SPRATLY The delayed expedition to Spratly has lined up some solid transportation and should be on the way this Thursday, February 1st. Planning calls for about one days travel and they hope to open up on Friday, February 2nd for a three to five day operation.

The call sign to be used will be 1S1A. QSLs will go to W1YRC. The transportation to be used is a 64' boat which should be adequate for the trip. They will have the two Collins stations, two beams and a couple of 35' towers. They will also have a crew of capable operators to rack up a high total of QSOs. Those in on the trip are Phil Wight, VS6DR, Don Riebhof, HS3DR, John Lunsford, XV5AC and Scott Gant, also of XV5AC.

The transmitting frequencies to be used will be:

3805kc 7070kc 14195kc 21250kc 28550kc

Listening frequencies will be announced. There will be c.w. operations and while these frequencies for c.w. are not available, checking the low end of the c.w. bands should prove that the pile-ups will mark the action.

While some have already started to worry about band openings, it might be pointed out that twenty often is open from the states to the Orient after 0900Z. West Coast stations report these openings often and on the lower frequency VS6DO is reported on 75 and 160 mtrs around 1400Z regularly. Check the frequencies and do not assume that they are out...

PALMYRA An extended Palmyra operation is shaping up, this one may extending over a month's period. This should develop within the next sixty days as soon as the work arrangements for some items can be made.

There is an opening on this trip for an amateur who can handle the cooking and kitchen chores. Any DXing Gourmet who might be interested might pass their name along and we will pass it on in turn... The KP6-Palmyra operation is not far off and more solid details should be available shortly...even possibly the name of the cook.

UPPER VOLTA W1AM departed the states for West Africa last week and should be opening from XT2AAs QTH this week. Art expects to be there in XT2-land until February 10th. There should be a bit of twenty and fifteen activity and attempts will be made to activate the station on 40 and 80mtrs, both SSB and CW and the action will follow the demand.

K1JYN will be in daily contact with Art and by the start of this week will have most of the operating details worked out. Should anyone wish a schedule or want some late information, get in touch with K1JYN. QSLs will go to W1AM with sase or sae/IRC/ There is a possibility that Art will get his own license after arrival in Volta but up to the time of departure he had not received notification though he had sent in a bundle of assorted documents.

7Z3AB A large number of amateurs showed at K6GLC's a week or so back to meet 7Z3AB and his XYL...they being somewhat surprised at the number coming to visit them, and delightfully so. VR1W and VR3AC came all the way across town and some drove down from the Fresno area and up from San Diego...more than 75 DXers dropped in. As some said: "If Henry wasn't there in Saudi Arabia, 7Z3s would be awfully rare".

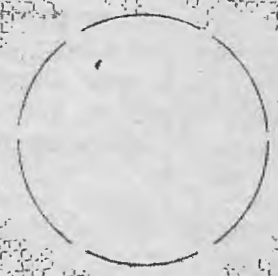

You may not notice it yet...and we hope that you will...but the Postmaster General last week got on the horn and told the Regional Postmaster Generals to "...meet the established service standards...right now".....

So the Assistant Postmaster Generals got all the District Managers on the horn and told them to "...meet the established service standards or else...". And all the rest of the week all of the faithful were leaping aboard their steeds and galloping in all directions...

These standards call for the delivery of airmail anywhere in the U.S. lower 48 by the second day after mailing...the delivery of 1st class mail by the third day. SINT MAARTEN Two stations will be active from February 9th to the 14th with PJ7ARI and PJ7VD. PJ7ARI will be heard mostly on phone and PJ7VD on c.w. This will be an all-band operation with a possible 160mtr effort with a rig supplied by PJ7VL. The 160mtr frequency most likely will be 1826.5kc and 1808kc. QSLs will go via PJ2VD at Box 879, Curacao.

80 METERS Several hard to get stations have been coming through regularly in recent weeks with VU2KV being in most mornings last week. Venkat has been showing up around 3690kc from 1430Z and hanging in there for about an hour. Mostly c.w. but some SSB. Some West Coast stations have gotten through including the perennial leaders such as K6AHV, W6ISQ and W6TSQ. ZK2BD has been showing up frequently around 3786kc from 0730Z...OK3WW around 3502kc from 0600Z; CT1JV around 3514kc from 0500Z. UA0FCM has been often around 3617kc with a SSB signal from 0900Z and has asked that his presence there be publicized. He says that the SSB frequency there is from 3600kc to 3650kc. KA2AA is looking for 80mtr contacts and will be on or about 3537kc transmitting and listening 3775kc to 3810kc most days from 1500Z. Will make schedules for 40 or 80... EA6BG has kept schedules on 80mtrs...was at 3750kc and listening above 3800kc a week or so ago. A possibility for a schedule.

ARRL BOARD MEETING A few items from the recent ARRL Board meeting which may interest DXers include Item 8...the establishment of an Emergency Communications Advisory Committee...Item 20...adopted a statement of position of concern on progressively restrictive actions of the FCC....Item 27 instructed the International Affairs Committee to start preparation work for the basic plan of action for use in the next world administrative conference for the high frequencies....Item 29 asked the IARU to establish a 5-Band WAC Award...amended to provide for a 6-Band WAC...Item 33 found the Board back off from a motion to strengthen the office of ARRL President and referring it to a committee for study....Item 35 directs QST to publish the name and call signs and circumstances on suspension or revocation of amateur licenses...Item 38 was action taken to oppose increase in FCC license fees...in Item 51 adopted a list of "President Goals". They voted down a motion to issue pins for 200 and 300 countries worked...voted in favor of constructing an addition to the headquarters building...authorized a pin for 40 years of membership. Full minutes will be in the March QST.

PREFIXES CI1ADV was the special prefix being signed last week to commemorate the entry of Prince Edward Island into the Canadian confederation. This prefix will be used all year. In Iran the 9C9 prefix was being used to commemorate an anniversary and this will be found on twenty SSB.

In Kenya 5Y4 will be signed for the balance of this year while in Italy there is IV5VEC being signed in Viareggio. This one will QSL to K4WQS.

The West Palm Beach Radio Club will be at the South Florida State Fair this week and will be signing WC4SFF...in fact they will go through the week-end and up to February 4th. This one QSLs to W4HAW.

Mt. ATHOS Etc The ARRL DXCC Desk will start accepting SY1MA QSLs for credit starting March 1st. If you send the card in before that date, it will not be accepted. This operation is being QSLed by WA1HAA. He has been working through the logs and putting the cards into the mails during January. Many reporting receiving the card. KS4-Swan Island has been deleted from the DXCC list effective with the end of August. If you made a contact up through August 31, 1972, you can submit it for credit [deleted]. If you worked Swan after September 1st...or even on September 1st.. it will count for Honduras. Swan Island credits for the Honor Roll will be deleted as of February 1, 1973.
