NEW COUNTRY! After many years of consideration, it seems that the DXCC Desk will soon advise that East and West Germany will be counted as separate countries. This has been urged for a good many years. Maybe we should not say that it is 'new', only that the political considerations and the criteria have been changed. Anyhow, it will be a good counter.

SHORTLY NOTED With the bands not especially scintillating last week, we thought that we were set for space. Some last minute information ran us short and we had to cut out the 40/80 reports. We will try harder next week.

There do appear possibilities that the DX Advisory Committee may come up with some proposals and these may include activity endorsements for the DXCC Certificate such as a.m., NBFM, RTTY, b.o.n.g.o etc. There is also a possibility of some recommendations on revision of the DXCC Country list and a change in the criteria. Also, some thought is being to a plaque to the one who works everything available. Problems of QSL managers, reluctance of some DX Stations to QSL and making things attractive to the younger group is also being considered. Also, what should be the composition of the ARRL DX Tests....shorter? Longer? Different?

ARRL Al Michel, W8WC, ARRL Director from the Great Lakes Division, passed away on September 8th after a long illness. Richard Egbert, W8ETU, takes over as Director for the balance of the term of office.

NEWSWEEK magazine in their September 10th issue has an article on the CB mess. And you can get highlights of FCC actions by dialing a recorded service. The number is (202) 632-0002. The recorded announcements are up-dated at 11:00a.m. and 3:00p.m. press release times daily. The reports are bare and concise and will give the outline of actions. However, it is noted that it may be best to get the full release before taking any actions which may have repercussions if you did not get the whole message.

ARRL reports that the volume of protests on the giving of a portion of the 220mc band to the CBers is good and will have considerable impact. However, they are urging that the effort not be relaxed and are urging everyone to write.

While in this area it might be noted that there is a big struggle going on over the request of the AT&T for a big assignment of frequencies for the development of a radio-telephone system by AT&T. 115 megacycles of spectrum is involved and initially the FCC leaned towards assigning 75 megacycles to AT&T. This raised a considerable commotion, even the White House getting into the action, they recommending that AT&T only be assigned 14 megacycles and other 1 megacycle be reserved for later assignment.
