DESROCHES Because of work commitments, the departure of the VQ9-Group on the trip to Desroches has been put off a few days and is now set for September 7th with an arrival there on September 9th.

The plans still include a full two weeks of operation and they expect to operate until September 22nd. All bands will be worked, ten through eighty, CW and SSB and they plan to spread out across the bands with no special frequencies. Their main objectives will be to work everyone that can get a signal into the Desroches area.

Those going on this trip will be VQ9D-Richard Barnes, VQ9M-R. Miles and VQ9BP-Bill Pomeroy, the latter one of those ubiquitous Marin QRPers.

Desroches itself is a narrow cay on the southern edge of a circular, submerged reef and the cay is the only land on the atoll rim. It is about $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles long, $\frac{3}{4}$ mile wide and there is about 800 acres of land about six or eight feet above sea level. It is 131 miles from Mahe in the Seychelles and while close to the Amirantes, it is on a separate bank.

Desroches has a deep lagoon with an easy entrance and excellent anchorages. A landing is possible at all states of the tide and any time of the year. The island is privately owned, it being the property of a M. Andre Delhomme. The only population is a small labor force recruited from Mahe to tend the coconut crop. Generally these laborers are contracted for an eighteen month period, the owner of the island having the responsibility to feed and house them as well as paying the minimum legal wage. The owner must also provide hospital facilities, a shop for living necessities and on which the profit margin is controlled as well as a jail for possibly too much exuberance on a Saturday night. Provision must be made also for a trip by a vessel to the island at least every three months.

QSLs will go as follows: VQ9BP to Box 220, Victoria, Mahe, Seychelles Islands. VQ9D and VQ9M go to Box 116, APO New York 09030. VQ9MI will be maintaining daily schedules with the group around 7071kc.

The beam antennas have arrived from England and they will have two TA33 tribanders, two 35" masts, a vertical, some long wires, antenna tuners plus two generators.

If sometimes you wonder what medium-rare DX stations do while waiting for the next pile-up, it may be enlightening to note that VQ9D-Dick Barnes passes along the information that he worked PQ9NS on August 12th...21330kc at 1418Z. Dick notes that this was his first Fernando de Noronha which he needed for DXCC. As Lord Baden-Powell, the Hero of Mafeking, would often say: "Son of a Gun!".

SIKKIM AC3PT showed at a number of spots last week while band conditions were good, sometimes with UA9VB as M.C. for the effort. The station was reported as active on August 16/17/18th. AC3PT during those days was reported at 14318kc/1200Z on August 18th...at 14160kc/1130Z on August 17th and at 14003kc/1555Z on August 16th. Said to QSL direct. Some stateside stations reported hearing him for brief periods. A watch around the frequency of the SEANet...14320kc/1200Z might give some indication of possible activity. The word last week was to QSL direct...other indicators are via a VU2. This may be clarified but work them first.....

SUNSPOT LOUIE Last Tuesday when this observation was made, there were two sunspots present, the top spot showing on Aug 14th and the bottom one showing on August 20th. The top spot is about 10,000 miles in diameter while the lower one is about 8000. The upper one has been stable with little change in size or appearance since it showed. It is still a bit too early to say what the bottom spot will do. The good conditions that existed a week ago might be matched with the significant sunspots.....there were three visible on the 15th, four on the 17th and but a lonely one by the 19th remained of the group shown last week. The new one had just put in its appearance then as shown on the chart. Conditions were good from August 13th up to the start of last week and then they fell flat on their collective faces. While it lasted, the Sunspot Dance did produce some good results but it does seem that many of the dancers stopped jiggling to work DX.... Band conditions are expected to gradually improve the first part of this week and then deteriorate at the turn of the month...

POLISH MOUNTAINEERING EXPEDITION The SP-mountaineering group were in the Yukon last week and SP9PT/VE8 was being reported on both c.w. and SSB. A note from Woj, SP9PT, advises:

I am a member of the 1st Polish Mountaineering Expedition to Alaska (we climbed successfully on Mt. McKinley) and Mt. St. Elias on the Alaska/Yukon Border. There are a lot of approaches to the summit on these mountains which have never been climbed before. Some of the lower peaks in the ranges are still nameless. I have been QRV on all bands, CW and SSB, from 3 August to 10 September. I have had to this time about 400 QSOs, about half with European stations including 24 with SP/SQ stations. We have also worked 48 countries while on this mountaineering effort to the highest peak in North America. We will probably be back in Poland in October. QSL inquiries can be sent to either SP9RU or to the SP-QSL Bureau. During the trip we have used a TS-515 transceiver with a TH3-Jr beam plus some inverted Vee dipoles.

Frank says that he will be back in Taipei in early October and he does have permission to operate. His hopes are that he can satisfy many looking for their initial BV-Formosa contact.
