FARQUHAR The Farquhar group will depart the Seychelles at first light on October 17th, heading SW on a + run to the Farquhar Group. The running time is estimated to be three days which should put them on the island October 20th.

The plans are for an around the clock operation from October 21st to 28th. There will be four stations in action, concentrating mostly on 15/20mtrs but with some possibility for 10/40mtrs.

The stations making the trip are VQ9B, VQ9BP, VQ9M and VQ9R. Apparently no special calls will be used, each operator will sign his own call/Farquhar. Both CW and SSB will be used and the operation will take them across the CQ WW Test on Oct 27/28th. When all the excitement is over, the group will return to Mahe in the Seychelles. How the QSLing will be handled is not clear at this point but more will develop on this. Possibly all the stations will go to one Post Office Box there in Mahe.

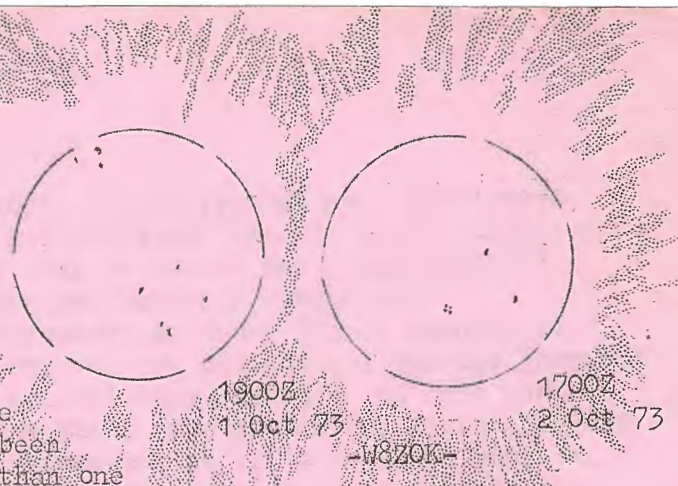
JUAN FERNANDEZ No late word on this planned effort of K5QHS and it would seem that San is still on for a departure next week.....opening around October 20/21st if all goes well.

The political situation in Chile seems to be quieting down to some degree. Last week the October 1st issue of TIME Magazine noted that a detention center had been set up in the Juan Fernandez Islands. A week back San was quite sure that the trip was possible and was determined to go. Next week things should be a mite more clearer.

CLIPPERTON Some mention has been made in the DARC DX-MB bulletin of some scientific studies planned for the area with mention being made of DJ5RT visiting the island to make some medical/meteorological studies. This would be sponsored by the University of Freiburg. Don't start looking yet....but some day, some time, some place on the bands you will hear Clipperton. After you have worked it, what will you have to live for?

ANTARCTIC There are a couple down there that some never cease to search for....and South Sandwich is one. Anyhow, LU4ZS is an Argentine station on the Antarctic Continent and now in the South Sandwich group as some have speculated...hopefully. A note from LU5HI notes that at the present there are no Argentine military bases in the South Sandwich group, the possibility of any operation there is very remote. At this time there is an Argentine DX Club in formation and it is possible that if there was a groundswell of interest shown to the group that they might start thinking of South Sandwich. LU7AAC would be the route for any mail intended for this new group. This call is not listed in CBs a year old and the address is: Eduardo Godfrid, Lavalle 1882, 2 do Piso, Buenos Aires. Any individual or group giving thought to a South Sandwich plunge might also write to LU7AAC for possible assistance. LU1ZA who was at 7095/0545Z last week reported that he was on the South Orkneys. It may be redundant to mention it but the 'Z' following the numeral in an Argentine callsign is an indicator of an Antarctic station. If you already knew that, skip that line.

SUNSPOT LOUIE There has been considerable sunspot activity in the last week, the group of sunspots on last weeks chart disappearing on the first of the month. A new spot showed on September 26th, another showing on the 28th. Then a third spot and a small group showed on October 2nd, the single spot above it by that time had practically disappeared.



With the appearance of these sunspots and the accompanying disturbances there have been some fairly good openings. The sunspots have not been stable enough for some time to last for more than one pass, this indicating that the spots themselves are from short endurance eruptions. In the chart the small spots are about 6000 miles in diameter and the larger ones about 12000 miles. As of Saturday, WWV was reporting the forecast as Fair to Good, Unsettled and a U-6 forecast. A number of requests showed up last week for the Comet Kohoutek information supplied by W5LTY at NASA. There are still some on hand which will be sent if a case with 16¢ on it is sent. Most interesting.

9M8SDA Hugh Johnson, 9M8SDA, was operated on at a Manila hospital this last weekend for an intestinal obstruction. Initially hospitalized for what was thought to be an attack of malaria, then it was suspected it was hepatitis and finally they figured it to be something else. ANGUILLA W3HNK will be heading south for the CQ WW Test and will operate from Anguilla the latter part of this month. He should be on the air around October 22nd and will operate on 10/15/20mtrs through the contact. He will have a beam for these bands and a kilowatt to help things along. He will possibly give 40/80mtrs a going-over and 3775kc or thereabouts will be the 75mtr territory.

SHORTLY NOTED K4DAO, Vince, presently in Darwin, has been issued the call VK8AB. He will be there for some months before heading for the Indian Ocean. Those who may wish to contact K3RLY can still go via the post office box in Simpsonville. This was Box 125, Simpsonville, Maryland 21150. It is understood that Bud still picks up and answers the mail there though he has changed his QTH. Even possible that maybe one of these days he will be back in the action again.

K6BX was complaining to the Executive Board that QST has rejected some of his advertising. The NorthEast DX Meeting at Hyannis, Mass was well attended with W1BB holding forth on 160mtr possibilities and W1YRC showing the 1S1A story. Out in Chicago area the W9DXCC meeting had 184 register. Father Moran, 9N1MM was there, and a number of out-of-towners including a VU2 showed up.

5N2ESH showed up from Nigeria last week, QSLs to Box 3034, Lagos. VQ9HCS is reported to be on Astove Island in the Cosmoledo Group with his gear and should be heard on the air soon. HC8SB on 15mtrs recently QSLs to the Guayaquil Radio Club, Box 5757 there. Initially we thought SY5MA might be Slim Again...but W4KA is the QSL manager and says that Bill active on c.w. low in the 7mc band. Has Drake gear and will be on SSB. PY0AO on from Trinidade until October 10th QSLs to PY1MB. The AFRIKANER Net at 21355/1700Z has been showing with 9X5/9U5/VQ9/3V8/9J2 etc. KJ6DI often on 75mtrs around 0800Z QSLs to K4RHU.

The OCEANS magazine recently had good information on the Indian Ocean islands, the article was about the Seychelles but with comments on Aldabra, Des Roches, Glorioso and others. Only four French Meteorologists on Glorioso....most of whom apparently never learned what a QSL is.
