may develop on this one during the week but this should get you listening right for a starter.

DL7FT plus some other operators are also planning for a Mt. Athos operation, they also are aiming for the end of April, possibly in the same period as the HB9KB group. Last week support was not coming in as fast as hoped for though W6TSQ had received a number of contributions. The decision on this operation probably will be made during this week with the operation being shaped to what can be accomplished with the resources on hand.

This group will also go both CW and SSB in the usual frequencies. CW will be either 5 or 45kc above the bottom of the band. SSB will be split frequency with the listening frequencies as announced.

Frank was still hoping for support during the week-end and if this does develop, it is possible that there will be two groups there.....

SPANISH SAHARA A six day operation from EA9=Spanish Sahara was due to open up on Monday, April 16th and run to April 21st. The group from the Canaries will be signing EA8URE/EA9 and will operate ten through eighty....split and transceive.

The group will include EA8CI, EA8BX, EA8FF and EA8GK. QSLs will be handled by EA8GK, Box 860, Las Palmas, Canary Islands. The announced frequencies are:

3805kc 7095kc 7200kc 14150kc 14300kc 21250kc 28550kc

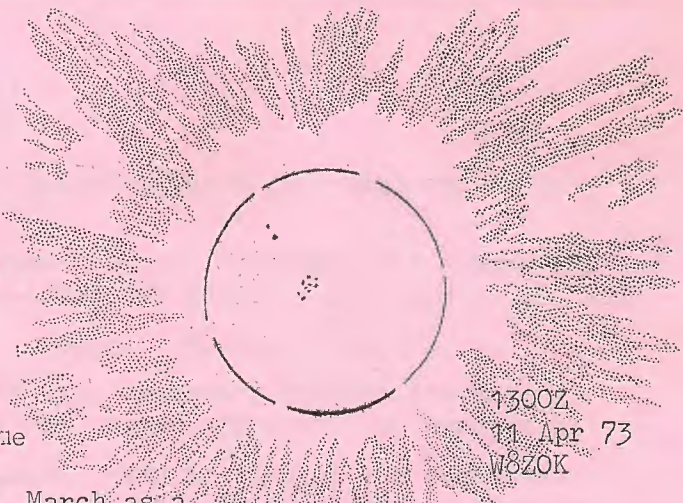
Some of these frequencies do not look just right for Region I but this is the way they were given and on more than one instance. At the minimum, they should get you inside the ballpark.

The group has a beam for 10/15/20 and will string dipoles for forty and eighty.

### SUNSPOT LOUIE...

Two groups of sunspots were visible when this observation was made towards the end of last week, the group on the right being eight individual spots ranging from 8000 to 10000 miles in diameter. These cover an area of approximately 50 000 miles square or an area of 2 billion, 500 million miles square. That's 2 500 000 000 square miles! During the last week WWV has been giving some reports of disturbed conditions.

This group first appeared around the end of March as a group of two spots. Since then the activity has increased and additional spots have appeared. The large group should have held up until last weekend and the band conditions have reflected the sunspot activity. Much deep-Russian stuff has been available since the first part of April on over-the-pole paths. While conditions have at times been bad...there have also been times when they were very good. W8ZOK who scans the spots for the WCDXB will be conducting the DX Forum at the Dayton Hamvention this week-end

TONGAREVA Plans for the mid-Pacific effort by W6GQU, K6GUY, KH6HIF, 5W1AU and KS6DY are firming up and they plan to open from this island on June 30th and operate for a week.

The group are solving problems as they develop, having had some logistics and agricultural matters to handle. ZK1CD, Barry, has been helping the group with the preparations.

The group has queried Bob White at the DXCC Desk on possible new country status for Tongareva but the word was that it would count only for Manihiki. However, they are still developing new information and are sending that on to the ARRL in an effort to have them reconsider.

W6GQU and K6GUY made the VR3AA-Fanning Island effort last year and combined DX with medical research. This time they will continue the same pattern and will make some medical studies on tuberculosis there in Tongareva. W6GQU will take portable X-ray equipment with him as well as the supplies to administer skin tests.

Gear will include YAESU FT101s with outboard VFOs, Deltaloop antennas plus a TH3 Jr. beam. The group has one ZEUS generator and are looking for the loan of a 300watt Honda on the trip and they will return it when they are back home again. The size of the crew has been pared back a bit to allow for more fuel to be taken. W6GQU will be in Papeete this coming week-end and will be operating FOØES. He will be there for a week and will be making inquiries on possible other efforts in the Pacific. Later this year the group is planning to travel again to Fanning and on to Palmyra.

While not mentioned in the information, it appears that the group will travel by air to Tongareva, provisions having been made for a shipment of aviation gasoline to Tongareva late this month for use by the DXpedition. More information will be available in the coming months.

CLIPPERTON While there has been nothing especially notable enough to start planning your working hours so that you will not miss an FO8C-Clipperton operation, there is still a lot of attention being given to that spot in the Pacific....

To bring you up on some of the recent notes.....there does seem to be a French unit more or less permanently on the island but the report is that these may be removed and any activity on the island ended later this year when the French end their nuclear tests in the South Pacific. Until this happens, no one is going to get on Clipperton to operate an amateur station.

One who was recently checking with his contacts in Paris says that all applications for Clipperton have been cancelled with the exception of one. This application is not by a Frenchman.....and there is some guarded optimism here.

One of the "Big" DXpeditioneers has made inquiries at a French consulate for a license for Clipperton. This was forwarded to Paris through channels....but it does show the interest is there.

Apparently any permission to land on Clipperton may have to come via Tahiti as that Polynesia capital has jurisdiction....and possibly a guaranteed letter from a Master of a vessel to safely return his passenger will have to be included. Anyhow, as K6HTM says: "All things come to him who waits"..and so will Clipperton.....eventually.
