FRED LAUN Fred Laun, LU5HFI, was flown from Cordoba in Argentina to the Canal Zone last week and presently is being treated at the Gorgas Hospital there for the wounds received in the terrorist kidnapping early in April. As of the week-end Fred was still in the intensive care ward but the prognosis for his recovery was good. Word from KZ5PW was that there was a possibility that some arrangements might be made so that he could be on the air as soon as his condition has improved sufficiently that the doctors would allow the activity. Fred is expected to be in the Gorgas Hospital for two weeks, possibly longer. It is expected that sometime in May he will be transferred to the states for further medical treatment, possibly to the Washington, D.C. area. The news during the week has been good, much to the relief of many concerned DXers.

PALMYRA/KINGMAN Plans continue for a possible Palmyra and Kingman Reef this summer, one group anticipating that the call KP6MD will be issued to them before long. Transportation is the key to any activity but this is expected to be solved without any difficulty.

One group looking at KP6-activity is the Southern California group which went to Tongareva for ZK1TA last summer. They have been working on plans for several months and believe they have the handle to the whole problem. As Lord Baden-Powell, the Hero of Mafeking would often say: "Be Prepared". Something certainly should be developing within the next sixty days.

Mt. ATHOS The announcement for another Mt. Athos effort has been expected for some weeks and may be out before the end of April. This will be a full-bore effort by some top DXers and should be sufficiently long to dry some of the demand for this one.

Patience....it is coming and probably before the end of May.....

SCRATCHED The VP8-South Georgia/Orkneys etc signing LU1ZC has evaporated and you will have to wait for the next opportunity. Problems developed and the schedule just never was possible.

On that possible TE9 during the WPX, this was another 'no-show' and this one seems to have been equipment problem. It is reported that they developed trouble almost immediately with the generator and managed only a few hours of operation before the power smoked out.

Nothing was ever heard on the VK/Lord Howe and it is time to stop looking.

CHINA Last weekend the W1/China operation was scheduled but the FCC has been putting out caution signals.

Several newspapers carried items on the FCC announcement that it would be illegal for W/K amateurs to work any amateurs inside the Peoples Republic of China. Possibly if you saw the press item you may have wondered if it was another QRP story. The newspaper accounts said that the W/Ks could not work the Chinese stations because the China government does not permit such operations by Chinese. Then they said that both China and the U.S. are signatories to the 1965 International Telecommunications Commission agreement.

If you check the banned lists in QST, it does not seem you will find BY listed as an illegal one to work. By now you may have the story of what the possibilities were on this last weekend but you may still be puzzled as to the reason why..

This will run through the weekend, from April 26th to 28th and K6JYO and WB6KAP will be ramroding the effort. They ask that those trying to work the big dish to stay away from WA6LETs frequency and that they will be looking for calls well off their frequency.

To work via the moon, it is figured that 1kw and an antenna with 18-20db gain will be sufficient. At moonrise and moonset even less may work the trick.
