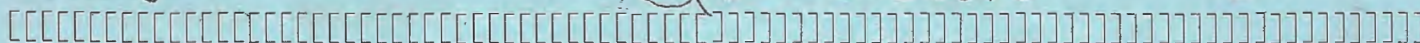

MELLILA After the bulletin was mailed last week, the word came that the FA9AA operation would be delayed one day until Tuesday. Then after the turn of the week the word was that the plans were off until January 7th. Apparently FA9AA was leaving Mellila to go to Spain where his sister was ill.

Mellila is still on but still a couple of weeks off. All you need is patience.

MELLISH There have been some reports that the DX Advisory Committee has made a recommendation on the VK9JW matter and maybe sometime in the future you will find out what it might be.

There did appear to be some inclination to regard the matter as a 'moral' issue. The problem with this word is that it can be applied in a number of ways. One accepted definition is...".relating to the principles of right and wrong in behavior".

Another definition is ..".probable though not proved".

It might be noted that this VK9JW operation took place in 1972 and it will soon be 1974. Watch for the decision and if you have any thoughts, make them known. Of course if you approve, it might be helpful to also give your views. Rather than telling it as it is, try telling it where it counts.

MADEIRA CT2AZ, J.L. Ritzen, will travel from the Azores down to the Madeira Islands to operate CT3AS from January 1st to January 15th. Up to this date his efforts to obtain his own CT3-call have not been successful and the plans at this time are to sign the CT3AS. However, this will change should the license come through. Hal will have Drake gear with an outboard VFO and will work everything from ten through 80 meters.

CT2AZ often found on the Africana Net and active most days.

SINT MARTIN W2JKN, Harold Robins, will be on the island there in the Caribbean from January 23rd all ready to sign PJ9HR and F0AYO/FS7. G3BID will also be in on the action.

Gear will include a FT101 and they will try 160 meters at the opportune moments.

The frequencies to watch are 21340kc/14340kc and 3800kc.

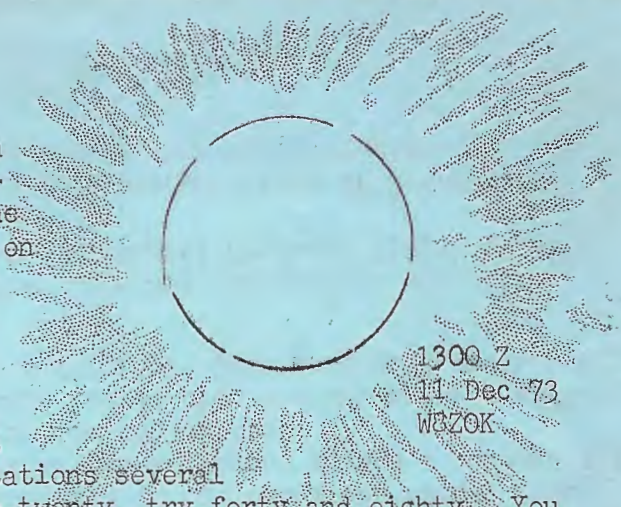
SY5MA This station has advised the QSL Manager, W4KA, that he has shut down operations because of the unstable conditions in the country there. All the QSOs up to the time of the shutdown will be answered as W4KA is loaded with the blank QSL cards. Leo advises that he has no logs prior to October 25th and if anyone worked a 'SY5MA' prior to that date it most likely was SLIM warming up for the CQ Test.

Bill, SY5MA, is returning to the states and this leaves even the QSL Manager without a valid QSO with the station. How's that for suffering? QSLs need save or they will go via the bureaus.

KHANCA This call was due to open up at OOOZ last Saturday and operate over the weekend to commemorate the 70th Anniversary of the Wrights Brothers flight at Kitty Hawk. QSLs go to K4CIA.

DES ROCHES Some of the VQ9 group which operated from Farquhar back in October are starting to talk about a possible July 1974 operation from VQ9-Desroches.

SUNSPOT LOUIE Up to the time of the observation made on December 11th, there had been no significant sunspot activity during the period from the start of the month. The last spots disappeared on December 1st and nothing has shown since. Band conditions have been sporadic and most openings have been brief. Night time DX on the higher frequencies has been a sometimes thing and the action has been on the lower bands. However on these the signals have been rather surprising at times. 75mtr traffic nets are being QRMed by stations several thousand miles away. If you cannot find them on twenty, try forty and eighty. You may be surprised.

The sunspot cycle still has some time to run but the Kitt Peak National Observatory in Arizona reports that the first spots in the new cycle have been detected. The evidence was found last August when it was noted that a sunspot had appeared that had magnetic properties opposite to those in the cycle now winding down. These new cycle also are usually found further removed from the axis of rotation. The present solar cycle is expected to end sometime in 1975. It can be expected that when the new cycle starts that the activity will increase rather rapidly, much faster than the present decline. Maximum activity should be around 1980. So hold on....DX will rise again.

Comet Kohoutek should increase in magnitude during the rest of December and should be at maximum brilliance around December 28th. Until that date look for it in the morning sky before sunrise, after December 28th look for it in the sunset skies. How bright it will be is still a matter of speculation, some say it may not be as bright as was previously forecast, others saying it may be almost as bright as the moon. Take a look and judge for yourself.

We are not sure of the effective date but it probably will be soon. Those VK9s went independent a few weeks back.

POSTAGE As of this week-end there still was no definite word on whether postage rates will go up on January 5th. We are still holding our breath on increasing the rates for the bulletin and should we go right down to the wire and then find out that the postage rates are not going up, there will be an adjustment on any subscriptions paid at the new rates.

The Postal Service is hell-bent on avoiding any problems in this years Christmas mails. Any area where the mails are not current gets immediate high level attention and the teletype down at the office clatters out the situation all across the country and identifying those areas where even the slightest problem may exist. There's no longer any refuge in anonymity.

There also seems to be some changes developing outside the Post Office on whether the Postal Service, or any governmental agency, should ever be a profit making organization. Service...yes. Efficiency...yes. Profits...well, in an inflationary cycle and with costs going up, the constant increase in postage may in the end be contrary to the idea of supplying a service.

One thing for sure, the Postal Service is not in the same condition it was a year ago. It has come a long ways back but there is little relaxation.

IRAQ A French firm has signed a 133 million dollar contract to build the first steel making complex at Khor Al-Zubair. France has an agreement with Iraq to supply technical assistance in return for oil at a low price. These may not affect DXing directly but often a rare one has been opened up by DXers following the work in business deals.

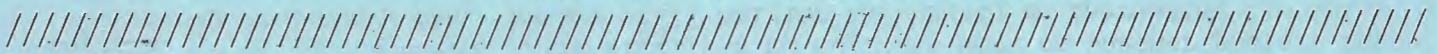
W1AW will not transmit code practice or bulletins on ten or fifteen meters during late hours after January 1st due to lack of long-distance propagation.
